JUNIOR MORTGAGE, SECURITY AGREEMENT, ASSIGNMENT OF RENTS AND FIXTURE FILING

This Junior Morigage, Security Agreement, Assignment of Rents and Fixture Filing ("Junior Mortgage") made this 21st day of April, 2008 by 3FJ CONSTRUCTION COMPANY, INC., an Illinois corporation, whose address is 2554 Jade Avenue, Arlington Heights, Illinois 60004 ("Mortgagor") to DAVID CRAW Or D, whose address is 701 S. Wells Street, Chicago, Illinois 60607 (hereinafter referred to as "Mortgagee").

WHEREAS, Mortgagee has made a loan to Mortgagor in the original principal amount of TWO HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND DCLLARS (\$250,000.00) ("Loan"), which Loan is evidenced by a Note dated as of October 31, 2007("O iginal Note") and was executed by Mortgagor to and for the benefit of Mortgagee; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to a Loan Modification Agreement dated as of an even date herewith by and between Mortgagor, Robert Chavin, Cindy Chavin and Mor gagee, the principal amount of the Loan was increased by ONE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$100,000.00) to THREE HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$350,000.00) and the Criginal Note was amended, restated and replaced by a note of an even date herewith executed by Mortgagor in the original principal amount of THREE HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$350,000.00) ("Note"); and

Mortgagor hereby agrees that Mortgagor is justly indebted to Mortgagee in the principal sum of THREE HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$350,000.00), plus interest as collenced by the Note whereby Mortgagor promises to pay the said principal sum, together with interest

thereon, from the date and at the rate set forth therein, at the office of Mortgagee, or at such other place as may be designated in writing by the legal holders thereof until the entire principal balance remaining unpaid plus accrued interest shall be due and payable as required therein.

NOW, THEREFORE, in order to secure Mortgagor's obligations as set forth in the Note entered into by and between Mortgagor and Mortgagee as of an even date herewith and all extensions, modifications, renewals or replacements thereof and the performance of Mortgagor's covenants and agreements herein contained, and for other good and valuable consideration the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, including as set forth in the recitals, Mortgagor does by these presents grant, bargain, warrant, sell, convey, and mortgage unto Mortgagee, as successors and assigns forever, the real estate and all of its estate, right, title, and interest therein situated in the City of Chicago, County of Cook and State of Illinois, as more particularly described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and made a part hereof (sometimes herein referred to as the "real estate"), which real estate, together with the following described property, is collectively referred to as the "premises";

TOGETHER WITH:

- (1) All right, title, and interest of Mortgagor, including any after-acquired title or reversion, in and to the beds of the ways, streets, avenues, vaults, and alleys adjoining the premises,
- All and singular the tenements, here ditaments, easements, minerals, appurtenances, passages, waters, water courses, riparian, irrigation, and drainage rights, and other rights, liberties, and privileges thereof or in any way now or hereatter appertaining, including homestead and any other claim at law or in equity as well as any after-acquired title, franchise, or license and the reversion and reversions and remainder and remainders thereof,
- (3) All rents, issues, proceeds, and profits accruing and to accrue from the premises (which are pledged primarily and on a parity with the real estate, and not secondarily), and
- All buildings and improvements of every kind and description now or hereafter erected or placed thereon and all materials intended for construction, reconstruction, alteration, and repairs of such improvements now or hereafter erected thereon, all of which materials shall be deemed to be included within the premises immediately upon the delivery thereof to the premises, and all fixtures now or hereafter owned by Mortgagor and attached to or contained in an a used in connection with the premises, including, but not limited to, all machinery, motors, elevators, fittings, radiators, awnings, shades, screens, and all plumbing, heating, lighting, ventilating, refrigerating, incinerating, air-conditioning, and sprinkler equipment and fixtures and appurtenances thereto, and all items of furniture, furnishings, equipment, and personal property owned by the Mortgagor used or useful in the operation of the said real estate, and all renewals or replacements thereof or articles in substitution therefor, whether or not the same are or shall be attached to said building or buildings in any manner, it being mutually agreed, intended, and declared that all the aforesaid property owned by said Mortgagor and placed by it on the premises or used in connection with the operation or maintenance of the premises shall, so far as permitted by law, be deemed to form a part

and parcel of the real estate and for the purpose of this Junior Mortgage to be real estate, and covered by this Junior Mortgage, and as to any of the property aforesaid which does not so form a part and parcel of the real estate or does not constitute a "fixture" (as such term is defined in the Uniform Commercial Code), this Junior Mortgage is hereby deemed to be, as well, a Security Agreement under the Uniform Commercial Code for the purpose of creating hereby a security interest in such property, which Mortgagor hereby grants to the Mortgagee as Secured Party (as such term is defined in the Uniform Commercial Code), it being further understood and agreed that the provisions of this subparagraph (4) shall not apply or attach to any trade fixtures or personal property of any tenant of the premises;

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the Mortgagee and its successors and assigns forever, for the purposes and uses herein set forth;

PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that if the Mortgagor shall pay the liabilities as provided in the Note, and shall pay all other sums herein provided for, or secured hereby, and shall well and truly keep and perform all of the covenants herein contained, then this Junior Mortgage shall be released at the cost of the Mortgagor, otherwise to remain in full force and effect.

MORTGAGOR FURTHER COVENANTS and agrees as follows:

- 1. <u>Recitals/Defined Terms</u>. Tre foregoing recitals are incorporated into this Junior Mortgage as if fully set forth herein. Except as specifically defined herein, all defined terms used herein and in the foregoing recitals shall have the me mings ascribed therefore in the Note.
- 2. Payment of Amounts Due. This Junior Mortgage is given for the purpose of securing the payment, performance and observance by Mortgagor of each covenant, condition, provision and agreement contained herein and in the Note and of all nonies expended or advanced by Mortgagor pursuant to the terms hereof and in the Note, or to preserve any right of Mortgagee hereunder, or to protect or preserve the premises or any part thereof.
- 3. <u>Taxes</u>. Mortgagor shall immediately pay, when first due and owing, all general taxes, special taxes, special assessments, water charges, sewer service charges, and all other charges of whatever kind, ordinary or extraordinary, which may be levied or imposed against the premises, and to furnish to Mortgagee, upon Mortgagee's request, official receipts therefor within thirty (30) days after payment thereof.

4. Insurance

(a) <u>Casualty</u>. Mortgagor shall keep the improvements now existing or hereafter erected on the premises constantly insured against loss or damage under such types and forms of insurance policies and in the minimum amount of the outstanding balance of the principal sum from time to time and for such periods as Mortgagee may from time to time require, and Mortgagor shall pay promptly, when due, any premiums on such insurance. Unless Mortgagee otherwise agrees, all such insurance shall provide "all risk" full insurable

value replacement cost coverage and shall be carried with companies having a Best's rating of A+ or A acceptable to the Mortgagee and the policies and renewals (or certificates evidencing same), marked by the insurer "PAID", shall be delivered to the Mortgagee at least thirty (30) days before the expiration of the old policies and shall have attached thereto standard noncontributing mortgage clauses in favor of and entitling the Mortgagee alone to collect any and all of the proceeds payable under all such insurance, as well as standard waiver of subrogation endorsements, and shall contain provision for ten (10) days notice to Mortgagee prior to any cancellation or amendment thereof. Mortgagor shall not carry separate insurance, concurrent in kind or form and contributing in the event of loss, with any insurance required hereunder. In the event of a change in ownership or of occupancy of the premises (if approved in writing by Mortgagee), immediate notice thereof by mail shall be delivered to all insurers. In the event of any loss covered by such insurance, Mortgagor shall immediately notify Mortgagee in writing, and Mortgagor hereby authorizes and directs each and every insurance company concerned to make payments for such loss directly and solely to Mortgagee (vino may, but need not, make proof of loss) and Mortgagee is hereby authorized to adjust, collect, and compromise in its discretion all claims under all policies, and Mortgagor shall sign upon demand by Mortgagee, all receipts, vouchers, and releases required by such insurance companies. After deducting any costs of collection, Mortgagee may use or apply the proceeds, at its option, (i) as a credit upon any portion of the indebtedness secured hereby, or (ii) to repairing and restoring the improvements, in which event the Mortgagee shall not be obliged to see to the proper application thereof nor shall the amount so released or used for resturation be deemed a payment on the indebtedness secured hereby, or (iii) to deliver same to the Mortgagor. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary or inconsistent contained herein, provided no Event of Default exists, if the cost to rebuild or repair the improvements when added to all existing liens on the premises, is less than eighty percent (80%) of the appraised value of the premises, as determined by Mortgagee, then, subject to the liens hereof, Mortgagee shall permit the insurance proceeds to be used to rebuild or repair the improvements. In the event Mortgagee shall elect to apply such proceeds to restoring the improvements, such proceeds shall be made available, from time to time, upon Mortgagee being furnished with satisfactory vidence of the estimated cost of such restoration and with such architect's certificates, waivers of lien, contractors' sworn statements and other evidence of cost and of payments as Mortgagee hay reasonably require and approve, and if the estimated cost of the work exceeds ten percent (10%) of the original principal amount of the indebtedness secured hereby, Mortgagor small furnish Mortgagee with all plans and specifications for such rebuilding or restoration as Mortgagee may reasonably require and approve. No payment made prior to the final completion of the work shall exceed ninety percent (90%) of the value of the work performed, from time to time, and at all times the undisbursed balance of said proceeds remaining in the hands of Mortgagee shall be at least sufficient to pay for the cost of completion of the work, free and clear of any liens. In the event of foreclosure of this Junior Mortgage, or other transfer of title to the premises in the extinguishment of the indebtedness secured hereby, all right, title, and interest of Mortgagor, in and to any insurance policies then in force, and any claims or proceeds thereunder shall pass to Mortgagee or any purchaser or grantee. In the event Mortgagee, in its reasonable discretion, determines that any insurance provided by

Mortgager, does not comply with the insurance requirements set forth herein, then Mortgagee may, at any time and at its own discretion, procure and substitute for any and all of the insurance so held as aforesaid, such other policy or policies of insurance, in such amount and carried in such company as it may determine, the cost of which shall be repaid to Mortgagee by Mortgagor upon demand. Mortgagor shall furnish to Mortgagee, upon its request, estimates or appraisals of insurable value, without cost to the Mortgagee, such as are regularly and ordinarily made by insurance companies to determine the then replacement cost of the building or buildings and improvements on the premises.

- Liability. Mortgagor shall carry and maintain comprehensive public liability insurance as may be required from time to time by Mortgagee in forms, amounts, and with companies having a Best's rating of A+ or A or satisfactory to Mortgagee, and Mortgagor will apply all insurance proceeds under such policies to the payment and discharge of the liabilities in respect of which such proceeds are collected. It is understood and agreed that policy shall name Mortgagee as an additional insured party thereunder. Certificates of such insurance, premiums prepaid, shall be deposited with Mortgagee and shall contain provision for ten (10) days' notice to Mortgagee prior to any cancellation or amendment thereof.
- Preservation, Restoration and Use of Premises. No building or other improvement on the premises shall (except as required by law) be altered, removed, or demolished nor shall any fixtures or appliances on, in or about said buildings or improvements be severed, removed, sold or mortgaged, without the prior virit en consent of Mortgagee, and in the event of the demolition or destruction in whole or in part of any of the fixtures, chattels, or articles of personal property covered hereby or by any separate security agreement given in conjunction herewith, the same shall be replaced promptly by similar fixtures, charlels, and articles of personal property at least equal in quality and condition to those replaced, free from any security interest in or encumbrances thereon or reservation of title thereto. Mortgage, shall promptly repair, restore, or rebuild any buildings or improvements now or hereafter on the premises which may become damaged or be destroyed. The buildings and improvements shall be so restored or rebuilt so as to be of at least equal value and substantially the same character as prior to such damage or destruction. Mortgagor shall not permit, commit, or suffer any waste, impairment, or deterioration of the premises or any part or improvement thereof, and shall keep and maintain the premises and every part thereof in good repair and condition and effect such repairs as Mortgaget may reasonably require, and, from time to time, make all needful and proper replacements and additions thereto so that said buildings, fixtures, machinery, and appurtenances will, at all times, be in good condition, fit and proper for the respective purposes for which they were originally erected or installed. Mortgagor shall not suffer or permit the premises to be abandoned or to be used for a purpose other than that for which the premises are presently used, or represented to Mortgagee to be used. Mortgagor shall not subject the premises to any use covenants or restrictions and shall not initiate, join in or consent to any change in any existing private restrictive covenant, zoning ordinance, or other public or private restriction limiting or defining the uses which may be made of or the kind of improvements which can be constructed or placed on the premises or any part thereof, and shall promptly notify Mortgagee of, and appear in and defend, at its sole cost and expense, any such proceedings seeking to effect any of the foregoing. Mortgagor shall not subdivide the real estate and

shall not subject the premises to the provisions of the condominium laws of the state in which the premises are situated.

- 6. Compliance with Governmental, Insurance and Other Requirements. Mortgagor shall comply with all statutes, ordinances, orders, requirements, or decrees relating to the premises or the use thereof of any federal, state, or municipal authority, and shall observe and comply with all conditions and requirements necessary to maintain in force the insurance required under paragraph 4 hereof and to preserve and extend any and all rights, licenses, permits (including, but not limited to, zoning variances, special exceptions, and nonconforming uses) privileges, franchises, and concessions which are applicable to the premises or which have been granted to or contracted for by Mortgagor in connection with any existing or presently contemplated use of the premises. In the event thra any building or other improvement on the premises must be altered or removed to enable Mortgago, to comply with the foregoing provisions of this paragraph 6, Mortgagor shall not commence any such alterations or removals without Mortgagee's prior approval of the need therefor and the plans and specifications pertaining thereto. After such approval, which shall not be unreasonably withheld or delayed, Mortgagor, at its sole cost and expense, shall effect the alterations or removal so required and approved by Mortgagee. Mortgagor shall not by act or omission permit any building or other improvement on and not subject to the lien of this Junior Mortgage to rely on the premises or any part thereof or any interest therein to fulfill any municipal or governmental requirement, and Mortgagor hereby assigns to Mortgagee any and all rights to give consent for all or any portion of the premises or any interest therein to be so used. Similarly, no building or other improvement on the premises shall rely on any and not subject to the lien of this Junior Mortgage or any interest therein to fulfill any governmental or municipal requirement. Mortgagor shall not by act or omission impair the integrity of the premises as a single zoning lot separate and apart from all other premises. Any act or omission by Mortgagor which would result in a violation of any of the provisions of this paragraph shall be void. Mortgagor shall duly and punctually perform and comply with all covenants and conditions expressed as binding up on it under any recorded document or any other agreement of any nature whatsoever binding upon it which pertains to the premises.
- Mortgagor shall keep the premises free from liens of mechanics and materialmen and from all other liens, charges, and encumbrances of whatever nature, regardless of (i) whether he same arise voluntarily or involuntarily on the part of Mortgagor and (ii) whether the same are subordinate to, prior to, or on a parity with the lien of this Junior Mortgage, and shall furnish to Mortgagee satisfactory evidence of the payment and discharge of any such liens, charges, and encumbrances, asserted or claimed to exist against the premises, excepting, however, any lien or encumbrance expressly consented to by Mortgagee with respect to which Mortgagor shall pay, when due, the indebtedness secured thereby and upon Mortgagee's request, furnish to Mortgagee satisfactory evidence of such payment or payments. In the event Mortgagor shall suffer or permit any superior or junior lien to be attached to the premises, Mortgagee, at its option, has the unqualified right to cause the liabilities of Mortgagor under the Note to be immediately due and payable without notice to Mortgagor.

- 8. <u>Sale, Conveyance or Other Transfers</u>. In the event Mortgagor shall, without the prior written consent of Mortgagee, which consent Mortgagee may, in its absolute discretion, withhold, sell, transfer, convey, encumber, lease, or assign the title to all or any portion of the premises, or the rents, issues, or profits therefrom, whether by operation of law, voluntarily, or otherwise, or shall contract to do any of the foregoing, then any of the foregoing acts, omissions, or occurrences shall constitute an event of default hereunder and Mortgagee, at its option, shall then have the unqualified right to accelerate the maturity of the Note, causing the full principal balance and accrued interest, to be immediately due and payable without notice of Mortgagor, and, in addition, Mortgagee shall be entitled to pursue any and all rights and remedies granted hereunder, in the Note or otherwise available to it, at law or in equity.
- government shall require Internal Revenue or other documentary stamps hereon or on the payments due under the Note secured hereby, or shall otherwise impose a tax or impose an assessment on this Junior Mortgage or on the Note or shall require payment of an interest equalization tax upon the indebtedness secured hereby, then the said indebtedness and the accrued interest thereon shall be and become due and payable at the election of Mortgagee thirty (30) days after the mailing of notice of such election to Mortgagor, provided, however, said election shall be unavailing and this Junior Mortgage and the Note shall be and remain in effect, if Mortgagor lawfully may pay for such stamps or such tax including interest and penalties thereon to or on behalf of Mortgagee and Mortgagor does in fact pay, when payable, for all such stamps or such tax, as the case may be, including interest and penalties thereon.
- Effect of Change in Laws Regarding 12 xation. In the event of the enactment, after 10. the date of this Junior Mortgage, of any law of the state in which the premises are located deducting from the value of the land for the purpose of taxation any lien thereon, or imposing upon Mortgagee the payment of the whole or any part of the taxes or assessments or charges or liens herein required to be paid by Mortgagor, or changing in any way the laws relating to the taxation of mortgages or debts secured by mortgages or Mortgagee's interest in the property, or the manner of collection of taxes, so as to affect this Junior Mortgage or the debt secured hereby or the holder thereof, then, and in any such event, Mortgagor, upon demand by Mortgagee, shall pay such takes or assessments, or reimburse Mortgagee therefor; provided, however, that if, in the opinion of coursel for Mortgagee, (i) it might be unlawful to require Mortgagor to make such payment or (ii) the graving of such payment might result in the imposition of interest beyond the maximum amount permitted by law, then, and in such event, Mortgagee may elect, by notice in writing given to Mortgagor, to declare all of the indebtedness secured hereby to be and become due and payable within thirty (30) days from the giving of such notice. Notwithstanding the foregoing, Mortgagor shall not be obligated to pay any portion of Mortgagee's federal or state income tax.
- 11. Mortgagee's Performance of Defaulted Acts. In case of default herein, Mortgagee may, but need not, make any payment or perform any act herein required of Mortgagor in any form and manner deemed expedient by Mortgagee. By way of illustration and not in limitation of the foregoing, Mortgagee may, but need not, make full or partial payments of principal or interest on prior encumbrances, if any, and purchase, discharge, compromise, or settle any tax lien or other prior

or junior lien or title or claim thereof, or redeem from any tax sale or forfeiture affecting the premises or contest any tax or assessment. Mortgagee is hereby authorized to make or advance, in the place and stead of the Mortgagor, any payment relating to taxes, assessments, water rates, sewer rentals, and other governmental or municipal charges, fines, impositions, or liens asserted against the premises and may do so according to any bill, statement, or estimate procured from the appropriate public office without inquiry into the accuracy of the bill, statement or estimate or into the validity of any tax, assessment, sale, forfeiture, tax lien, or title or claim thereof; and the Mortgagee is further authorized to make or advance in the place and stead of the Mortgagor any payment relating to any apparent or threatened adverse title, lien, statement of lien, encumbrance. claim, or charge, or payment otherwise relating to any other purpose herein and hereby authorized, but not enumerated in this paragraph, and may do so whenever, in its judgment and discretion, such advance or ad ar ces shall seem necessary or desirable to protect the full security intended to be created by this in trument, and in connection with any such advance, Mortgagee, at its option, may and is hereby authorized to obtain a continuation report of title or title insurance policy prepared by a title insurance company of Mortgagee's choosing. All monies paid for any of the purposes herein authorized and all expenses paid or incurred in connection therewith, including attorneys' fees, and any other monies advanced by Nortgagee to protect the premises and the lien hereof, shall be so much additional indebtedness secured hereby, and shall become immediately due and payable by Mortgagor to Mortgagee without notice and with interest thereon at the default interest rate. Inaction of Mortgagee shall never be considered as a waiver of any right accruing to it on account of any default on the part of Mortgagor.

Eminent Domain. Any and all awards heretofore or hereafter made or to be made 12. to the present and all subsequent owners of the premises, by any governmental or other lawful authority for taking, by condemnation or eminent domain the whole or any part of the premises or any improvement located thereon or any easement therein or appurtenant thereto (including any award from the United States Government at any time after the gilovance of the claim therefor, the ascertainment of the amount thereof and the issuance of the warrant for payment thereof), are hereby assigned by Mortgagor to Mortgagee, which award Mortgagee is hereby authorized to collect and receive from the condemnation authorities, and Mortgagee is hereby authorized to give appropriate receipts and acquittance therefor. Mortgagor shall give Mortgagee immedia e notice of the actual or threatened commencement of any such proceedings under condemnation cr en inent domain, affecting all or any part of the said premises or any easement therein or appure neace thereof, including severance and consequential damage and change in grade of streets, and vil' deliver to Mortgagee copies of any and all papers served in connection with any such proceedings. Notigagor shall make, execute, and deliver to Mortgagee, at any time or times upon request, free, clear, and discharged of any encumbrances of any kind whatsoever, any and all further assignments and instruments deemed necessary by Mortgagee for the purpose of validly and sufficiently assigning to Mortgagee all awards and other compensation heretofore and hereafter to be made to Mortgagor for any taking, either permanent or temporary, under any such proceeding. The proceeds of all such awards shall be paid to Mortgagee and may be applied by Mortgagee, at its option, after the payment of all of its expenses in connection with such proceedings, including reasonable costs and attorneys' fees, to the reduction of the indebtedness secured hereby or to restoring the improvements, in which

event the same shall be paid out in the same manner as is provided, with respect to insurance proceeds, in paragraph 4(a) hereof.

13. Acknowledgment of Debt. Mortgagor shall furnish from time to time within seven (7) days after Mortgagee's request, a written statement, duly acknowledged, verifying the amount due under this Junior Mortgage (as reflected on the books and records of Mortgagee) and whether any alleged offsets or defenses exist against the indebtedness secured by this Junior Mortgage.

14. Assignment of Rents.

- To facilitate payment and performance of the amounts due hereunder, Mortgagor hereby absolutely, presently and unconditionally transfers and assigns to Mortgage all right, title and interest of Mortgagor in and to (i) all existing and future leases, subleases, licenses and other agreements for the use and occupancy of all or any part of the premises whether written or oral and whether for a definite term or month to month, together with all guaranties of the lessee's obligations thereunder and together with all extensions, modifications and renewals thereof (hereinafter called the "Leases"), and (ii) all income, receipts, revenues, rents, issues and profits now or hereafter arising from or out of the Leases or from or out of the premises or any part thereof, including without limitation room rents, minimum rents, auditional rents, percentage rents, parking and maintenance charges and fees, tax and insurance contributions, proceeds of the sale of utilities and services, cancellation premiums, claim, for damages arising from any breach of the Leases, proceeds from any sale or other disposition of all or any portion of the premises, and all other benefits arising from the use or enjoyr ent of, or the lease, sale or other disposition of, all or any portion of the premises, together with the immediate and continuing right to receive all of the foregoing (hereinafter called the 'Rents"). This assignment is an absolute assignment and not an assignment for security purposes Mortgagor agrees that, during the term of this Junior Mortgage, the Rents shall not constitute property of Mortgagor (or of any estate of Mortgagor) within the meaning of 11 U.S.C. \$541, as amended from time to time. In furtherance of this Assignment, and not in lieu hereof, viortgagee may require a separate assignment of lessor's interest in the leases and/or separate specific assignments of rents and leases covering one or more of the Leases; the terms of all such assignments are incorporated herein by reference.
- (b) Mortgagor hereby authorizes and directs the lessees and tenants incler the Leases that, upon written notice from Mortgagee, all Rents shall be paid directly to Mortgagee as they become due. Nevertheless, Mortgagee grants a license to Mortgagor entitling Mortgagor to collect the Rents until Mortgagee notifies the lessees and tenants in writing to pay the Rents to Mortgagee. The term "Environmental Laws" shall mean any and all federal, state and local laws, statutes, regulations, ordinances, codes, rules and other governmental restrictions or requirements relating to the environment or hazardous substances, including, without limitation, the Federal Solid Waste Disposal Act, the Federal Clean Air Act, the Federal Clean Water Act, the Federal Resource Conservation and Recovery Act of 1975 and the Federal Comprehensive Environmental Responsibility, Cleanup and Liability Act of 1980, as well as all regulations of the Environmental Protection Agency, the Nuclear Regulatory Agency and any state department of natural resources or state environmental protection agency now or at any time hereafter in effect.
