## NOTICE, Vacant Building Determination

Notice is hereby given that on the 9 day of May (month), 2008 (year) the City of Evanston, an Illinois Municipal Corporation, by its Community Development Department, Property Standards Division, made a determination that the property described below is a "Vacant Building" in accordance with the provisions of the City Code of the City of Evanston, Title 5, Chapter 20, "Vacant Buildings" (viewable at [www.cityofevanston.org](http://www.cityofevanston.org))

The City of Evanston regulates vacant buildings to protect the public health, safety and welfare from the public nuisance that vacant buildings cause due to vacancy, deterioration, neglect and code violations. The City of Evanston seeks to maintain sanitation and health standards, prevent crime and avoid fire, health and safety hazards to the public and future owners and occupants of any vacant buildings with the enforcement of applicable City codes and ordinances.

This determination of a vacant building shall subject this property to the provisions of Title 5, Chapter 20, including, but not limited to: Section 4-20-6: Obligation to Register Vacant Buildings. Buildings must be registered with the City of Evanston for a \$200.00 fee and inspected for code compliance by the City of Evanston for a \$500.00 fee. Real estate transfer stamps may be withheld by the City as provided in the ordinance. Proof of liability insurance for the building must be provided to the City of Evanston along with a vacant building plan for building maintenance and repair. 4-20-12: A Certificate of Code Compliance shall be required prior to any occupancy. 4-20-13: Buildings may remain neither boarded for not more than 6 months nor vacant for more than 2 years. 4-20-14: Enforcement and Penalties. Violators of Title 5, Chapter 20, Vacant Buildings, may be subject to a fine of \$100.00 to \$750.00 per day per violation.


