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1. Payment of Principal, Interest and Late Charge. Borrower shall pay when due the principal of, and interest on, the debt evidenced by the Note and late charge due under the Note.

2. Monthly Payment of Taxes, Insurance and Other Charges. Borrower shall include in each monthly payment, together with the principal and interest as set forth in the Note and any late charges, a sum for (a) taxes and special assessments levied or to be levied against the Property, (b) leasehold payments, or ground rents on the Property, and (c) premiums for insurance required under Paragraph 4. 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If the amounts held by Lender for Escrow Items exceed the amounts permitted to be held by RESPA, Lender shall account to Borrower for the excess funds as required by RESPA. Second, to any taxes, special assessments, leasehold payments or ground rents, and fire, flood and other hazard insurance premiums, as required;

Third, to interest due under the Note;

Fourth, to amortization of the principal of the Note; and

Fifth, to late charges due under the Note.

4. Fire, Flood and Other Hazard Insurance. Borrower shall insure all improvements on the Property, whether now in existence or subsequently erected, against any hazards, casualties, and contingencies, including fire, for which Lender requires insurance. This insurance shall be maintained in the amounts and for the periods that Lender requires. Borrower shall also insure all improvements on the Property, whether now in existence or subsequently erected, against loss by floods to the extent required by the Secretary. All insurance shall be carried with companies approved by Lender. The insurance policies and any renewals shall be held by Lender and shall include loss payable clauses in favor of, and in a form acceptable to, Lender.

In the event of loss, Borrower shall give Lender immediate notice by mail. Lender may make proof of loss if not made promptly by Borrower. Each insurance company concerned is hereby authorized and directed to make payment for such loss directly to Lender, instead of to Borrower and to Lender jointly. All or any part of the insurance proceeds may be applied by Lender, at its option, either (a) to the reduction of the indebtedness under the Note and this Security Instrument, first to any delinquent amounts applied in the order in paragraph 3, and then to prepayment of principal, or (b) to the restoration or repair of the damaged Property. Any application of the proceeds to the principal shall not extend or postpone the due date of the monthly payments which are referred to in paragraph 2, or change the amount of such payments. Any excess insurance proceeds over an amount required to pay all outstanding indebtedness under the Note and this Security Instrument shall be paid to the entity legally entitled thereto.

In the event of foreclosure of this Security Instrument or other transfer of title to the Property that extinguishes the indebtedness, all right, title and interest of Borrower in and to insurance policies in force shall pass to the purchaser.

5. Occupancy, Preservation, Maintenance and Protection of the Property; Borrower's Loan Application; Leaseholds. Borrower shall occupy, establish, and use the Property as Borrower's principal residence within sixty days after the execution of this Security Instrument (or within sixty days of a later sale or transfer of the Property) and shall continue to occupy the Property as Borrower's principal residence for at least one year after the date of occupancy, unless Lender determines that requirement will cause undue hardship for Borrower, or unless extenuating circumstances exist which are beyond Borrower's control. 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

THE NOTE CONTAINS PROVISIONS ALLOWING FOR CHANGES IN THE INTEREST RATE AND THE MONTHLY PAYMENT. THE NOTE LIMITS THE AMOUNT THE BORROWER'S INTEREST RATE CAN CHANGE AT ANY ONE TIME AND THE MAXIMUM RATE THE BORROWER MUST PAY.

ADDITIONAL COVENANTS. In addition to the covenants and agreements made in the Security Instrument, Borrower and Lender further covenant and agree as follows:

INTEREST RATE AND MONTHLY PAYMENT CHANGES

(A) Change Date

The interest rate may change on the first day of JANUARY , 2001 , and on that day of each succeeding year. "Change Date" means each date on which the interest rate could change.

(B) The Index

Beginning with the first Change Date, the interest rate will be based on an Index. "Index" means the weekly average yield on United States Treasury Securities adjusted to a constant maturity of one year, as made available by the Federal Reserve Board. "Current Index" means the most recent Index figure available 30 days before the Change Date. If the Index (as defined above) is no longer available, Lender will use as a new Index any index prescribed by the Secretary. As used in this Rider, "Secretary" means the Secretary of Housing and Urban Development or his or her designee." Lender will give Borrower notice of the new Index.

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Initials:

A new interest rate calculated in accordance with paragraphs (c) and (d) of this Rider will become effective on the Change Date. Borrower shall make a payment in a new monthly amount beginning on the first payment date which occurs at least 25 days after Lennder has given Borrower the notice of changes effective on the Change Date. Lennder will give notice to Borrower of any change in the interest rate and monthly payment amount.

The notice must be given at least 25 days before the new monthly payment amount is due, and must set forth (i) the date of the notice, (ii) the Change Date, (iii) the old interest rate, (iv) the new interest rate, (v) the new monthly payment amount, (vi) the Current Index and the date it was published, (vii) the method of calculating the change in monthly payment amount, and (viii) any other information which may be required by law from time to time.

(G) Effective Date of Changes

Borrower shall make a payment in a new monthly amount in accordance with paragraph (E) of this Rider for any increase in the first payment date which occurs at least 25 days after Lennder has given Borrower the notice of changes effective on the Change Date. Lennder will give notice to Borrower of any change in the interest rate and monthly payment amount.

A new interest rate calculated in accordance with paragraphs (c) and (d) of this Rider will become effective on the Change Date. Borrower shall make a payment in a new monthly amount beginning on the first payment date which occurs at least 25 days after Lennder has given Borrower the notice of changes effective on the Change Date. Lennder will give notice to Borrower of any change in the interest rate and monthly payment amount.

Lennder should have been stated in a timely notice, then Borrower has the option to either (i) demand the return of any excess payment or (ii) require that any excess payment be paid to the Note holder at the Note rate, be supplied as payment of principal, Lennder's obligation to return any excess payment at the Note rate, even if the Note is otherwise assigned before the demand for return is made.

(F) Notice of Changes

If the interest rate changes on a Change Date, Lennder will calculate the amount of monthly payment of principal and interest which would be necessary to repay the unpaid principal balance in full at the maturity Date at the new interest rate. In making such calculation, Lennder will use the unpaid principal balance which would be owed on the Change Date if there had been no default in payment on the Note, reduced by the amount of any prepayments to principal. The result of this calculation will be the amount of the new monthly payment of principal and interest.

The notice must be given at least 25 days before the new monthly payment amount is due, and must set forth (i) the date of the notice, (ii) the Change Date, (iii) the old interest rate, (iv) the new interest rate, (v) the new monthly payment amount, (vi) the Current Index and the date it was published, (vii) the method of calculating the change in monthly payment amount, and (viii) any other information which may be required by law from time to time.

(D) Limits on Interest Rate Changes

The existing interest rate will never increase or decrease by more than five percentage points (5.0%) on any single Change Date. The interest rate will never be more than one percentage point (1.0%) on any subsequent Change Date. Subject to the limits stated in Paragraph 2 of the Note,

(C) Calculation of Interest Rate Changes

Before each Change Date, Lennder will calculate a new interest rate by adding a margin of percentage point (0.125%). Subject to the Current Index and rounding the sum to the nearest one-eighth of one percentage point (0.125%), to the Current Index and rounding the sum to the nearest one-eighth of one percentage point (0.125%). Before each Change Date, Lennder will calculate a new interest rate by adding a margin of two and three fourths percentage point(s).

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
