
That at the special instance and request of said contractor the claimant furnished extra and additional materials and extra and additional labor on said premises of the value of \$16,835.00, and on November 14, 2008, substantially completed thereunder work to the value of \$44,835.00.

That said contractor is entitled to credits on account thereof as follows: the sum of \$36,200.00, leaving due, unpaid and owing to the claimant, after allowing all credits, the sum of EIGHT THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED THIRTY-FIVE and no cents (\$8,635.00) Dollars, for which, with interest, the claimant claims a lien on said land and improvements and on the moneys or other considerations due or to become due from the owner under said contract against said contractor and owner.

To the extent permitted by law, all waivers of lien heretofore given by claimant, if any, in order to induce payment not received are hereby revoked. Acceptance of payment by claimant of part, but not all, of the amount claimed due hereunder shall not operate to invalidate this notice and lien.




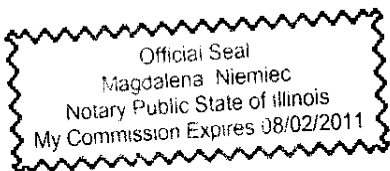
