### AGPEND JUDGMENT ORDER

This matter having come to be heard by agreement of the parties, Plaintiffs Laborers' Pension Fund and Laborers' Welfare Fund of the Health and Welfare Department of the Construction and General Laborers' District Council of Chicago and Vicinity and James S. Jorgensen, Administrator of the Funds, (collectively "Funds") by and through their attorney, Christina Krivanek, and Defendants Benson Construction Company ("Company") and Mark W. Berglund ("Berglund"), by and through their attorney, Neil P. Gantz,, pursuant to their Agreed Stipulation of Judgment:

#### IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

- 1. Judgment is hereby entered in favor of the Plaintiffs and against Defendants

  Benson Construction Company and Mark W. Berglund, jointly and severally, in the amount of
  \$39,410.69 as follows:
  - a. For \$19,319.05; representing \$13,126.64 in delinquent contributions and union dues, \$2,448.00 in liquidated damages, \$2,187.00 in accumulated liquidated damages, \$401.21 in interest, and \$1,156.20 in audit costs due and owing

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- pursuant to the audit conducted of the Company's books and records for the period of November 1, 2007 through December 31, 2008;
- b. For \$17,216.64 representing the accelerated balance of the Note and Guaranty entered into to by Defendants to pay all delinquencies owed to the Funds for the period of April through June 2008: \$8,401.47 in benefit contributions to the Welfare Fund; \$5,945.73 in contributions to the Pension Fund; and \$2,869.44 in associated liquidated damages; and
- c. For \$2,875.00 representing attorneys' fees and costs.
- 2. Defendants are to pay post judgment interest in all amounts due from the date of judgment until the judgment is satisfied.
