JUDGMENT

This matter coming before the Honorable Judge Mary Ellen Coghlan on the Public Guardian's Default Prove-up on the Petition for a Citation to Recover Assets against John Willis and CARSBM, (inc.), James Burton appearing on behalf of the Public Guardian, this Court having jurisdiction and being fully advised in the premises:

THE COURT FINDS THAT:

1. This Court ordered Citations to Recover Assets to issue against John Willis and CARSBM on July 17, 2008.
2. Personal jurisdiction over John Willis and CARSBM, inc. was effectuated via personal service on September 3, 2008.
3. For the purpose of this Default Prove-up against John Willis and CARSBM, all of the counts of the Petition for a Citation Recover Assets are deemed true only to John Willis and CARSBM, but are not deemed as true to any other respondent.
4. On November 19, 2009, this Court entered an Order of Default against John Willis and CARSBM, Inc. for their failure to answer the Citation to Recover Assets.
5. On December 17, 2009, a Notice of Order was entered thereby establishing that the Orders of Default were mailed to the respondents at their last known addresses.
6. John Willis a 38-year-old man who is married to a cousin of Lloyd Lewis. Willis is employed as a car salesman, and started an internet car sales business named CARSBM, Inc.

6(B) A closing occurred on or about 4/13/2007 and Willis and CARSBM received proceeds totaling over \$144,000⁰⁰ was distributed to Willis + CARSBM

7. At the closing of the real property, Willis and CARSBM received two checks totaling \$144,261.51.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. A money judgment against John Willis shall be entered in the amount or \$144,261.51, and
2. A money judgment against CARSBM shall be entered in the amount of \$144,261.51.
