
1. Owner(s) now holds title to that certain real property in the County Cook, State of Illinois (the "Property"), to wit:

All of the labor and materials furnished and delivered by Claimant were furnished to and used in connection with the improvement of the Property, and the last of such labor and materials was furnished, delivered and performed, and the work contemplated under the Contract completed, on or about May 29, 2009.
- 5. There is now justly due and owing the Claimant after allowing to the Owner's Agent all credits, deductions and offsets, the sum of **Nineteen Hundred Dollars & 00/100** (\$1,900.00) plus interest at the rate specified in the Illinois Mechanics Lien Act.
