
Proceedings on Request for Relief

The court reserves jurisdiction of this matter for the purposes of modification, enforcement, or termination of this Agreed Order, including the adjudication of proceedings for contempt or default fines, which could result in the imposition of a fine and/or incarceration, and reinstatement of City's Complaint.
- 10. This matter is hereby dismissed by agreement of the parties, without prejudice, subject to the "greement detailed above. This order is final and enforceable, the court finding no just cause or reason to delay its enforcement. A!! parties to this agreement waive their right to appeal this Agreed Order.
