## UNIFORM COVENANTS. Borrower and Lender covenant and agree as follows

Payment of Principal, Interest, Escrow Items, Prepayment Charges, and Lo.e Charges. Borrower shall pay when due the principal of, and interest on, the debt evidenced by the Note and any prepayment c argues and late charges due under the Note. Borrower shall also pay funds for Escrow Items pursuant to Section 3. Payments due and r the Note and this Security Instrument shall be made in U.S. currency. However, if any check or other instrument received by Lender as payment under the Note or this Security Instrument is returned to Lender unpaid, Lender may require that any or all subsequent payments due under the Note and this Security Instrument be made in one or more of the following forms, as selected by Lender: (a) cash; (b) money order; (c) certified check, bank check, treasurer's check or cashier's check, provided any such check is drawn upon an institution whose deposits are insured by a federal agency, instrumentality, or entity; or (d) Electronic image range.

Payments are deemed received by Lender when received at the location designated in the Note or at such cahe, location as may be designated by Lender in accordance with the notice provisions in Section 15. Lender may return any payment a partial payment if the payment or partial payments are insufficient to bring the Loan current. Lender may accept any payment or partial payment insufficient to bring the Loan current, without waiver of any rights hereunder or prejudice to its rights to refuse such payment or partial payments in the future, but Lender is not obligated to apply such payments at the time such payments are accepted. If each Periodic Payment is applied as of its scheduled due date, then Lender need not pay interest on unapplied funds. Lender may hold such unapplied funds until Borrower makes payment to bring the Loan current. 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Application of Payments or Proceeds. 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Community Association Dues, Fees, and Assessments, if any. To the extent that these items are Escrow Items, Borrower shall pay them in the manner provided in Section 3.

Borrower shall promptly discharge any lien which has priority over this Security Instrument unless Borrower: (a) agrees in writing to the payment of the obligation secured by the lien in a manner acceptable to Lender, but only so long as Borrower is performing such agreement; (b) contests the lien in good faith by, or defends against enforcement of the lien in, legal proceedings which in Lender's opinion operate to prevent the enforcement of the lien while those proceedings are pending, but only until such proceedings are concluded; or (c) secures from the holder of the lien an agreement satisfactory to Lender subordinating the lien to this Security Instrument. If Lender determines that any part of the Property is subject to a lien which can attain priority over this Security Instrument, Lender may give Borrower a notice identifying the lien. Borrower shall keep the improvements now existing or hereafter erected on the Property insured against loss by are, hazards included within the term "extended coverage," and any other hazards including, but not limited to, earthquakes and fireds, for which Lender requires insurance. This insurance shall be maintained in the amounts (including deductible levels) and for the periods that Lender requires. What Lender requires pursuant to the preceding sentences can change during the term of the Loa. The insurance carrier providing the insurance shall be chosen by Borrower subject to Lender's right to disapprove Borrower's choice, which right shall not be exercised unreasonably. Lender may require Borrower to pay, in connection with this Loan, either: (a) a one-time charge for flood zone determination, certification and tracking services; or (b) a one-time charge for flood zone determination and certification services and subsequent charges each time remappings or similar changes occur which reasonally might affect such determination or certification. Borrower shall also be responsible for the payment of any fees imposed by the Faueral Emergency Management Agency in connection with the review of any flood zone determination resulting from an objection by Borrower.

All insurance policies required by Lender and renewals of such grainless shall be subject to Lender's right to disapprove such policies, shall include a standard mortgage clause, and shall name Lender as mortgage and/or as an additional loss payee. Lender shall have the right to hold the policies and renewal certificates. If Lender requires, Borrower shall promptly give to Lender all receipts of paid premiums and renewal notices. Such loss reserve shall be non-refundable, notwithstanding the fact that the Loan is ultimately paid in full, and Lender shall not be required to pay Borrower any interest or

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earnings on such loss reserve. Lender can no longer require loss reserve payments if Mortgage Insurance coverage (in the amount and for the period that Lender requires) provided by an insurer selected by Lender again becomes available, is obtained, and Lender requires separately designated payments toward the premiums for Mortgage Insurance. In the event of a partial taking, destruction, or loss in value of the Property in which the fair market ratus of the Property immediately before the partial taking, destruction, or loss in value is equal to or greater than the amount of the sums secured by this Security Instrument immediately before the partial taking, destruction, or loss in value, unless Borrower and Lendus otherwise agree in writing, the sums secured by this Security Instrument shall be reduced by the amount of the Miscella eo is Proceeds multiplied by the following fraction: (a) the total amount of the sums secured immediately before the partial taking, up are tion, or loss in value divided by (b) the fair market value of the Property immediately before the partial taking, destruction, or to s in value. 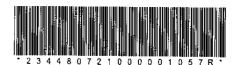
