

The Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (I'linois EPA) has reviewed the Corrective Action Completion Report submitted for the above-referenced incident. This information was dated November 1, 2011, and was received by the Illinois EPA on November 2, 2011. Citations in this letter are from the Environmental Protection Act (Act), as amended by Public Act 92-0554 on June 24, 2002, and Public Act 96-0908 on June 8, 2010, and 35 Illinois Administrative Code (35 Ill. The Corrective Action Completion Report and associated Licens at Professional Engineer Certification submitted pursuant to Section 57.7(b)(5) of the Act and 35 Ill. Adm.
