THIS MODIFICATION OF MORTGAGE dated April 5, 2012, is made and executed between TED MAVRAKIS aka THEODORE G. 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2012 (such maturity date as it hereafter may be renewed, extended or amended from time to time, herein called the "Maturity Date"); provided, such Maturity Date shall not be later than Twenty (20) years after the date hereof; (x) that certain Promissory Note dated September 5, 2010, in the original principal amount of \$1,002,621.06 executed by TM Building LLC payable to Lender, as amended, supplemented, modified or replaced from time to time. The interest rate on the Note is five and one half percent (5.50%) per annum. Interest on the unpaid principal balance of the Note will be computed on a 365/360 basis; that is, by applying the ratio of the interest rate over a year of 360 days, multiplied by the outstanding principal balance, multiplied by the actual number of days the principal balance is outstanding. Payment of all interest and principal due on the Note is due no later than September 5, 2013 (such maturity date as it hereafter may be renewed, extended or amended from time to time, herein called the "Maturity Date"); provided, such Maturity Date shall not be later than Twenty (20) years after the date hereof; (xi) that certain Promissory Note dated September 5, 2010, in the original principal amount of \$1,608,738.61 executed by 1040 S. Milwaukee, LLC payable to Lender, as amended, supplemented, modified or replaced from time to time. The interest rate on the Note is five and one half percent (5.50%) per annum. Interest on the unpaid principal balance of the Note will be computed on a 365/360 basis; that is, by applying the ratio of the interest rate over a year of 360 days, multiplied by the outstanding principal balance, multiplied by the actual number of days the principal balance is outstanding. Payment of all interest and principal due on the Note is due no later than September 5, 2013 (such maturity date as it hereafter may be renewed, extended or amended from time to time, herein called the "Maturity Date"); provided, such Maturity Date shall not be later than Twenty (20) years after the date hereof.

CONTINUING VALIDITY. Except as expressly modified above, the terms of the original Mortgage shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect and are legally valid, binding, and enforceable in accordance with their respective terms. Consent by Lender to this Modification does not waive Lender's right to require strict performance of the Mortgage as changed above nor obligate Lender to make any future modifications. Nothing in this Modification shall constitute a satisfaction of the promissory note or other credit agreement secured by the Mortgage (the "Note"). It is the intention of Lender to retain as liable all parties to the Mortgage and all parties, makers and endorsers to the Note, including accommodation parties, unless a party is expressly released by Lender in writing. Any maker or endorser, including accommodation makers, shall not be released by virtue of this Modification. If any person who signed the original Mortgage does not sign this Modification, then all persons signing below acknowledge that this Modification is given conditionally, based on the representation to Lender that the non-signing person consents to the changes and provisions of this Modification or otherwise will not be released by it. This waiver applies not only to any initial extension or modification, but also to all such subsequent actions.

WAIVER. GRANTOR HEREBY EXPRESSLY AND UNCONDITIONALLY WAIVES AND RELINQUISHES:

(1) ANY RIGHT TO TRIAL BY JURY IN ANY ACTION OR PROCEEDING (i) TO ENFORCE OR DEFEND ANY RIGHTS UNDER OR IN CONNECTION WITH THIS AGREEMENT OR ANY AMENDMENT, INSTRUMENT, DOCUMENT OR AGREEMENT DELIVERED OR WHICH MAY BE DELIVERED RELATED TO THIS AGREEMENT OR (ii) ARISING FROM ANY DISPUTE OR CONTROVERSY IN CONNECTION WITH, IN FURTHERANCE OF, OR RELATED TO THIS AGREEMENT OR ANY AMENDMENT, INSTRUMENT, DOCUMENT OR AGREEMENT RELATED THERETO, AND AGREES THAT ANY SUCH ACTION OR PROCEEDING SHALL BE TRIED BEFORE A JUDGE AND NOT A JURY;

(2) EVERY DEFENSE, INCLUDING, WITHOUT LIMITATION, BREACH OF THE IMPLIED COVENANT OF GOOD FAITH AND FAIR DEALING, AND ANY CAUSE OF ACTION, COUNTERCLAIM OR SETOFF WHICH GRANTOR MAY HAVE TO ANY ACTION BY LENDER IN ENFORCING THIS AGREEMENT OR ANY DOCUMENT EXECUTED IN CONNECTION WITH, RELATED TO, OR IN FURTHERANCE OF THIS AGREEMENT.

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GRANTOR ACKNOWLEDGES HAVING READ ALL THE PROVISIONS OF THIS MODIFICATION OF MORTGAGE AND GRANTOR AGREES TO ITS TERMS. THIS MODIFICATION OF MORTGAGE IS DATED APRIL 5, 2012.

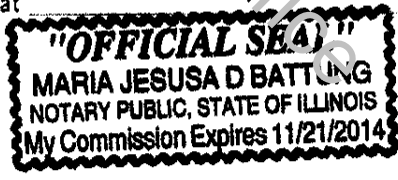

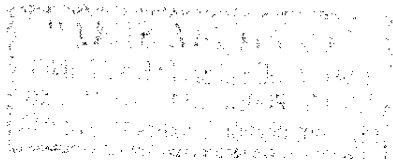
