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

I, DeeAnn E. Payne, have read the attached power of attorney and am the person identified as the [Agent] for the Principal. I hereby acknowledge that when I act as [Agent] or "attorney-in-fact", I am given power under this Durable Enduring Power of Attorney to make decisions about money, property, or both belonging to the Principal, and to spend the Principal's money, property, or both on the Principal's behalf, in accordance with the terms of this Durable Enduring Power of Attorney. This Durable Enduring Power of Attorney is valid only if the Principal is of sound mind when the Principal signs it. When acting in the capacity of agent, I am under a duty [called "fiduciary duty"] to observe the standards observed by a prudent person, which means the use of those powers that is reasonable in view of the interests of the Principal and in view of the way in which a person of ordinary judgment would act in carrying out that person's own affairs.
