The Illinois Environmental Protection Age: cy (Illinois EPA) has reviewed the Corrective Action Completion Report submitted for the above-referenced incident. This information was dated August 7, 2012 and was received by the Illinois EPA on August 9, 2012. Citations in this letter are from the Environmental Protection Act (Act), as amended by Tublic Act 92-0554 on June 24, 2002, and Public Act 96-0908 on June 8, 2010, and 35 Illinois Administrative Code (35 Ill. Adm. Code).

The Corrective Action Completion Report and associated Licensed Professional Engineer Certification submitted pursuant to Section 57.7(b)(5) of the Act and 35 Ill. Adm. Code 734.135(d) indicate corrective action for the above-referenced site was conducted in accordance with the Corrective Action Plan approved by the Illinois EPA. The Corrective Action Completion Report demonstrates that the requirements of Section 57.7(b) of the Act have been satisfied.

Based upon the certification by Nathan Douglas Johnson, a Licensed Professional Engineer, and pursuant to Section 57.10 of the Act (415 ILCS 5/57.10), your request for a no further remediation determination is granted under the conditions and terms specified in this letter.

Issuance of this No Further Remediation Letter (Letter), based on the certification of the Licensed Professional Engineer, signifies that: (1) all statutory and regulatory corrective action requirements applicable to the occurrence have been complied with; (2) all corrective action concerning the remediation of the occurrence has been completed; and (3) no further corrective action concerning the occurrence is necessary for the protection of human health, safety, and the environment. Pursuant to Section 57.10(d) of the Act, this Letter shall apply in favor of the following parties:

In addition, the Groundwater Ordinance (photocopy attached) must be filed as an attachment of this Letter with the Office of the Recorder or Registrar of Titles of the applicable county. This Letter shall not be effective until officially recorded by the Office of the Recorder or Registrar of Titles of the applicable county in accordance with Illinois law so it forms a remanent part of the chain of title for the above-referenced property. Within 30 days of this Letter being recorded, an accurate and official copy of this Letter, as recorded, shall be obtained and submitted to the Illinois EPA. For recording purposes, it is recommended that the Leaking Underground Storage Tank Environmental Notice of this Letter be the first page of the instrument filed.

### Highway Authority F greement:

Illinois Department Of Transportation (IDOT) agrees, through the use of a Highway Authority Agreement, to allow contaminated groundwater and/or soil to remain beneath its highway right-of-way adjacent to the site located at 6705 West Cermak Rd., Berwyn, Litriois. Specifically, as shown on the attached map, contamination will remain in the right-of-way for Cermak Rd. as indicated in the Highway Authority Agreement # HAA 1218. The Highway Authority agrees to: (a) prohibit the use of groundwater under the highway right-of-way that is contaminated above Tier 1 groundwater remediation objectives as a potable or other domestic supply of water, and (b) limit access to soil contamination under the highway right of-way that is contaminated above residential Tier 1 soil remediation objectives. The following activities shall be grounds for voidance of the ordinance as an institutional control and this Letter:

- 5. Failure to establish, operate, and maintain controls in full compliance with the Act, applicable regulations, and no approved corrective action plan, if applicable, may result in voidance of this Letter.

ORDINANCE NO. <u>06-12</u>

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE USE
OF GROUNDWATER AS A POTABLE
WATER SUPPLY BY THE INSTALLATION
OR USE OF POTABLE WATER SUPPLY
WELLS OR BY ANY OTHER METHOD IN THE
CITY OF BERWYN, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, certain properties in the City of Berwyn, Illinois have been used over a period of time for commercial/ir distrial purposes; and

WHEREAS, because of said use, conventrations of certain chemical constituents in the groundwater beneath the City of Berwyn may exceed Class I groundwater quality standards for potable resource groundwater as set forth in 35 Illinois Administrative Code 620 or Tier 1 remediation objectives as set forth in 35 Illinois Administrative Code 742; and

WHEREAS, the City of Berwyn desires to limit potential threats to human health from groundwater contamination while facilitating the redevelopment and productive use of properties that are the source of said chemical constituents.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BERWYN, ILLINOIS:

### SECTION 1: The use of groundwater as a potable water supply prohibited.

Except for such uses or methods in existence before the effective date of this ordinance, the use of, or attempted use of, groundwater from within the corporate limits of the City of Berwyn, as a potable water supply, by the installation or drilling of wells or by any other method, is hereby prohibited. This prohibition expressly includes the City of Berwyn.

#### SECTION 2: Peralties.

Any person violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be subject to a fine of up to Five Hundred Dollars and no.100 (\$500.00) per day, for each violation.

#### SECTION 3: Definitions.

"Person" is any individual, partnership, co-partnership, firm, company, limited liability company, corporation, association, joint stock company, trust, estate, political subdivision, or any other legal entity, or their legal representatives, agents or assigns.

"Potable water" is any water used for human or domestic consumption, including, but not limited to, water used for drinking, bathing, swimming, washing dishes, or preparing foods.

### SECTION 4: Repealer.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed insofar as they are in conflict with this ordinance, specifically Ordinance No. 1042.25 is hereby repealed and replaced by this ordinance.
