- 3. Plaintiff has satisfactorily proven all elements of Counts I-IV of the Complaint.

  It Is Hereby Ordered That:
- 1. A Final Judgment is entered in favor of the Plaintiff and against Illinois Trading Co., in the amount of \$184,271.13, plus further accruing interest.
- 2. A Final Judgment is entered in favor of the Plaintiff and against Illinois Trading Co., the Obee Family Partnership, and Lawrence N. Oberman, jointly and severally, in the current amount \$46,812.23, plus further accruing interest.
- 3. That the above-referenced sum of \$46,812.33 represents PACA trust assets, which are rightfully Plaintiff's property. See Perishable Agricultural Commodities Act, 1930, 7 U.S.C. §§ 499a-499t, as amended (2009 & Supp. 2011)
- 4. A permanent injunction is granted prohibiting Defendants Illinois Trading Co., Lawrence N. Oberman, and the Obee Family Partnership, their respective agents, and any of their banking institutions from paying, withdrawing, transfer in g. assigning, or selling PACA trust assets, including from Illinois Trading Company's, Oberman's, and the Obee Family Partnership's bank accounts, moneys that would reduce the balance in the accounts below \$46,812.33. In finding that the facts support this injunction, the Court again considered the initial TRO motion, the Affidavit of Kyle Jensen filed in support of that motion, the remainder of the record, as well as the in-court answers to questions posed by the Court during the first TRO hearing, and now also rads to those facts the facts deemed admitted in the complaint (in light of Defendants' default).
