THIS ORDINANCE MAY BE CITED AS VILLAGE ORDINANCE NUMBER

13-3-Z-3968

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING A SPECIAL USE PERMIT FOR THE OUTDOOR SALE OF PROPANE AT 3626 TOUHY AVENUE, SKOKIE, ILLINOIS IN A B2 COMMERCIAL DISTRICT

WHEREAS, CSD Touhy, LLC, the owner of the following described real property:

LOT 1 IN TOURY MARKETPLACE SUBDIVISION, BEING A SUBDIVISION OF THAT PART OF THE WEST HALF OF THE SOUTHEAST QUARTER AND EAST HALF OF THE SOUTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 26, TOWNSHIP 41 NORTH, RANGE 13, EAST OF THE THIRD PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN, IN COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS.

PINS: 10-26-318-020, 10-26-318-029, 10-26-318-032, 10-26-318-033, 10-26-318-034, 10-26-318-035, 10-26-402-019, 10-26-402-032, 10-26-402-034, 10-26-402-035, 10-26-402-055, 10-26-412-025

more commonly described as 3626 Touny Avenue, Skokie, Illinois (the "Subject Property"), petitioned the Village of Skokie for a special use permit for the outdoor sale of propane in a B2 Commercial district; and

WHEREAS, the Subject Property is the future site of the proposed Walmart store. The outdoor propane sale area will be located by the southern entrance to the store and south of the six proposed soft drink vending machines previously approved in Village Ordinance Number 12-5-Z-3904; and

WHEREAS, the display would consist of two cages containing three propane tanks each. Both cages would be locked at all times and will be accessed only by Walmart employees at the time of sale; and

WHEREAS, the Skokie Plan Commission, at a public hearing duly neid on December 6, 2012, for which proper legal notice had been achieved and no interested parties appeared, heard testimony from Village staff and the petitioner; and

WHEREAS, the propane would be available for sale during all hours of operation of the Walmart store and, based upon questions from Commissioners, the petitioner and Village staff stated the following:

- (i) the sale of propane was common at other Walmart stores,
- (ii) the tanks would not be refilled at the store as the customer would return the empty tank to Walmart and it would be picked up and refilled off-site,
- (iii) no permit from the Fire Department was required; and

WHEREAS, following all testimony and discussion, the Plan Commission (a) made the appropriate findings of fact as required under Section 118-32 of the Skokie Village Code and (b)

voted to recommend to the Mayor and Board of Trustees that the requested special use permit be granted subject to the conditions contained in the Plan Commission Report dated February 19, 2013; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Board of Trustees, at a public meeting duly held on February 19, 2013, concurred in the aforesaid recommendations and findings of fact of the Skokie Plan Commission;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Board of Trustees of the Village of Skokie, Cook County, Illinois:

That the special use permit requested by the petitioner for the outdoor sale Section 1: of propane at the Subject Property, described above and commonly known as 3626 Touhy Avenue, Skokie, Illinois, in a B2 Commercial district be and the same is hereby granted and approved subject to each of the conditions set forth below:

- The patitioner shall operate and maintain the outdoor propane sales area in substantial conformance with the Front Sidewalk Plan, dated October 31, 2012;
- All propage sales shall be limited to the 2 storage cages, each of which shall 2. contain a total of 3 tanks, and both cages shall be locked at all times and only be accessed by the employees of Walmart;
- The petitioners shall comply with all Federal and State statutes, laws, rules and 3. regulations and all Village codes, ordinances, rules, and regulations;
- Failure to abide by any and all terms of this Ordinance shall be cause for the 4. Village to initiate hearings to determine whether the subject Ordinance, as well as any applicable business licenses, should be revised or revoked; and
- The petitioners shall pay all costs related to any hearings conducted as a result of 5. non-compliance with any of the provisions of the enabling ordinance. The costs shall include but not be limited to court renewer fees, attorney fees, and staff time required researching and conducting said hearing

That a notice of the approval of this Ordinance incorporating the Section 2: conditions contained herein shall be executed by the owner of the property in writing and duly recorded with the Cook County Recorder of Deeds Office at the owner's expense.

That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and recordation as provided by law.
