THIS ORDINANCE MAY BE CITED AS VILLAGE ORDINANCE NUMBER

13-8-Z-4001

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING A SPECIAL USE PERMIT TO ESTABLISH AND OPERATE A LIMITED SERVICE RESTAURANT WITH A DRIVE-THROUGH FACILITY AT 3316 TOUHY AVENUE, SKOKIE, ILLINOIS IN A B2 COMMERCIAL DISTRICT

WHEREPS, the owner ("Petitioner") of the following described real property:

LOT 4 IN SKOKIE COMMONS SUBDIVISION, BEING A SUBDIVISION OF THAT PART OF THE SOUTHEAST QUARTER OF SECTION 26, TOWNSHIP 41 NORTH, RANGE 13, EAST OF THE CHIRD PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN, IN COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS

PIN: 10-26-403-002-0000

more commonly described as 3316 Touhy Avenue, Skokie, Illinois (the "Subject Property"), petitioned the Village of Skokie for a special use permit to establish and operate a limited service restaurant with a drive-through facility in an B2 Commercial district; and

WHEREAS, the anticipated limited service restaurant tenant at 3316 Touhy Avenue is part of a larger planned development which will include Mariano's Fresh Foods grocery store; and

WHEREAS, the drive-through window is expected to be located on the west side of the building. According to the traffic study submitted by the Petitioners, the stacking for seven (7) vehicles to the pick-up window of the drive-through along with eight (8) more vehicles to the menu board is sufficient and will not impede or obstruct pedestrian or vehicular movement; and

WHEREAS, the Skokie Plan Commission, at a public hearing only held on June 6, 2013, for which proper legal notice had been achieved and no interested parties appeared, (a) made the appropriate findings of fact as required under Section 118-32 of the Strokie Village Code and (b) voted to recommend to the Mayor and Board of Trustees that the requested special use permit be granted, subject to the conditions contained in the Plan Commission Report dated August 5, 2013; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Board of Trustees, at a public meeting duly held on August 5, 2013, concurred in the aforesaid recommendations and findings of fact of the Skokie Plan Commission;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Board of Trustees of the Village of Skokie, Cook County, Illinois:

Section 1: That the special use permit requested by the petitioner to establish and operate a limited service restaurant with a drive-through facility at the Subject Property,

described above and commonly known as 3316 Touhy Avenue, Skokie, Illinois, in a B2 Commercial district be and the same is hereby granted and approved subject to each of the conditions set forth below:

- 1. The petitioner shall develop the Subject Property in substantial conformance with the final Village approved site plans dated July 26, 2013, landscape plans dated August 13, 2013, sign plans dated April 23, 2013 and May 1, 2013, and building elevations dated April 23, 2013.
- 2. Any outdoor sound systems shall at all times maintain audio levels that are compliant with the Skokie Village Code.
- 3. All objects and landscaping within a 15-foot sight distance triangle shall not exceed 30 inches in height, except traffic control devices listed in the Manual on Uniform Fraffic Control Devices.
- 4. Waste receptucles shall be placed on the Subject Property for the use of customers, and that the Health Department shall determine the size, type, and location of these units.
- 5. All signage shall conform to the Skokie Village Code, or per the relief granted. Any sign on the Subject Property that is in violation of that Code must be removed or modified to conform with the Village Code prior to the issuance of an occupancy permit.
- 6. The petitioner shall comply with all Federal and State statutes, laws, rules and regulations and all Village codes, ordinances, rules, and regulations.
- 7. Failure to abide by any and all terms of this Ordinance shall be cause for the Village to initiate hearings to determine whether the subject Ordinance, as well as any applicable business licenses, should be revised or revoked. The petitioner shall pay all costs related to any hearings conducted as a result of non-compliance with any of the provisions of the enabling ordinance. The costs shall include but not be limited to court reporter fees, attorney fees, and staff time required researching and conducting said hearing.
- 8. The petitioner shall implement any necessary operational improvements to ensure that stacking of vehicles within the drive-through lane will not impede or obstruct pedestrian or vehicular movements.
- 9. A screened garbage corral with an impermeable surface shall be provided to contain all dumpsters.
- 10. At least once during every 4 hours of operation and before opening and closing of the business, employees shall patrol the Subject Property and clear it of debris.
- 11. The sale of open alcoholic beverages at carryout restaurants is prohibited.

<u>Section 2</u>: That a notice of the approval of this Ordinance incorporating the conditions contained herein shall be executed by the owner of the property in writing and duly recorded with the Cook County Recorder of Deeds Office at the owner's expense.
