# AN ORDINANCE GRANTING A SPECIAL USE PERMIT TO ALLOW PACKAGED LIQUOR SALES AT 3358 TOUHY AVENUE, SKOKIE, ILLINOIS IN A B2 COMMERCIAL DISTRICT

**WHEREAS**, the owner of the following described real property:

LOT 1 IN SKONT COMMONS SUBDIVISION, BEING A SUBDIVISION OF THAT PART OF THE SOUTHEAST QUAPTER OF SECTION 26, TOWNSHIP 41 NORTH, RANGE 13, EAST OF THE THIRD PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN, IN COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS.

PIN: 10-26-403-002-0007

more commonly described as 3557 Touhy Avenue, Skokie, Illinois (the "Subject Property"), petitioned the Village of Skokie ter a special use permit to allow packaged liquor sales in a B2 Commercial district; and

WHEREAS, this case was presented to the Skokie Plan Commission in conjunction with ten (10) companion cases; 2013-10P thru 20.3-13, and 2013-15P thru 2013-20P, all pertaining to the proposed Skokie Commons development which will include a Mariano's Fresh Market grocery store (hereinafter "Mariano's"); and

WHEREAS, in 2008, the Mayor and Board of Trustees created the Class O liquor license for retail establishments that only sell liquor to be consumer of premises, commonly referred to as packaged liquor establishments; and

**WHEREAS**, on January 18, 2011, Ordinance Number 11-1.3814 was adopted which created a new category of the O license, OL ("L" for Large), for retailers that sell liquor only for consumption off-premises and have over 40,000 square feet of total retail space with no minimum or maximum square footage required to be dedicated to the sale of liquor; and

**WHEREAS**, Mariano's is anticipated to have a total square footage of approximately 71,310 ft<sup>2</sup>.

**WHEREAS**, Mariano's is desirous of the ability to sell packaged liquor at retail and prior to submitting an application to the Skokie Liquor Commissioner, a special use permit is required since it will be located in a B2 Commercial district. Mariano's currently sells liquor at its other ten (10) locations in the Chicagoland area; and

**WHEREAS**, the sale of packaged liquor is a common practice at other grocery stores in the area. The Subject Property is entirely surrounded by commercial and industrial uses. Hours of sale shall be in accordance with the state and local laws; and

WHEREAS, the Skokie Plan Commission, at a public hearing duly held on June 6, 2013, for which proper legal notice had been achieved and no interested parties appeared, (a) made the

appropriate findings of fact as required under Section 118-8.(a)(1) of the Skokie Village Code and (b) voted to recommend to the Mayor and Board of Trustees that the requested special use permit be granted subject to the conditions contained in the Plan Commission Report dated December 2, 2013; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Board of Trustees, at a public meeting duly held on December 2, 2013, concurred in the aforesaid recommendations and findings of fact of the Skokie Plan Commission;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Mayor and Board of Trustees of the Village of Skokie, Cook County, Illinois:

Section 1: That the special use permit requested by the petitioner to allow packaged liquor sales at the Subject Property, described above and commonly known as 3358 Touhy Avenue, Skokic, Minois, in a B2 Commercial district, be and the same is hereby granted and approved subject to each of the conditions set forth below:

- 1. Any charge in the business ownership or operator of the liquor sales from Mariano's snall cause the subject Special Use Permit to cease, unless it is determined that it is appropriate for administrative review;
- 2. The petitioner shall comply with all Federal and State statutes, laws, rules and regulations and all village codes, ordinances, rules, and regulations;
- 3. Failure to abide by any and all terms of this Ordinance shall be cause for the Village to initiate hearings α determine whether the subject Ordinance, as well as any applicable business licens and should be revised or revoked; and
- 4. The petitioner shall pay all costs related to any hearings conducted as a result of non-compliance with any of the provisions of the enabling ordinance. The costs shall include but not be limited to court reporter fees, attorney fees, and staff time required researching and conducting said hearing.

Section 2: That a notice of the approval of this Ordinance incorporating the conditions contained herein shall be executed by the owner of the property in writing and duly recorded with the Cook County Recorder of Deeds Office at the owner's expense.

Section 3: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and recordation as provided by law.
