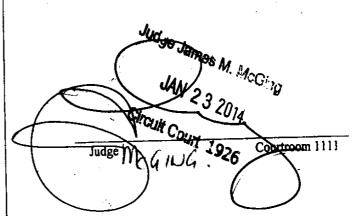
Penalties

- Should Defendant(s) fail to comply with any provision of this Agreed Order, City may petition the Court to enforce this Agreed Order. Defendant(s) shall be subject to the following specified penalties for failure to comply as determined by this Court. This list is not exclusive, and the Court may order other appropriate remedies upon petition by City, including the appointment of a receiver to make roairs and/or reinstatement of the case.
 - (a) Default Fines
 - Defendant(s) soul follow the compliance schedule set forth above and shall be subject to fines of \$500.00 per day for each violation of the Municipal Code of Chicago that exists past the due date. Such fines shall be calculated from the first day Defendant(s) violate(s) the compliance schedule, and shall continue to run until Defendant(s) bring(s) the violation(s) into compliar ce.
 - [] Further, if the premises are found not to be secured (as required by the Municipal Code of Chicago) after entry of this Agreed Order, Defendant(s) chall be subject to a lump-sum default fine in the amount of \$5,000.00.
 - (b) Contempt of Court

This order is final and enforceable pursuant to Illinois Supreme Court Rule 304(a), the court finding no just cause or reason to delay its enforcement.
