## <u>ORDER</u>

Bill of Costs [90] is granted. The Court awards Defendant United Airlines, Inc. \$6,613.81 in costs.

## **STATEMENT**

Defendant filed the instant Bill of Costs on December 2, 2013. To date, however, Plaintiff Ricardo Tovar has not responded. Fursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 54(d), the Court grants Defendant United Airlines, Inc 's ("Defendant") Bill of Costs in the amount of \$6,613.81. "There is a presumption that the prevaining party will recover costs, and the losing party bears the burden of an affirmative showing that the ded costs are not appropriate." Beamon v. Marshall & Ilsley Trust Co., 411 F.3d 854, 864 (7th Cir. 2005) (citing M.T. Bonk Co. v. Milton Bradley Co., 945 F.2d 1404, 1409 (7th Cir. 1991)); sec also Rivera v. City of Chi., 469 F.3d 631, 634 (7th Cir. 2006); Weeks v. Samsung Heavy Indus. Co., 126 F.3d 926, 945 (7th Cir. 1997) ("The presumption in favor of awarding costs to the prevailing party is difficult to overcome, and the district court's discretion is narrowly confined-the court must award costs unless it states good reasons for denying them." (citing Congregation of the Passion, Holy Cross Province v. Touche, Ross & Co., 854 F.2d 219, 222 (7th Cir. 1988))). When re riewing a bill of costs, "[a] district court simply needs to determine that expenses are allowable of the reasonable and necessary." Deimer v. Cincinnati Sub-Zero Prods., Inc., 58 F.3d 341, 345 (7th Cir. 1995).
