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MORTGAGE, SECURITY AGREEMENT AND FINANCING STATEMENT

THIS MORTGAGE, SECURITY AGREEMENT AND FINANCING STATEMENT (the "Mortgage") is dated March 5th, 2014, by and between CREW DEVELOPMENT, LLC, an Illinois limited liability company (herein referred to as the "Mortgagor"), and 223 REAL ESTATE, LLC, an Illinois limited liability company at 734 Melrose Street, Chicago, IL 60657 (herein referred to as the "Mortgagee").

WITNESSETH

THAT THE REAS on March 5th, 2014, Mortgagor executed a Promissory Note payable to Mortgagee in the amount of Three Handred Fourteen Thousand Dollars 00/100 DOLLARS (\$ 314,000) (the "Note"). The entire remaining balance of principal and interest is due on or before September 1, 2014.

NOW THEREFORE, the Mortgagor, to secure the payment of the Indebtedness (hereafter defined) including interest and late charges in accordance with the terms, provisions and limitations of this Mortgage and of the Note, and the performance of the covenans and agreements herein contained by the Mortgagor to be performed, and also in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, does by these presents mortgage, grant, remise, release. It is and convey unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, all interest in real estate located in the County of Cook and State of Illinois as more fully described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and made a part hereof which, with the property hereinalter described, is collectively referred to herein as the "Premises."

This Mortgage shall also secure any and all renewals or extensions of the whole or any part of the Indebtedness hereby secured however evidenced, with interest at such any larger as may be agreed upon, and any such renewals or extensions or any change in the terms or rate of interest shall not impair in any manner the validity or priority of this Mortgage, nor release the Mortgagor from personal liability for the Indebtedness (hereafter defined) hereby secured.

TOGETHER with all improvements, tenements, reversions remainders, easements, fixtures and appurtenances now or hereafter thereto belonging, and all rents, issues and profits there if for so long and during all such times as Mortgagor may be entitled thereto (which are pledged primarily and in a parity with said real estate and not secondarily); all tenant security deposits, utility deposits, common area maintenance charges, real estate tax and insurance premium deposits and insurance premium rebates to which Mortgagor may be entitled or which Mortgagor may now or hereafter have therein or thereon, including (without restricting the for going): all fixtures, apparatus, equipment and articles (other than tenant trade fixtures which relate to the use, occupancy and enjoyment of the Premises) used to supply heat, gas, air conditioning, water, light, power, sprinklet protection, waste removal, refrigeration and ventilation (whether single units or centrally controlled), it being understood that the enumeration of any specific articles of property shall in no way exclude or be held to exclude any items of property not specifically mentioned. All of the land, estate and property hereinabove described, real, personal and mixed, whether affixed or annexed or not (except where otherwise hereinabove specified) and all rights hereby conveyed and in ratgaged are intended so to be as a unit and are hereby understood, agreed and declared (to the maximum extent permuted by law) to form part and parcel of the real estate and to be appropriated to the use of the real estate, and shall be, for any perposes of this Mortgage, decined to be real estate and conveyed and mortgaged hereby.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the Premises unto the Mortgagee and its successors and assigns until all Indebtedness evidenced by the Note is fully discharged, for the purposes and uses herein set forth.

IT IS FURTHER UNDERSTOOD AND AGREED THAT:

shall, to the extent permissible under applicable law: (a) promptly repair, restore or rebuild any buildings or improvements now or hereafter on the Premises which may become damaged or be destroyed to substantially the same character as prior to such damage or destruction, so long as insurance proceeds are sufficient therefor; (b) keep the Premises constantly in good condition and repair, without waste; (c) keep the Premises free from mechanics' liens or other liens or claims for lien not expressly subordinated to the lien hereof (collectively called "Liens") and resulting

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from the acts of the Mortgagor, subject, however, to the rights of the Mortgagor set forth in Paragraph 2 below; (d) immediately pay when due any indebtedness which may be secured by a lien or charge on the Premises on a parity with or superior to the lien hereof, and upon request exhibit satisfactory evidence of the discharge of such lien to Mortgagee, subject, however, to the rights of the Mortgagor set forth in Paragraph 2 below; (e) comply with all existing federal, state and local requirements of law, regulations, ordinances, orders and judgments and all covenants, easements and restrictions of record with respect to the Premises and the use thereof; (f) except as provided in any existing or future leases of the Premises, if any, make no material alterations in the Premises without Mortgagee's prior written consent which consent shall not be unreasonably withheld or delayed; (g) observe and comply with all conditions and requirements (if any) necessary to preserve and extend all rights, easements, licenses, permits (including without limitation, zoning variations and any non-conforming uses and structures), privileges, franchises and concessions applicable to the Premises or contracted for in connection with any present or future use of the Premises; and (h) pay each item of J-debtedness (hereafter defined) secured by this Mortgage when due according to the terms hereof and of the Note.

- Right to Contest. Notwithstanding anything in Paragraphs 4 and 5 of this Mortgage to the contrary, Mortgagor may, in good and and with reasonable diligence, contest the validity or amount of any lien on the Premises, and defer payment and discharge thereof during the pending of such contest, provided that: (a) such contest shall have the effect of preventing the sale or forfeiture of the Premises or any part thereof, or any interest therein, to satisfy such lien; (b) within thirty (30) days after Mortgagor has been notified of the assertion of such lien, Mortgagor shall have notified Mortgagee in writing of Mortgagor's intention to contest such lien; and (c) Mortgagor shall have deposited with Mortgagee at such place as Mortgagee may from time to time in writing appoint, and in the absence of such appointment. then at the office of Mortgagee, a sum of money which shall be sufficient in the reasonable judgment of Mortgagee to pay in full such lien and all interest which might become due thereon, and shall keep on deposit an amount so sufficient at all times, increasing such amount to cover acditoral interest whenever, in the reasonable judgment of Mortgagee, such increase is advisable, until such lien shall be removed, released, or otherwise discharged where upon the funds so deposited shall be promptly returned to Mortgagor, or shall obtain a title endorsement or title indemnity to the lender's title insurance policies of Mortgagee or a surety bond of a surety company reasonably satisfactory to Mortgagee, insuring or bonding Mortgagee against any harm as a result of such contest. Such deposits shall earn interest at no more than commercial money market rates. If Mortgagor shall fail to prose at such contest with reasonable diligence or shall fail to pay the amount of the lien plus any interest finally determined to be due upon the conclusion of such contest, to the extent such amount exceeds the amount which Mortgagee will pay as provided below, or shall fail to maintain sufficient funds on deposit as hereinabove provided or to provide a title endorsement or indomnity or surety bond, Mortgagee may, at its option, apply any money so deposited in payment of or on account of such fien, or that part thereof then unpaid, together with all interest thereon. If the amount of money so deposited shall be in ufficient for the payment in full of such lien, together with all interest thereon, Mortgagor shall forthwith, upon demend deposit with Mortgagee a sum which, when added to the funds then on deposit, shall be sufficient to make such payme t in full. Mortgagee shall, upon the final disposition of such contest, apply any money so deposited in full payment of such lien or that part thereof then unpaid, together with all interest thereon (provided Mortgagor is not then in default hereunder) when so requested in writing by Mortgagor and when furnished by Mortgagor with sufficient funds to make such pagazorani in full and with evidence satisfactory to Mortgagee of the amount of payment to be made and any excess funds so deposited, after payment of the foregoing shall be promptly returned to Mortgagor.
- 3. <u>Indebtedness</u>. "Indebtedness" means all obligations of Mortgager to Mortgagee for payment of any and all amounts due under the Note or this Mortgage, together with any and all other indebtedness now or at any time due and owing from Mortgagor to Mortgagee, howsoever and whensoever arising or created. "Indebtedness" also includes all amounts so described herein and all costs of collection, legal expenses and reasonable outside attorneys' fees incurred or paid by Mortgagee in attempting the collection or enforcement of the Note or this Mortgage, or any extension or modification of this Mortgage, the Note, or the guaranty of the Note, or in any legal proceeding occurring by reason of Mortgagee's being the mortgagee under this Mortgage or any extension or modification thereof or the payee under the Note or any extension or modification thereof, including but not limited to any declaratory judgment action, or in the repossession, custody, sale, lease, assembly or other disposition of any collateral for the Note. Notwithstanding anything contained herein to the contrary, in no event shall the lien of this Mortgage secure outstanding liabilities in excess of two hundred percent (200%) of the original stated principal amount of the Note.

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4. Payment of Taxes. Subject to the provisions hereinafter set forth in Section 5 hereof, Mortgagor shall pay all general taxes before any penalty interest attaches, and shall pay special taxes, special assessments, water charges, sewer service charges, and all other charges against the Premises of any nature whatsoever when due, and shall, upon written request, furnish to Mortgagee duplicate receipts therefor within thirty (30) days following the date of payment. Mortgagor may pay in full "under protest" any tax or assessment which Mortgagor may desire to contest, in the manner provided by law. If Mortgagor does not elect to pay under protest, Mortgagor will post such bond or other security as Mortgagee may reasonably require to protect the lien of this Mortgage.

5. **Tax Deposits.** INTENTIONALLY OMITTED

Insurance. Mortgagor shall keep all buildings and improvements and the Collateral (defined in Paragraph 10 below) now or hereafter situated on said Premises insured (to the extent in each instance such coverage is generally and readily available, at commercially reasonable rates) against loss or damage by fire, lightning, wind storm, hail storm, aircraft, ehicles, smoke, explosion, riot or civil commotion as provided by a standard comprehensive general liability poncy and (to the extent in each instance such coverage is generally and readily available, at commercially reasonable raies) against such other hazards as may reasonably be required by Mortgagee, including without limitation of the generality of the foregoing: (a) rent loss or business interruption insurance to cover losses for not less than twelve (12) months, and (b) flood insurance whenever same is available and, in the reasonable opinion of Mortgagee, such protection is necessary. Mortgagor shall also provide insurance coverage with such limits for injury to and death of any person or damage to property of a combined single limit coverage of not less than the Indebtedness secured hereby. All policies of insurance to be furnished hereunder shall be in forms, companies and amounts reasonably satisfactory to Mortgagee, with waiver of subrogation endorsements and a standard non-contributory mortgagee clause attached to all policies, including a provision requiring that the coverage evidenced thereby shall not be terminated or materially modified without thirty (30) days prior written notice to the Mortgagee. Mortgagor shall deliver a certificate evidencing such coverage, to the Mortge gee and, in the case of insurance about to expire, shall deliver a certificate evidencing renewal not less than twenty-five (25) days prior to their respective dates of expiration. Such insurance may be maintained pursuant to a blanket insurance policy, as reasonably determined by Mortgagor.

Mortgagor shall not take out separate insurance concurrencia form or contributing in the event of loss with that required to be maintained hereunder unless Mortgagee is included thereon under a standard non-contributory mortgagee clause acceptable to Mortgagee. Mortgagor shall immediately notify Mortgagee whenever any such separate insurance is taken out and shall promptly deliver to Mortgagee a certificate evidencing such coverage. In the event of a foreclosure of the lien of this Mortgage, or of a transfer of title to the Premises either in lieta of foreclosure or by purchase at the foreclosure sale, all interest in all insurance policies in force shall pass to Mortgagee, transferee or purchaser, as the case may be, to the extent said policies are assignable under applicable law.

7. Insurance Deposits. INTENTIONALLY OMITTED

8. <u>Mortgagee's Interest In and Use of Tax, Deposits, Insurance Deposits and Late Escrow Account;</u> Security Interest. INTENTIONALLY OMITTED

Event of Default has occurred hereunder or under the terms of the Note, such insurance proceeds shall be applied to pay for the cost of repair, rebuilding or restoration of the buildings and other improvements on the Premises. If the Mortgagee makes said proceeds available to reimburse Mortgagor or any lessee for the cost of repair, rebuilding or restoration of the buildings or other improvements on the Premises, such proceeds shall be made available under the terms of a standard construction escrow agreement and shall be disbursed on receipt of architect's certificates, lien waivers and any other documentation or certificates required under the terms of standard construction escrow agreement. If the buildings and other improvements shall to the extent permissible under applicable law be so repaired, restored or rebuilt, such repaired, restored or rebuilt buildings and other improvements shall be of at least equal value and substantially the same character as prior to such damage or destruction. The Mortgagee must approve plans and specifications of such work before such work shall be commenced which approval shall not be unreasonably withheld, delayed or denied. If the proceeds are made available by the Mortgagee to reimburse the Mortgagor or any lessee for the cost of repair, rebuilding or restoration, any proceeds remaining after payment of all costs of such repair, rebuilding or restoration and the reasonable charges of the Disbursing Party (hereinafter defined) shall, be paid to any party entitled

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thereto as the same appear on the records of the Mortgagee. Any proceeds of insurance held by the Disbursing Party shall be invested in an interest-bearing account for the benefit of Mortgagor which is insured by an agency of the United States Government. The risk of loss of such funds, while so invested shall be borne solely by Mortgagor.

The term "Disbursing Party" refers to the Mortgagee and to any responsible trust company or title insurance company selected by the Mortgagee.

Mortgage shall constitute a Security Agreement within the meaning of the Illinois Uniform Commercial Code 810 ILCS 5/1-101 et seq., (the "Code") with respect to all sums on deposit with the Mortgagee pursuant to Paragraphs 5, 7, 9, 12 and 22 hereof, if any made, ("Deposits") and with respect to any property included in the definition herein of the word "Premises," which property may not be deemed to form a part of the real estate described herein or may not constitute a "fixture" (within the meaning of Section 9-313 of the Code), and all replacements of such property, substitutions for such property, add don's to such property, and the proceeds thereof (said property, replacements, substitutions, additions and the proceeds thereof, but specifically excluding all personal property or trade fixtures of any lessee located on the Premises, being sometimes herein collectively referred to as the "Collateral"); and (b) the Deposits and all of Mortgagor's right, title and in erest therein are hereby assigned to the Mortgagee, all to secure payment of the Indebtedness and to secure performance by the Mortgagor of the terms, covenants and provisions hereof.

If an Event of Default occurs of exists under this Mortgage, then, in accordance with the provisions of any applicable law, the Mortgagee, pursuant to the appropriate provisions of the Code, shall have an option to proceed with respect to both the real property and Colleteral in accordance with its rights, powers and remedies with respect to the real property, in which event the default provisions of the Code shall not apply. The parties agree that if the Mortgagee shall elect to proceed with respect to the Collater 1 separately from the real property, ten (10) days written notice of the sale of the Collateral shall be reasonable notice. The reasonable expenses of retaking, holding, preparing for sale, selling and the like incurred by the Mortgagee shall include, but not be limited to, reasonable attorneys' fees and legal expenses incurred by Mortgagee. The Mortgagor agrees that, without the written consent of the Mortgagee, the Mortgagor will not remove or permit to be removed from the Premises any of the Collateral except that so long as no Event of Default (hereafter defined) exists or occurs hereunder, Margagor shall be permitted to sell or otherwise dispose of the Collateral when obsolete, worn out, inadequate, unserviceable or unnecessary for use in the operation of the Premises, and any replacement or substituted Collateral shall be subject to the security interest created hereby and that the security interest of the Mortgagee shall be perfected and first in priority, it being expressly understood and agreed that all replacements, substitutions and additions to the Collateral shall be and become immediately subject to the security interest of this Mortgage and covered hereby. The Mortgagor shall, from time to lime, on request of the Mortgagee, deliver to the Mortgagee at the cost of the Mortgagor: (a) such further financing statements and security documents and assurances as Mortgagee may reasonably require to the end that the liens and security interest created hereby shall be and remain perfected and protected in accordance with the requirements of any present or future law; and (b) an inventory of the Collateral in reasonable detail. The Mortgagor covenants and represents that all Collateral now is, free and clear of liens, encumbrances, title retention devices and security interests of others except as otherwise discarded in the evidence of title provided to Mortgagee as of the date of this Mortgage.

The Mortgagor and Mortgagee agree, to the extent permitted by law, that: (a) all of the property described within the definition of the word "Premises" herein are or are to become fixtures on the land described herein; (b) this instrument, upon recording or registration in the real estate records of the proper office, shall constitute a "fixture filing" within the meaning of Sections 9-313 and 9-402 of the Code; and (c) Mortgagor is a record owner of the land described herein.

If the Collateral is sold in connection with a sale of the Premises, Mortgagor shall notify the Mortgagee prior to such sale and shall require as a condition of such sale that the purchaser specifically agree to assume Mortgagor's obligations as to the security interests herein granted and to execute whatever agreements and filings are deemed necessary by the Mortgagee to maintain Mortgagee's first perfected security interest in the Collateral, Deposits and the deposits described in Paragraph 8 above; provided, however, such notice and condition shall not be required if Mortgagee has agreed to release its lien in the Collateral and the Premises in accordance with Paragraph 23.

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11. Stamp Tax; Effect of Changes in Laws Regarding Taxation. If, by the laws of the United States of America or of any state or subdivision thereof having jurisdiction over the Mortgagor, any tax is due or becomes due in respect of the issuance of the Note (other than income taxes assessed to Mortgagee), the Mortgagor covenants and agrees to pay such tax in the manner required by any such law. The Mortgagor further covenants to reimburse the Mortgagee for any reasonable sums which Mortgagee may expend by reason of the imposition of any tax on the issuance of the Note.

In the event of the enactment, after this date, of any law of the state in which the Premises is located deducting from the value of the land for the purpose of taxation of any lien thereon, or imposing upon the Mortgagee the payment of the whole or any part of the taxes or assessments or charges or liens herein required to be paid by Mortgagor, or changing in any way the laws relating to the taxation of mortgages or debts secured by mortgages or the Mortgagee's interest in the Premises, or the manner of collection of taxes, so as to affect this Mortgage or the Indebtedness or the holder thereof, then, and in any such event, the Mortgagor, upon demand by the Mortgagee, shall pay such taxes or assessments or reimburse the Mortgagee therefor; provided, however, that if in the opinion of counsel for the Mortgagee: (a) it might be unlawful to require Mortgagor to make such payment; or (b) the making of such payment might result in the imposition of interest beyond the maximum amount permitted by law; then and in any such event, the Mortgagee may elect, by notice in writing given to the Mortgagor, to declare all of the Indebtedness to be and become due and payable ninety (90) days from the giving of such notice.

12. Observance of Legge Assignment. As additional security for the payment of the Note and for the faithful performance of the terms and conditions contained herein, Mortgagor has assigned to Mortgagee all of its right, title and interest as landlord in and to the leases if any, and all future leases of the Premises. All leases of the Premises are subject to the approval of the Mortgagee at to form, content and tenant(s), which approval shall not be unreasonably withheld or denied.

Mortgagor will not, without Mortgagee's pric written consent, which consent shall not be unreasonably withheld or denied: (a) execute any assignment or pledge of any rents or any leases of the Premises except an assignment or pledge securing the Indebtedness; or (b) make any lease of the Premises except for actual occupancy by the tenant thereunder.

Mortgagor at its sole cost and expense will: (a) at all times recomptly and faithfully abide by, discharge and perform all of the covenants, conditions and agreements contained in all 'eases of the Premises, on the part of the landlord thereunder to be kept and performed; (b) subject to the terms and provisions of the assignment of such leases enforce or secure the performance of all of the covenants, conditions and agreements of such leases on the part of the tenants to be kept and performed; (c) appear in and defend any action or proceeding artising under, growing out of or in any manner connected with such leases or the obligations, duties or liabilities of the landlord or of any tenants thereunder; (d) transfer and assign or cause to be separately transferred and assigned to Mortgagee, upon written request of Mortgagee, any lease or leases of the Premises heretofore or hereafter entered into, and make, e ecute and deliver to Mortgagee upon demand, any and all instruments required to effectuate said assignment; (e) furnish Mortgagee, within thirty (30) days after a written request by Mortgagee so to do (but not more often then once in the spaces occupied and the rentals payable thereunder; and (f) exercise within thirty (30) days of any written demand therefor by Mortgagee any right to request from the tenant under any lease of the Premises a certificate with respect to the status thereof.

Nothing in this Mortgage or in any other documents relating to the loan secured hereby shall be construed to obligate Mortgagee expressly or by implication, to perform any of the covenants of any landlord under any of the leases assigned to Mortgagee or to pay any sum of money or damages therein provided to be paid by the landlord, each and all of which covenants and payments Mortgagor agrees to perform and pay or cause to be performed and paid.

In the event of the enforcement by Mortgagee of any remedies provided for by law or by this Mortgage, the tenant under each lease of the Premises shall, at the option of the Mortgagee, attorn to any person succeeding to the interest of landlord as a result of such enforcement and shall recognize such successor in interest as landlord under such lease without change in the terms or other provisions thereof; provided, however, that said successor in interest shall not be bound by any payment of any rent or additional rent for more than one month in advance or any amendment or modification to any lease made without the consent of Mortgagee or said successor in interest. Mortgagor shall use its

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reasonable efforts to obtain from each tenant, upon request by said successor in interest, an instrument or instruments confirming such attornment.

Mortgagor and Lien Not Released. From time to time Mortgagor may, at Mortgagoe's option, without giving notice to or obtaining the consent of Mortgagor or Mortgagor's successors or assigns of the consent of any junior lienholder, guarantor or tenant, without liability on Mortgagoe's part and notwithstanding Mortgagor's breach of any covenant, agreement or condition: (a) release anyone primarily or secondarily liable on any of the Indebtedness; (b) accept a renewal note or notes therefor; (c) release from the lien of this Mortgage any part of the Premises; (d) take or release other or additional security for the Indebtedness; (e) consent to any plat, map or plan of the Premises; (f) consent to the granting of any easement; (g) join in any extension or subordination agreement; (h) agree in writing with Mortgagor to modify the rate of interest or period of amortization of the Note or change the time of payment or the amount of the monthly installments payable thereunder; and (i) waive or fail to exercise any right, power or remedy granted by law or berein or in any other instrument given at any time to evidence or secure the payment of the Indebtedness.

Any actions taken by Mortgagee pursuant to the terms of this Paragraph 13 shall not impair or affect: (a) the obligations of Mortgagor or Mortgagor's successors or assigns to pay any sums at any time secured by this Mortgage and to observe all of the covenants, agreements and conditions herein contained; (b) the guaranty of any individual or legal entity for payment of the Indeptedness: and (c) the lien or priority of the lien hereof against the Premises. Mortgagor shall pay to Mortgagee a reasonable surface charge and such title insurance premiums and reasonable attorneys' fees as may be incurred by Mortgagee for any action described in this Paragraph 13 taken at the request of Mortgagor or its beneficiaries.

- 14. Mortgagee's Reliance on Tax 6il's etc. Mortgagee in making any payment hereby authorized: (a) relating to taxes and assessments, may do so according to any bill, statement or estimate procured from the appropriate public office without inquiry into the validity of any tax, sses ment, sale, forfeiture, tax lien or title or claim thereof; or (b) for the purchase, discharge, compromise or settlement of any other prior lien, may do so without inquiry as to the validity or amount of any claim for lien which may be asserted.
- Acceleration of Indebtedness in Case of an Event of Default. An "Event of Default" shall mean the following: (a) if Mortgagor shall fail to make due and punctual payment of principal or interest on the Note, or any other payment due in accordance with the terms thereof, beyond all applicable cure periods (which terms are hereby incorporated by reference); or (b) if Mortgagor or any guaranter of the Nove shall file (i) a petition for liquidation, reorganization or adjustment of debt under Title 11 of the United States Code (1 CV.S.C. § 101 et seq.) or any similar law, state or federal, whether now or hereafter existing, (ii) any answer admitting insolvency or inability to pay its debts, or (iii) fail to obtain a vacation or stay of involuntary proceedings within ninety (90) days, as hereinafter provided; or (c) if any order for relief for the Mortgagor or for any guarantor of the Note shall be entered in any case under Title 11 of the United States Bankruptcy Code, or a trustee or a receiver shall be appointed for the Mortg gor or for any guarantor of the Note in any voluntary or involuntary proceeding, or any court shall have taken jurisdiction. The major part of the property for the Mortgagor or for any guarantor of the Note in any voluntary proceeding for the reorganization, dissolution, liquidation, adjustment of debt or winding up of the Mortgagor or of any guaranter of the Note, and such trustee or receiver shall not be discharged or such jurisdiction not be relinquished or vacated or stayed on appeal or otherwise stayed within ninety (90) days; or (d) if the Mortgagor or any guarantor of the Note secured hereby shall make an assignment for the benefit of creditors, or shall admit in writing its inability to pay its debts generally as they become due, or shall consent to the appointment of a receiver or trustee or liquidator of all or any major part of its property; or (c) if Mortgagor shall fail to observe or perform any other covenant, agreement or condition set forth herein and required to be kept or performed or observed by the Mortgagor, which failure is not cured within thirty (30) days after written notice thereof, provided that, if Mortgagor acts diligently, continuously in good faith to cure such failure within such thirty (30) day period after written notice and such failure cannot reasonably be cured within such time period, then such time period shall be extended; or (f) if Mortgagor shall fail to observe or perform any covenant, agreement or condition required to be kept or observed by Mortgagor or any guarantor in any other instrument given at any time to evidence, guaranty or secure the payment of the Indebtedness beyond all applicable cure periods set forth therein.



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If an Event of Default shall exist or occur, then the whole of the Indebtedness shall at once, at the option of the Mortgagee, become immediately due and payable without notice to Mortgagor. If the Mortgagee shall be or become entitled to accelerate the maturity of the Indebtedness while any insurance proceeds or condemnation awards are held by or for the Mortgagee to reimburse Mortgagor or any lessee for the cost of repair, rebuilding or restoration of the buildings or other improvements on the Premises, as set forth in Paragraphs 9 and 22 hereof, or while any amount is held by Mortgagee in a Lease Escrow Account as set forth in Paragraph 12 hereof, then and in such event, the Mortgagee shall be entitled to apply all such insurance proceeds, condemnation awards and Lease Escrow Account then held by or for it in reduction of the Indebtedness, and any excess held by it over the amount of the Indebtedness shall be paid Mortgagor or any party entitled thereto, without interest, as the same appear on the records of Mortgagee.

Foreclosure; Expense of Litigation. When the Indebtedness or any part thereof shall become due, whether by acceleration or otherwise, Mortgagee shall have the right to foreclose the lien hereof for such Indebtedness or part thereof. In any civil action to foreclose the lien hereof, there shall be allowed and included as additional Indebtedness in the order or judgment for foreclosure and sale all reasonable expenditures and expenses which may be paid or incurred by c. on behalf of Mortgagee for reasonable attorneys' fees, appraiser's fees, special process server fees, outlays for docume way and expert evidence, stenographers' charges, publication costs, and costs (which may be estimated as to items to be expecided after entry of said order or judgment) of procuring all such abstracts of title, title searches and examination, title i surance policies and similar data and assurances with respect to the title as Mortgagee may deem reasonably necessary either to prosecute such civil action or to evidence to bidders at any sale which may be had pursuant to such order or judgment the true condition of the title to, or the value of the Premises. All reasonable expenditures and expenses of the nature in an Paragraph mentioned and such reasonable expenses and fees as may be incurred in the protection of the Premises and the maintenance of the lien of this Mortgage, including the reasonable fees of any attorneys employed by Mortgagee in any litigation or proceeding affecting this Mortgage, the Note or the Premises, including probate, appellate and bankroptly proceedings, or in preparation for the commencement or defense of any action or proceeding or threatened action or proceeding, shall be immediately due and payable by Mortgagor, promptly on receipt of a statement, with interest thereon at the rate set forth in the Note applicable to a period when a default exists thereunder, and shall be secured by this Mortgage

At all times, the Mortgagor shall appear in and defend any suit, action or proceeding that might in any way in the sole judgment of Mortgagee affect the value of the Premises, the phority of this Mortgage or the rights and powers of Mortgagee hereunder or under any document given at any time to some the Indebtedness. Mortgagor shall, at all times, indemnify, hold harmless and reimburse Mortgagee on demand for any and all loss, damage, expense or cost, including cost of evidence of title and attorneys' fees, arising out of or incurred in connection with any proceeding in which Mortgagee is held to have been liable as a result of negligence or willful act of Mortgagor.

- Application of Proceeds of Foreclosure Sale. The proceeds of any foreclosure sale of the Premises shall be distributed and applied in the following order of priority: first, on account of all costs and expenses medican to the foreclosure proceedings, including all such items as are mentioned in the preceding Paragraph hereof; second, all other items which may under the terms hereof constitute secured Indebtedness additional to that concepted by the Note, with interest thereon as herein provided; third, all principal and interest remaining unpaid on the Note; and fourth, any overplus to any party entitled thereto as their rights may appear.
- Appointment of Receiver or Mortgagee in Possession. Upon, or at any time after, the commencement of an action to foreclose this Mortgage, the court in which such action was commenced may, upon request of the Mortgagee, appoint a receiver of the Premises either before or after foreclosure sale, without notice and without regard to the solvency or insolvency of Mortgagor at the time of application for such receiver and without regard to the then value of the Premises or whether the same shall be then occupied as a homestead or not; and the Mortgagee or any holder of the Note may be appointed as such receiver or as Mortgagee in possession. All monies paid for any of the purposes herein authorized and all reasonable expenses paid or incurred in connection therewith, including reasonable attorneys' fees, and any other monies advanced by Mortgagee in regard to any tax referred to in Paragraph 11 or to protect the Premises or the here hereof, shall be so much additional Indebtedness secured hereby, and shall become immediately due and payable without notice and with interest thereon at the rate of interest set forth in the Note applicable to a period when a default exists thereon. Inaction of Mortgagee shall never be considered as a waiver of any right accruing to it on account of any default on the part of Mortgagor.
- Rights Cumulative. Any proceeds of any award held by the Mortgagee hereunder for the purpose of rebuilding shall be invested in an interest-bearing account, for the benefit of Mortgagee, which is insured by an agency of the United States Government.

23. Release upon Payment and Discharge of Mortgagor's Obligations. Mortgage shall release this Mortgage and the lien hereof by proper instrument in recordable form upon payment and discharge of all Indebtedness secured hereby (including any prepayment charges and late charges provided for herein or in the Note).

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- 24. <u>Giving Notice</u>. Any notice which either party hereto may desire or be required to give to the other party shall be deemed sufficient if given in accordance with the terms of the Note.
- 25. <u>Waiver of Defense</u>. No action for the enforcement of the lien or of any provision hereof shall be subject to any defense which would not be good and available to the party interposing same in an action at law upon the Note.
- Waiver of Statutory Rights. Mortgagor shall not and will not apply for or avail itself of any appraisement, valuation, stay, extension or exemption laws or any so-called "Moratorium Laws," now existing or hereafter enacted, in order to prevent or hinder the enforcement or foreclosure of the lien of this Mortgage, but hereby waives the berefit of such laws. Mortgagor, for itself and all who may claim through or under it, waives any and all right to have the property and estates comprising the Premises marshaled upon any foreclosure of the lien hereof and agrees that any court having jurisdiction to foreclose such lien may order the Premises sold as an entirety. Mortgagor does hereby expressly wa've any and all right of redemption from any order or judgment of foreclosure of the lien of this Mortgage on behalf of Mortgagor, and each and every person, except judgment creditors of Mortgagor, acquiring any interest in or title to the Premises subsequent to the date of this Mortgage.
- Financial Statements and Records. Mortgagor covenants and agrees that it will keep and maintain books and records of account in which of it, true and correct entries shall be made of all dealings and transactions relative to the Premises, which books and records of account shall, at reasonable times and on reasonable notice, be open to the inspection of the Mortgagee and its accountants and other duly authorized representatives. Such books of record and account shall be kept and maintained in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles consistently applied. Mortgagor further covenants and agrees to deliver such financial statements and information as the Mortgagee shall reasonably require from time to time (and not more often than once each year).
- 28. Filing and Recording Charges and Taxes. Mortgagor will pay all filing, registration, recording and search and information fees, and all expenses incident to the execution and acknowledgment of this Mortgage and all other documents securing the Note, and all federal, state, courty and municipal taxes, other taxes, duties, imposts, assessments and charges arising out of or in connection with the execution, delivery, filing, recording or registration of the Note, this Mortgage and all other documents securing the Note and all assignments thereof.
- 29. <u>Business Purpose; Usury Exemption.</u> The proceeds of the lear secured by this Mortgage will be used for the purposes specified in the Illinois Interest Act, 815 ILCS 205/4, and the principal obligation secured hereby constitutes a "business loan" which comes within the purview and operation of said a.t.
- 30. Due on Sale or Further Encumbrance Clause. The occurrence at any time of any of the following events shall be deemed to be an unpermitted transfer of title to the Premises and therefore an Event of Default hereunder:
 - (a) any sale, conveyance, assignment or other transfer of, or the grant of a security interest in, all or any part of the title to the Premises;
 - (b) any sale, conveyance, assignment, or other transfer of, or the grant of a security interest in, any general partnership interest in any limited partnership or general partnership directly or indirectly controlling Mortgagor;
