#### JUDGMENT ORDER

This matter came before the Coort on a motion for judgment on the pleadings as to liability and a succeedent prove-up niffer in Med by Arcelainaraive District Council 1 of Illinois of the international Union of Bricklayers and Allied Craftworkers AFL-CIO ("Union"), the Court has examined the Union's submissions and is fully informed, and it appears that good cause exists for granting the Union's motion and entering judgment in this form.

#### Therefore, IT IS ORDERED as follows:

- 1. Judgment is entered against Wesley Orlowski and Orlowski Company, Inc., jointly and severally, in the amount of \$101,686.90, plus interest on \$94,355.90 of that amount at the rate of 10% a year from April 22, 2009 to the date of payment, and interest on the remaining amount at the statistics years.
- 2. Wesley Orlowski and Orlowski Company, Inc., are ordered, jointly and severally, to provide the Union with a bond in the amount of \$30,000.00 and in the required form or, in the alternative, to make a payment to the Union in the amount of \$30,000.00 to serve as a cash bond;

3. Wesley Orlowski and Orlowski Company. Inc., are ordered, jointly and severally, to refrain from performing any work within the geographic and craft jurisdiction of the Union, regardless of the name or business form under which they perform such work, unless and until they provide the bond or cash bond and make the payments as stated in the arbitration award on behalf of the individual Bricklayers;

Wesley Orlowski and Orlowski Company, Inc., are ordered, jointly and severally, to do at hiring through the procedures stated in the arbitration award;

5. Wesley Grlowski and Orlowski Company. Inc., are ordered, jointly and severally, to submit to, cooperate in, and pry for a wage and benefit audit to be conducted by an auditor selected by the Union;

Wesley Orlowski and Orlowski Company, Inc., are ordered, jointly and severally, to provide payroll reports and job location reports to the Labor-Management Cooperation Committee by the last Friday of each month;

Wesley Orlowski and Orlowski Company, Inc., are ordered, jointly and severally, to arrange for all current and new employees to attend silica awareness and scaffold training classes on company time, and to pay all fees associated with those classes;

8. Wesley Orlowski and Orlowski Company. Inc., are ordered, jointly and severally, to place identification on all equipment; and

9 the Court retains jurisdiction of this case to resolve any disputes concerning compliance.
