The Court being fully advised of the premises of this proceeding and having heard the testimony of the City's inspector, finds that:

1. The Court has jurisdiction of the parties hereto and the subject matter, which is the premises located at the following address: **8149 S. Avalon Ave., Chicago, Illinois**, and legally described as follows:

 - b. The building's electrical system has exposed wiring, 's missing fixtures and is stripped and inoperable.
 - c. The building's flooring is warped and missing in sections.
 - d. The buildng's glazing is broken or missing.
 - e. The buildng's heating system is missing a furnace and ductwork, is vandalized, stripped and inoperable
 - f. The building's joists are cracked.
 - g. The building's masonry has step or stress fractures and washed out mortar joints.

- Defendant owners are ordered to keep the property secure until it is demolished. H.
- The City's performance under the Order will result in a statutory in rem lien that attaches I. only to the subject parcel of real estate. If the City seeks a personal judgment against any individual party to this action, it will proceed by separate motion directed to that party.
- Defendants with either possession or control of the subject property shall immediately J. remove any and all persons occupying the subject property and all personal property from said premises instanter so that said premises will be completely vacant and free of personal property before demolition is commenced. The City's Department of Human Services is authorized to assist in the relocation of any tenants.
- Pursuant to Illinois Supreme Court Rule 304(a), this is a final and appealable order and the K. Court finds that there is no just reason for delaying the enforcement or appeal of this order.
- The Court reserves jurisdiction of this cause to enforce the terms of this Order, for the L. purpose of ascertaining demolition costs for entry of money judgments against the defendant owners, and for the purpose of hearing foreclosure proceedings, as defined by the applicable statutes and ordinances.

WHEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED That
