4. Governing Law; Severability. This Security Instrument shall be governed in Federal law and the law of the jurisdiction in which the Property is located. In the event that any provision or clause of this Security Instrument or the Note conflicts with applicable law, such conflict shall not exact other provisions of this Security Instrument or the Note which can be given effect without conflicting provision. 7. Acceleration; Remedies.
