

- (B) "Borrower" is Candice M Hartranft And Gordon D Hartranft II Husband and Wife ar conants by the entirety. Borrower is the mortgagor under this Security Instrument.
- (C) "Lender" is Associated Bank, N.A.. Lender is a Corporation organized and existing under the laws of The United States of America. Lender's address is 200 N Adams St, Green Bay, WI 54351. Lender is the mortgagee under this Security Instrument.
- (D) "Note" means the promissory note signed by Borrower and dated March 09, 2016. The Note states that Borrower owes Lender FIVE HUNDRED SEVENTY THOUSAND AND NO/100 Dollars (U.S. \$ 570,000.00 ) plus interest. Borrower has promised to pay this debt in regular Periodic Payments and to pay the debt in full not later than March 01, 2046.

BORROW ET. COVENANTS that Borrower is lawfully seised of the estate hereby conveyed and has the right to mortgace, grant and convey the Property and that the Property is unencumbered, except for encumbrances of record. Sorrower warrants and will defend generally the title to the Property against all claims and demands, subject to any encumbrances of record.

Lender may return any payment or partial payment if the payment or partial payments are insufficient to bring the Loan current. Lender may accept any payment or partial proment insufficient to bring the Loan current, without waiver of any rights hereunder or prejudice to its rights to refuse such payment or partial payments in the future, but Lender is not obligated to apply such payments at the time such payments are accepted. Any application of payments, insurance proceeds, or Miscellaneous Proceeds to principal due under the Note shall not extend or postpone the due date, or change the amount, of the Periodic Payments.

3. Funds for Esrrow Items. If the Index is no longer a alla ile, the Note Holder will choose a new index which is based upon comparable information. The Note Holder will give me notice of this choice.

#### (C) Calculation of Changes

Before each Change Date, the Note Ho der will calculate my new interest rate by adding TWO AND 250/1000 percentage points (2.250%) to the Current Index. The Note Holder will then round the result of this addition to the nearest one-eighth of one procentage point (0.125%). Subject to the limits stated in Section 4(D) below, this rounded amount will be my new interest rate until the next Change Date.

The Note Holder will then determine the amount of the nor thly payment that would be sufficient to repay the unpaid principal that I am expected to owe at the Change Date in full on the Maturity Date at my new interest rate in substantially equal payments. The result of this colour tion will be the new amount of my monthly payment.

#### (D) Limits on Interest Rate Changes

The interest rate I am required to pay at the first Change Date will not be greater than 5.000% or less than 2.250%. Thereafter, my interest rate will never be increased or decreased on any single Change Date by more than two percentage points from the rate of interest I have been paying for the preceding 12 months. My interest rate will never be greater than 8.000%.

#### (E) Effective Date of Changes

My new interest rate will become effective on each Change Date. I will pay the amount of my rie / monthly payment beginning on the first monthly payment date after the Change Date until the amount of my monthly payment changes again.

#### (F) Notice of Changes

The Note Holder will deliver or mail to me a notice of any changes in my interest rate and the amount of my monthly payment before the effective date of any change. The notice will include information required by law to be given to me and also the title and telephone number of a person who will answer any question I may have regarding the notice.
