AN ORDINANCE GRANTING A SPECIAL USE PERMIT TO ESTABLISH AND OPERATE A SELF-SERVICE STORAGE FACILITY AT 5830 HOWARD STREET, SKOKIE, ILLINOIS IN AN M2 LIGHT INDUSTRY DISTRICT

WHEREAS, the owner (hereinafter "Petitioner") of the following described real property:

LOT 1 IN SKOKIE SELF 3TORAGE SUBDIVISION, BEING A SUBDIVISION OF PART OF THE NORTHEAST QUAPTER OF SECTION 29, TOWNSHIP 41 NORTH, RANGE 13, EAST OF THE THIRD PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN, IN COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS.

more commonly described as 5830 Howard Street, Skokie, Illinois (hereinafter "Subject Property"), petitioned the Village of Skokie for a special use permit to establish and operate a self-service storage facility in an M2 Light Industry district; and

WHEREAS, Petitioner desires to construct a 121,500 square-foot self-service storage facility on the Subject Property which will contain 879 storage units, 26 of which will have direct access to the external circulation system. The facility also includes 1, 1,000 square-foot office area; and

WHEREAS, in case 2016-40P, the Skokie Plan Commission determined that 12 offstreet vehicle parking spaces were needed for this use and that the proposed plan meets the off-street parking requirement; and

WHEREAS, at the December 14, 2016, meeting, the Skokie Appearance Commission approved the building elevations, and the sign package was approved subject to the phone number and internet address being removed from the permanent signage; and

WHEREAS, at the February 8, 2017, meeting of the Skokie Appearance Commission, the building elevations were re-reviewed and approved due to requested modifications in the building material texture; and

WHEREAS, at a public hearing of the Skokie Plan Commission, duly held on January 5, 2017, for which proper legal notice had been achieved, one interested party spoke with concerns that enough parking was not provided; and

WHEREAS, after hearing all testimony, the Skokie Plan Commission (a) made the appropriate findings of fact as required under Section 118-6(f) of the Skokie Village Code and (b) voted to recommend to the Mayor and Board of Trustees that the requested special use permit be granted subject to the conditions contained in the Plan Commission Report dated February 6, 2017; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Board of Trustees, at a public meeting duly held on February 6, 2017, voted to concur in the aforesaid recommendations and findings of fact of the Skokie Plan Commission;

NOW. THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Board of Trustees of the Village of Skokie, Cook County, Illinois:

- Section 1. That the special use permit requested by the petitioner to establish and operate a self-service storage facility at the Subject Property, described above and commonly known as 5830 Howard Street, Skokie, Illinois, in an M2 Light Industry district, be and the same is hereby granted and approved subject to each of the conditions set forth below:
- 1. The petitioner shall comply with all the conditions in the site plan approval ordinance for this location;
- 2. The petitioner shall develop the Subject Property in substantial conformance with the final Village approved Preliminary Exterior Elevations plans dated January 12, 2017, and floor plans, dated December 16, 2016 (1st floor) and December 1, 2016 (2nd, 3rd and 4th floors);
- 3. Any change to the number of storage units may require a modification to the parking determination for this use;
- 4. Leasing any exterior vehicle parking space is expressly prohibited;
- 5. Outdoor storage of any kind is expressly prohibited;

- 6. All garbage must be contained in designated trash disposal areas; and
- 7. Failure to abide by any and all terms of this Ordinance shall be cause for the Village to initiate hearings to determine whether the subject Ordinance, as well as any applicable business licenses, should be revised or revoked. The petitioner shall pay all costs related to any hearings conducted as a result of non-compliance with any of the provisions of the enabling ordinance. The costs shall include but not be limited to court reporter fees, attorney fees, and staff time required researching and conducting said hearing.
- <u>Section 2</u>: That a notice of the approval of this Ordinance incorporating the conditions contained herein shall be executed by the owner of the property in writing and duly recorded with the Cook County Recorder of Deeds Office at the owner's expense.
- <u>Section 3</u>: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and recordation as provided by law.


