

#### **ORDER FOR RECEIVER'S THIRD CERTIFICATE**

This matter coming or to be heard on Receiver's Petition for the Court's approval of the third accounting and for authorization to issue a receiver's certificates, with due notice being given to all parties and the Court being fully advised in the premises;

#### THE COURT FINDS:

- 1. That on January 7, 2016, Globe rotters Engineering Corporation was appointed limited receiver for the purpose of performing specific tas's at the premises.
- 2. That Receiver performed various ser ices as detailed in the third accounting for fees and expenses from November 1, 2016 through and including January 31, 2017.
- 3. That Receiver's third accounting states that, in the course of fulfilling its duties, Receiver incurred out of pocket costs totaling \$454.11, and that \$4,127.65 in fees were billed for a combined total of \$4,581.76.
- 4. The Court has in rem jurisdiction over the subject property and the Defendants, such as could be located for service of process, received due notice of the receivers appointment, its accounting and its petition for approval of the third accounting.
- 5. After thorough consideration of the Motion and attached exhibits, this Court finds that \$454.11 in out of pocket costs and \$4,127.65 in fees, for a total of \$4,581.76 is fair just and reasonable compensation for the work completed by Receiver.

WHEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

\$3,602.76

- A. Globetrotters Engineering Corporation's costs and fees of \$4,581.76 are hereby approved and Receiver is granted leave to issue a receiver's certificate in said amount, with interest accruing on unpaid amounts from the date of this order is entered at a rate of 10%, per annum.
- B. The certificate is hereby issued pursuant to the provisions of the Illinois Compiled Statutes, Chapter 65, Section 5/11-31-2.
