PLAINTIFF CITY OF CHICAGO'S COMILAINT FOR EQUITABLE AND OTHER RELIEF

Plaintiff, THE CITY OF CHICAGO ("the City"), by and through its attorney, Stephen R. Patton, Corporation

Counself and the undersigned attorney, complains of the defendants as follows:

GENT RAL ALLEGATIONS

Nature of the Case

1. The City brings this action pursuant to its police power as a home rule dit under the strops. Constitution, article VII, § 6(a), 65 ILCS 5/11-31-1(a) et seq. (West 2012), 62 ILCS 5/11-13-13, and provisions of the Municipal Code of Chicago. By bringing this action, the City seeks to abate dangerous and unsafe conditions at the property in question and obtain equitable relief, civil penalties, attorney's fees, and costs.

The Parties and the Property at Issue

- 2. The City is a municipal corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Illinois.
- 3. Within the corporate limits of Chicago, there is a parcel of real estate legally described as:

LOT 28 IN BLOCK 22 IN PARK OF SOUTH ENGLEWOOD IN THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 4, TOWNSHIP 37 NORTH, RANGE 14, EAST OF THE THIRD PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN, IN COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS.
