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#### THE COVENANTS, CONDITIONS AND PROVISIONS REFERRED TO ON PAGE 2

- 1. Mortgagor shall (1) promptly repair, restore or rebuild any buildings or improvements now or hereafter on the premises which may become damaged or be destroyed; (2) keep said premises in good condition and repair, without waste, and free from mechanic's or other liens or claims for lien not expressly subordinated to the lien thereof; (3) pay when due any indebtedness which may be secured by a lien or charge on the premises superior to the lien hereof, and upon request exhibit satisfactory evidence of the discharge of such prior lien to the Mortgagee; (4) complete within a reasonable time any building or buildings now or at any time in process or erection upon said premises; (5) comply with all requirements of law or municipal ordinances with respect to the premises and the use thereof; (6) make no material alterations in said premises except as required by law or municipal ordinances.
- 2. Mortgagor shall pay before any penalty attaches all general taxes, and shall pay special taxes, special assessments, water charges, sewer service charges, and other charges against the premises when due and shall, upon written request, furnish to the Mortgagee duplicate receipts thereof. To prevent default hereunder Mortgagor shall pay in full under protest, in the manner provided by statute, any tax or assessment which Mortgagor may desire to contest.
- 3. In the event of the enactment after this date of any law of Illinois deducting from the value of land for the purpose of taxation any lien thereon, or imposing upon the Mortgagee the payment of the whole or any part of the taxes or assessments or charges or liens herein required to be paid by Mortgagor, or changing in any way the laws relating to the taxation of mortgages or debts secured by mortgages or the mortgagee's interest in the property, or the manner of collection of taxes, so as to affect this mortgage or the debt secured hereby or the holder thereof, then and in any such event, the Mortgagor, upon demand by the Mortgagee, shall pay such taxes or assessments, or reimburse the Mortgagee thereof; provided, however, that if in the opinion of coensel for the Mortgagee (a) it might be unlawful to require Mortgagor to make such payment or (b) the making of such payment might result in the imposition of interest beyond the maximum amount permitted by law, then and in such event, the Mortgagee may elect, by notice in writing give to Mortgagor, to declare all of the indebtedness secured hereby to be and become due and payable sixty (60) days from the giving of such notice.
- 4. If, by the laws of the United States of America or of any state having jurisdiction in the premises, any tax is due or becomes due in respect of the issuance of the note hereby secured, the Mortgagor covenants and agrees to pay such tax in the manner required by and such law. The Mortgagor further covenant to hold harmless and agree to indemnify the Mortgagee, and the Mortgagee's successors or assign, against any liability incurred by reason of the imposition of any tax on the issuance of the note secured hereby.
- 5. At such time as the Mortgagor are not in default either under the terms of the note secured hereby or under the terms of this mortgage, the Mortgagor shall have such privilege of making prepayments on the principal of said note (in addition to the required payments) as may be provided in said note.

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- 6. Mortgagor shall keep all buildings and improvements now or hereafter situated on said premises insured against loss or damage by fire, lightning and windstorm under policies providing for payment by the insurance companies of moneys sufficient either to pay the cost of replacing or repairing the same or to pay in full the indebtedness secured hereby, all in companies satisfactory to the Mortgagee, under insurance polices payable, in case of loss or damage, to Mortgagee, such rights to be evidenced by the standard mortgage clause to be attached to each policy, and shall deliver all policies, including additional and renewal policies, to the Mortgagee, and in case of insurance about to expire, shall deliver renewal polices not less than ten days prior to the respective dates or expiration.
- 7. In case of default therein, Mortgagee may, but need not, make any payment or perform any act hereinbefore required of Mortgagor in any form and manner deemed expedient, and may, but need not, make full or partial payments of principal or interest on prior encumbrances, if any, and purchase, discharge, compromise or settle any tax lien or other prior lien or title or claim thereof, or redeem from any tax sale or forfeiture affecting said premises or contest any tax or assessment. All moneys paid for any of the purposes herein authorized and all expenses paid or incurred in connection therewith, including attorney's fees, and any other moneys advanced by Mortgagee to protect the mortgaged premises and the lien hereof, shall be so much additional indebtedness secured hereby and shall become immediately due and payable without notice and with interest thereon at the highest rate now permitted by Pilippis law. Inaction of Mortgagee shall never be considered as a waiver of any right accounts to the Mortgagee on account of any default hereunder on the part of the Mortgagor.
- 8. The Mortgagee making any payment hereby authorized relating to taxes or assessments, may do so according to any bill, statement or estimate procured from the appropriate public office without inquiry into the accuracy of such bill, statement or estimate or into the validity of any tax, assessment, sale, forfeiture, tax lien or title or claim thereof.
- 9. Mortgagor shall pay each item of indebtedness herein mentioned, both principal and interest, when due according to the terms hereof. At the option of the Mortgagee and without notice to Mortgagor, all unpaid indebtedness secured by this mortgage shall, notwithstanding anything in the note or in this mortgage to the contrary, become due and payable (a) immediately in the case of default in making payment of any installment of principal or interest on the note, or (b) when default shall occur and continue for three days in the performance of any other agreement of the Mortgagor herein contained.
- 10. When the indebtedness hereby shall become due whether by acceleration or otherwise, Mortgagee shall have the right to foreclose the lien hereof. In any suit to foreclose the lien hereof, there shall be allowed and included as additional indebtedness in the decree for sale all expenditures and expenses which may be paid or incurred by or on behalf of Mortgagee for attorneys' fees, appraiser's fees, outlays for documentary and expert evidence, stenographers' charges, publication costs and costs (which may be estimated as to items to be expended after entry of the decree) of procuring all such abstracts of title, title searches, and examinations, title insurance policies, Torrens certificates, and similar data and assurances with respect to title as Mortgagee may deem

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to be reasonably necessary either to prosecute such suit or to evidence to bidders at any sale which may be had pursuant to such decree the true condition of the title to or the value of the premises. All expenditures and expenses of the nature in this paragraph mentioned shall become so much additional indebtedness secured hereby and immediately due and payable, with interest thereon at the highest rate now permitted by Illinois law, when paid or incurred by Mortgagee in connection with (a) any proceeding, including probate and bankruptcy proceedings, to which the Mortgagee shall be a party, either as plaintiff, claimant or defendant, by reason of this mortgage or any indebtedness hereby secured; or (b) preparations for the commencement of any suit for the foreclosure hereof after accrual of such right to foreclose whether or not actually commenced; or (c) preparations for the defense of any actual or threatened suit or proceeding which might affect the premises or the security hereof.

- 11. The proceeds of any foreclosure sale of the premises shall be distributed and applied in the following order of priority: First, on account of all costs and expenses incident to the foreclosure proceedings, including all such items as are mentioned in the preceding paragraph hereof; second, all other items which under the terms hereof constitute secured indebtedness additional to that evidenced by the note, with interest thereon as herein provided; third, all principal and interest remaining unpaid on the note; fourth, any overplus to Mortgagor, their heirs, legal representatives or assigns, as their rights may appear.
- 12. Upon or any time after the filing of a complaint to foreclose this mortgage the court in which such complaint is filed may appoint receiver of said premises. Such appointment may be made either before or after the sale, without notice, without regard to the solvency or insolvency of Mortgagor at the time of application for such receiver and without regard to the then value of the premises or whether the same shall be then occupied as a homestead or not, and the Mortgagee may be appointed as such receiver. Such receiver shall have power to collect the rents, issues and profits of said premises during the pendency of such foreclosure suit and, in case of a sale and a deficiency, during the full statutory period of redemption, whether there be redemption or pot, as well as during any further times when Mortgagor, except for the intervention of such receiver, would be entitled to collect such rents, issues and profits, and all other powers which may be necessary or are usual in such cases for the protection, possession, control management and operation of the premises during the whole of said period. The Court from time to time may authorize the receiver to apply the net income in his hands in payment in whole or in part of: (1) The indebtedness secured hereby, or by any decree foreclosing this mortgage, or any tax, special assessment or other lien which may be or become superior to the lien hereof or of such decree, provided such application is made prior to foreclosure sale; (2) the deficiency in case of a sale and deficiency.
- 13. No action for the enforcement of the lien or of any provision hereof shall be subject to any defense which would not be good and available to the party interposing same in an action at law upon the note hereby secured.

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- 14. The Mortgagee shall have the right to inspect the premises at all reasonable times and access thereto shall be permitted for that purpose.
- 15. The Mortgagor shall deposit monthly with the Mortgagee such sums as the Mortgagee may reasonably require for payment of taxes and assessments on the premises. No such deposit shall bear any interest.
- 16. If the payment of said indebtedness or any part thereof be extended or varied or if any part of the security be released, all persons now or at any time hereafter liable therefore, or interested in said premises, shall be held to assent to such extension, variation or release, and their liability and the lien and all provisions hereof shall continue in full force, the right of recourse against all such persons being expressly reserved by the Mortgagee, notwithstanding such extension, variation or release.
- 17. Mortgagee shall release this mortgage and lien thereof by proper instrument upon payment and discharge of all indebtedness secured hereby and payment of a reasonable fee to Mortgagee for the execution of such release.
- 18. This mortgage and all p ovisions hereof, shall extend to and be binding upon Mortgagor and all persons claiming under or through Mortgagor, and the word "Mortgagor" when used herein shall include all such persons and all persons liable for the payment of the indebtedness or any part thereof, whether or not such persons shall have executed the note or this mortgage. The word "Mortgagee" when used herein shall include the successors and assigns of the Mortgagee named herein and the holder or holders, from time to time, of the not secured hereby.

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#### **RIDER #A**

THIS RIDER, is attached to and made a part of a certain Mortgage and Installment Note dated December 29, 2017, between Lucas Sniady and Anna Sniady, husband and wife, Mortgagors, and Francesco Randazzo, as Trustee of the Francesco Randazzo Trust dated September 18, 1998 and Rosaria Randazzo, as Trustee of the Rosaria Randazzo Trust dated September 18, 1998, Mortgagees, for the property commonly known as 785 Timothy Lane, Des Plaines, Illinois.

- 1. In the event of conflict between the terms of this Rider and the Mortgage or Installment Note, then the terms of this Rider shall prevail and control.
- 2. The Mortgagors further covenant not to suffer or permit without the written permission or consent of the holder being first had and obtained, a sale, conveyance, installment sale, assignment (including assignment of beneficial interest, except for collateral purposes only transfer of any right, title, and interest in and to said property or any portion thereof, to any person, firm, corporation, or trust, and in the event of breach of this covenant, the holder may, without notice, at the option of the holder, declare the entire principal, interest, and advances immediately due and payable. The acceptance of payments by the holder shall not be a waiver of their right to demand immediate payment.
  - 3. Any and all amounts of priricipal may be pre-paid at anytime without penalty.
- 4. It is hereby understood that unless payment is made by Mortgagor within fifteen (15) days of the due date of each month, there will be added five (5%) percent of the monthly payment as penalty for late payment.
- 5. All remedies provided by this Mortgage are distinct and cumulative to any other right or remedy under this Mortgage or afforded by taw or equity and may be exercised concurrently, independently, or successively.
- 6. The Mortgagor understands and agrees that the mortgage a may transfer this Note and Mortgage.
- 7. As further security for payment of the indebtedness and performance of the obligations, covenants, and agreements secured hereby, the Mortgagors hereby assign to the Mortgagee and holder of the Note, all leases already in existence and to be created in the future, together with all rents to become due under existing or future leases or tenancies. This assignment, however, shall be operative only in the event of the occurrence of a default hereunder, or under the Note or other instrument collateral hereto, remaining uncured at the expiration of the grace period, if any, provided herein in respect to such default; and in any such case the Mortgagors hereby confer on the Mortgagee and

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the holder of the Note the exclusive power, to be used or not be used in its sole discretion, to act as agent, or to appoint a third person to act as agent for the Mortgagors, with power to take possession of, and collect all rents arising from the Premises and apply such rents, at the option of the Mortgagee or the holder of the Note, to the payment of the mortgage debt, taxes, costs of maintenance, repairs, expenses incident to managing, and other expenses, in such order of priority as the Mortgagee or the holder of the Note in their sole discretion determine, and to turn any balance remaining over to the Mortgagors; but such collection of rents shall not operate as an affirmance of the tenant or lease of the Note. Trustee and the holder of the Note shall be liable to account only for rents and profits actually received by the Mortgagee or the holder of the Note. In exercising any of the power contained in this section, the Mortgagee or the holder of the Note may also take possession of, and for these purposes use, any and all personal property contained in the Premises and used the Mortgagors in the rental or leasing thereof or any part thereof.

- 8. In addition to the monthly payment of principal and interest as provided in the Note, the Mortgagor agrees to deposit with the Mortgagee, on the day of each monthly payment is due, a sum equal to one-twelfth of the yearly taxes which may become a lien on the property and insurance, as reasonably estimated by the Mortgagee, to provide sufficient sums for the full payment of such taxes and insurance sixty days prior to its becoming due and payable. If at any time the real estate taxes or insurance increase or the Note holder receives notice of any increase in the taxes or insurance or the funds being held are insufficient, then the Mortgagors shall deposit, upon demand, such additional sums as are sufficient to pay the amount of taxes and insurance when due. In the event Mortgagors fail to make the deposits as required herein, such failure shall constitute a breach of the Installment Note and Mortgage.
- 9. In the event of any conflict between the terms of the Installment Note and Mortgage and this Rider "A" it is understood that this Rider "A" shall control.
