PLAINTIFF CITY OF CHICAGO'S
COMPLAINT FOR EQUITABLE AND OTHER RELIEF

Plaintiff, THE CITY OF Chicago ("the City"), by and through its attorney, Edward Siskel Corporation Counsel, and the undersigned ettorney, complains of the defendants as follows:

GENERAL ALLEGATIONS

Nature of the Case

1. The City brings this action pursuant to its police power as a home rule unit under the Illinois Constitution, article VII, § 6(a), 65 ILCS 5.11-31-1(a) et seq. (West 2012), 65 ILCS 5/11-13-15, and provisions of the Municipal Code of Chicago. Py bringing this action, the City seeks to abate dangerous and unsafe conditions at the property in question and obtain equitable relief, civil penalties, attorney's fees, and costs.

The Parties and the Property at Issu:

- 2. The City is a municipal corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Illinois.
- 3. Within the corporate limits of Chicago, there is a parcel of real estate legally described as:

LOT-11-AND-THE SOUTH 6-1/4 OF LOT 10 IN BLOCK 5 IN LUCY M. CKEEN ADDITION TO CHICAGO, SAID ADDITION BEING A SUBDIVISION OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 20, TOWNSHIP 32 NORTH, RANGE 14, EAST OF THE THIRD PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN, IN COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS.

This parcel is commonly known as 6426 S. SANGAMON ST., Chicago, Cook County, Illinois ("subject property"), and has a permanent index number of 20-20-212-030-0000.

4. Located on the subject property is a THREE-STORY FRAME MULTIPLE UNIT DWELLING WITH FRAME GARAGE BUILDING. The last known use of the building was RESIDENTIAL.
