



ORDER FOR RECEIVER'S FINAL CERTIFICATE

This matter coming on to be heard on Receiver's Petition for the Court's approval of the final accounting and for authorization to issue a leceiver's certificates, with due notice being given to all parties and the Court being fully advised in the premises;

THE COURT FINDS:

- That on December 5, 2017, Globetrotters Engineering Corporation was appointed limited receiver for 1. the purpose of performing specific tasks at the subject premises.
- That Receiver performed specific tasks as detailed in the final accounting for fees and expenses from 2. December 5, 2017 through and including April 3, 2018.
- That Receiver's final accounting states that, in the course of fulfilling its duties, Receiver incurred out of 3. pocket costs totaling \$6,993.00, and that \$7.111.05 in fees were billed for a combined total of \$14,104.05.
- The Court has in rem jurisdiction over the subject property and the Defendants, such as could be located 4. for service of process, received due notice of the receiver, appointment, its accounting and its petition for approval of the final accounting. \$3000 SV
