#### ORDER OF JUDGMENT

This matter coming before the Court on Plaintiff's Rule to Show Cause, proper notice having been given, and the Court being ful y advised in the premises,

#### IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

- 1. On September 28, 2017, this Court entered an order of final default judgment in favor of the Plaintiff, Freight Handlers, LLC dba Apex Logistics Group, and against the Defendant, Global Express Incorporated, in the total amount of \$1,785.55.
- 2. On November 21, 2017, Plaintiff issued a Citation to Discover Assets to Global Express Incorporated c/o Paul Wagner, its President.
- 3. On November 29, 2017, Wagner filed a motion purportedly on behalf of Global Express Incorporated in which he stated that he had not received any information or documentation about this proceeding.
- 4. On December 5, 2017, the Court heard the motion and advised Wagner that because he was not a lawyer, he could not represent Global Express Incorporated; gave Wagner an opportunity to retain counsel by January 2, 2018; and stayed enforcement of the pending Citation to Discover Assets except the portion thereof that stated: "YOU ARE PROHIBITED from making or allowing any transfer or other disposition of, or interfering with, any property not exempt from execution or garnishment belonging to the judgment debtor or to which the judgment debtor may be entitled or which may be acquired or become due to the judgment debtor and from paying over or otherwise disposing of any money not so exempt, which is due or becomes due to the judgment debtor, until further order of court or termination of the proceedings."

- 5. On December 10, 2017, Paul Wagner was personally served with the same Citation to Discover Assets, Citation Rider, and a copy of the Default Judgment.
- 6. On March 15, 2018, Defendant's counsel produced electronic copies of certain documents responsive to Plaintiff's Citation Rider. The production included Defendant's bank statements at Selfreliance Ukrainian American Federal Credit Union from March 1, 2017 to February 28, 2018, which was under the sole control of Paul Wagner.
- 7. The bank statements reflect that from December 19, 2017 through February 27, 2018, Paul Wagner made at least eight withdrawals or transfers from the bank account of Defendant Grobal Express Incorporated, which totaled \$118,066.44.
- 8. During the citation hearing, Wagner admitted that he was the sole signatory/account lockler with the ability to make withdrawals from the account and that he made the eight withdrawals
- 9. The Court ordered Wagner to personally appear on April 17, 2018 to show cause why he should not be held in contempt of Court for his transfer of funds in violation of the Citation to Discover Assets.
  - 10. Wagner failed to personally appear at the April 17, 2018 show-cause hearing.
- 11. On April 17, 2018, Plaintiff re eived copies of seven withdrawal checks that were issued from the account directly to Paul Wagner at Nagner's direction.
- 12. The Court finds that Paul Wagner transfered \$118,066.44 of the assets of Global Express Incorporated from its bank account at Selfrelian a Ukrainian American Federal Credit Union in violation of the restraining provision of the Citation to Discover Assets properly served upon Wagner and issued with respect to an enforceable judgment against Global Express Incorporated.
- 13. Accordingly, pursuant to 735 ILCS 5/2-1402(f)(1), judgment is hereby entered in favor of the Plaintiff, Freight Handlers, LLC dba Apex Logistics Group, and against the Third-Party Citation Respondent, Paul Wagner aka Pavlo Ivanov, in the amount of \$95,364.91, which is inclusive of the amount of the judgment entered against Defendant Global Express Incorporated (\$91,785.55) as well as Plaintiff's reasonable attorneys' fees (\$7,579.36) incurred in the post-judgment proceedings.
