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THIS MORTGAGE ("Securic Instrument") is given on March 1, 2019. The Mortgagors are Leroy F. Davis and Andrey Davis ("Borrowers"). This Security Instrument is given to GILLES SANTOS ("I ender"), whose address is 340 E. Randolph St., #4602, Chicago, IL 60601. Borrowers over Lender the principal sum of Ninety Thousand and No/100 Dollars (U.S. \$90,000.00). This debt is evidenced by Borrowers' Note dated of even date herewith ("Note"), which provides for monthly payments of interest only, with the full debt, if not paid earlier, due and payable on March 1, 2029. This Security Instrument secures to Lender: (a) the repayment of the debt evidenced by the Note, with interest, and all renewals, extensions and modifications; (b) the payment of all other sums, with interest, advanced under Paragraph 7 to protect the security of this Security Instrument; and (c) the performance of Borrowers' covenants and agreements under this Security Instrument and the Note. For this purpose, Borrowers do hereby mortgage, grant and convey to Lender the following described Property located in Cook County, Illinois:

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TOGETHER WITH all the improvements now or hereafter erected on the Property, and all easements, rights, appurtenances, rents, royalties, mineral, oil and gas rights and profits, water rights and stock and all fixtures now or hereafter a part of the Property. All replacements and additions shall also be covered by this Security Instrument. All of the foregoing is referred to in this Security Instrument as the "Property".

BORROWERS COVENANT that Borrowers are lawfully seized of the estate hereby conveyed and has the right to mortgage, grant and convey the Property and that the Property is unencumbered, except for encumbrances of record. Borrower warrants and will defend generally the title to the Property against all claims and demands, subject to any encumerances of record.

THIS SECULITY INSTRUMENT combines uniform covenants for national use and non-uniform covenants with limited variations by jurisdiction to constitute a uniform security instrument covering real property.

<u>UNIFORM COVENAL'15.</u> Borrowers and Lender covenant and agree as follows:

- 1. Payment of Principal and Interest; Prepayment and Late Charges. Borrowers shall promptly pay when due the principal and interest on the debt evidenced by the Note and any prepayment and late charge; due under the Note.
- 2. <u>Taxes and Insurance; Escrow.</u> Borrovers shall be responsible to pay all general real estate taxes attributable to the Property on a timely basis prior to the due dates thereof and to maintain and pay prior to the due dates thereof, all insurance premiums for hazard insurance on the Property as set forth in Paragraph 5 of this Mortgage. In the event that Borrower shall, at anytime, fail to pay the taxes or to renew the insurance, then Lender may, but shall not be required to, pay such taxes and/or pay such insurance premiums and such funds which are advanced shall be added to the principal balance due hereunder.
- 3. Application of Payments. Unless applicable law provides otherwise, all payments received by Lender under Paragraphs 1 and 2 shall be applied: first, to late charges due under the Note; second, to amounts payable under Paragraph 2; third, to interest due; and last, to principal due.
- 4. <u>Charges</u>; <u>Liens</u>. Borrowers shall pay all taxes, assessments, charges, fines and impositions attributable to the Property which may attain priority over this Security Instrument, and leasehold payments or ground rents, if any. Borrowers shall pay these obligations in the manner provided in Paragraph 2, or if not paid in that manner, Borrowers shall pay them on time directly to the person owed payment. Borrower shall promptly furnish to Lender all notices of amounts to be paid under this Paragraph. If

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Borrowers make these payments directly, Borrowers shall promptly furnish to Lender receipts evidencing the payments.

Borrowers shall promptly discharge any lien which has priority over this Security Instrument unless Borrowers: (a) agree in writing to the payment of the obligation secured by the lien in a manner acceptable to Lender; (b) contests in good faith the lien by, or defends against enforcement of the lien in, legal proceedings which in the Lender's opinion operate to prevent the enforcement of the lien or forfeiture of any part of the Property; or (c) secures from the holder of the lien an agreement satisfactory to Lender subor tinating the lien to this Security Instrument. If Lender determines that any part of the Property is subject to a lien which may attain priority over this Security Instrument, Lender nay give Borrowers a notice identifying the lien. Borrowers shall satisfy the lien or take one or more of the actions set forth above within ten (10) days of the giving of notice.

5. <u>Hazard Jusurance</u>. Borrowers shall keep the improvements now existing or hereafter erected on the Property insured against loss by fire, hazards included within the term "extended coverage" and any other hazards for which Lender requires insurance. This insurance shall be maintained in the amounts and for the periods that Lender requires. The insurance carrier providing the insurance shall be chosen by Borrower subject to Lender's approval which shall not be unreasonably withheld.

All insurance policies and renewals stall be acceptable to Lender and shall include a standard mortgage clause. Lender shall have the right to hold the Policies and Renewals. If Lender requires, Borrower shall promptly give to Lender all receipts of paid premiums and renewal notices. In the event of loss, Borrower shall give prompt notice to the insurance carrier and the Lender. Lender may make proof of loss if not made promptly by Borrower.

Unless Lender and Borrowers otherwise agree in writing, insurance proceeds shall be applied to restoration or repair of the Property damaged, if the restoration or repair is economically feasible and Lender's security is not lessened. If the restoration or repair is not economically feasible or Lender's security would be lessened, the insurance proceeds shall be applied to the sums secured by this Security Instrument, whether or not then due, with any excess paid to Borrowers. If Borrowers abandons the Property, or does not answer within thirty (30) days a notice from Lender that the insurance carrier has offered to settle a claim, then Lender may collect the insurance proceeds. Lender may use the proceeds to repair or restore the Property or to pay sums secured by this Security Instrument, whether or not then due. The thirty (30) day period will begin when the notice is given.

6. <u>Preservation and Maintenance of Property</u>. Borrowers shall not destroy, damage or substantially change the Property, allow the Property to deteriorate or commit waste.

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7. Protection of Lender's Rights in the Property. If Borrowers fail to perform the covenants and agreements contained in this Security Instrument, or there is a legal proceeding that may significantly affect Lender's rights in the Property (such as a proceeding in bankruptcy, probate, for condemnation or to enforce laws or regulations), the Lender may do and pay for whatever is necessary to protect the value of the Property and Lender's rights in the Property. Lender's actions may include paying any sums secured by a lien which has priority over this Security Instrument, appearing in court, paying reasonable attorneys' fees and entering on the Property to make repairs. Although Lender's paying take action under this Paragraph 7, Lender does not have to do so.

Any amounts disbursed by Lender under this Paragraph 7 shall become additional debt of Borrowers secured by this Security Instrument. Unless Borrowers and Lender agree to other terms of payment, these amounts shall bear interest from the date of disbursement at the Note rate and shall be payable, with interest, upon notice from Lender to Borrower requesting payment.

- 8. <u>Inspection</u>. I ender or its agent may make reasonable entries upon and inspections of the Property. Lender shall give Borrowers notice at the time of or prior to an inspection specifying reasonable can see for the inspection.
- 9. <u>Condemnation</u>. The proceeds of any award or claim for damages, direct or consequential, in connection with any concennation or other taking of any part of the Property, or for conveyance in lieu of condemnation, are hereby assigned and shall be paid to Lender.

In the event of a total taking of the Property, the proceeds shall be applied to the sums secured by this Security Instrument, whether or not then are, with any excess paid to Borrower. In the event of a partial taking of the Property, unless Porrowers and Lender otherwise agree in writing, the sums secured by this Security Instrument shall be reduced by the amount of the proceeds multiplied by the following fraction: (a) the total amount of the sums secured immediately before the taking divided by (b) the fair market value of the Property immediately before the taking. Any balance shall be paid to Borroy or

If the Property is abandoned by Borrower, or if, after notice by Lender to Borrowers that the condemner offers to make an award or settle a claim for damages, Borrowers fail to respond to Lender, within thirty (30) days after the date the notice is given, Lender is authorized to collect and apply the proceeds, at its option, either to restoration or repair of the Property or to the sums secured by this Security Instrument, whether or not then due.

Unless Lender and Borrower otherwise agree in writing, any application of proceeds to principal shall not extend or postpone the due date of the monthly payments referred to in Paragraphs 1 and 2 or change the amount of such payments.

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- Extension of the time for payment or modification of amortization of the sums secured by this Security Instrument granted by Lender to any successor in interest of Borrowers shall not operate to release the liability of the original Borrowers or Borrowers' successors in interest. Lender shall not be required to commence proceedings against any successor in interest or refuse to extend time for payment or otherwise modify amortization of the sums secured by this Security Instrument by reason of any demand made by the original Borrower or Borrower's successors in interest. Any forbearance by Lender in exercising any right or remedy shall not be a waiver of or preclude the exercise of any right or remedy
- 11. Successors and Assigns Bound; Joint and Several Liability; Cosigners. The covenants and agreements of this Security Instrument shall bind and benefit the successors and assigns of Lender and Borrower, subject to the provisions of Paragraph 17. Borrowers' covenants and agreements shall be joint and several. Any Borrower who co-signs this Security Instrument but does not execute the Note: (a) is cosigning this Security Instrument only to mortgage, grant and convey that Borrowers' interest in the Property under the terms of this Security Instrument; (b) is not personally obligated to pay the sums secured by this Security Instrument; and (c) agrees that Lender and any other Borrowers may agreed to extend, modify, forbear or make any accommodations with regard to the terms of this Security Instrument or the Note without that Borrower's consent.
- 12. Loan Charges. If the loan secured by this Security Instrument is subject to a law which sets maximum loan charges, and that have is finally interpreted so that the interest or other loan charges collected or to be collected in connection with the loan exceed the permitted limits, then: (a) any such loan charge small or reduced by the amount necessary to reduce the charge to the permitted limit; and (b) any sums already collected from Borrowers which exceeded permitted limits will be refunded to Borrowers. Lender may choose to make this refund by reducing the principal owed under the Note or by making a direct payment to Borrowers. If a refund reduces principal, the eduction will be treated as a partial prepayment without any prepayment charge under the Note.
- 13. <u>Legislation Affecting Lender's Rights</u>. If enactment or expiration of applicable laws has the effect of rendering any provision of the Note or this Security Instrument unenforceable according to its terms, Lender, at its option, may require immediate payment in full of all sums secured by this Security Instrument and may invoke any remedies permitted by Paragraph 19. If Lender exercises this option, Lender shall take the steps specified in the second paragraph of Paragraph 17.
- 14. <u>Notices</u>. Any notice to Borrowers provided for in this Security Instrument shall be given by delivering it or by mailing it by first class mail unless applicable law requires use of another method. The notice shall be directed to the Property Address or any other address Borrowers designate by notice to Lender. Any notice to Lender shall be

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given by first class mail to Lender's address stated herein or any other address Lender designates by notice to Borrowers. Any notice provided for in this Security Instrument shall be deemed to have been given to Borrowers or Lender when given as provided in this Paragraph.

- 15. Governing Law; Severability. This Security Instrument shall be governed by the law of the State of Illinois. In the event that any provision or clause of this Security Instrument or the Note conflicts with applicable law, such conflict shall not affect other provisions of this Security Instrument or the Note which can be given effect with at the conflicting provision. To this end the provisions of this Security Instrument and the Note and declared to be severable.
- 16. <u>Parrowers' Copy</u>. Borrowers shall be given one (1) conformed copy of the Note and of this Security Instrument.
- 17. Transfer of the Property or a Beneficial Interest in Borrower. If all or any part of the Property or any interest in it is sold or transferred (or if a beneficial interest in Borrowers is sold or transferred and Borrower is not a natural person) without Lender's prior written consent, Lender may, it its option, require immediate payment in full of all sums secured by this Security Instrument. However, this option shall not be exercised by Lender if exercise is prohibited by federal law as of the date of this Security Instrument.
- If Lender exercises this option, Lender shall give Borrowers notice of acceleration. The notice shall provide a period of not less than thirty (30) days from the date the notice is delivered or mailed within which Por owers must pay all sums secured by this Security Instrument. If Borrowers fail to pay these sums prior to the expiration of this period, Lender may invoke any remedies permitted by this Security Instrument without further notice or demand on Borrowers.
- Borrowers' Right to Reinstate. If Borrowers meet certain conditions, 18. Borrowers shall have the right to have enforcement of this Security Instrument discontinued at any time prior to the earlier of: (a) five (5) days (or such caner period as applicable law may specify for reinstatement) before sale of the Property pursuant to any power of sale contained in this Security Instrument; or (b) entry of a judgment enforcing this Security Instrument. Those conditions are that Borrowers: (a) pay Lender all sums which then would be due under this Security Instrument and the Note had no acceleration occurred; (b) cures any default of any other covenants or agreements; (c) pays all expenses incurred in enforcing this Security Instrument, including, but not limited to, reasonable attorneys' fee; and (d) takes such action as Lender may reasonably require to assure that the lien of this Security Instrument, Lender's rights in the Property and Borrowers' obligation to pay the sum secured by this Security Instrument shall continue Upon reinstatement by Borrowers, this Security Instrument and the obligations secured hereby shall remain fully effective as if no acceleration had occurred. However, this right to reinstate shall not apply in the case of acceleration under Paragraphs 13 or 17.

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**NON-UNIFORM COVENANTS**. Borrowers and Lender further covenant and agree as follows:

- 19. Acceleration; Remedies. Lender shall give notice to Borrowers prior to acceleration following Borrowers' breach of any covenant or agreement in this Security Instrument (but not prior to acceleration under Paragraphs 13 and 17 unless applicable law provides otherwise). The notice shall specify: (a) the default; (b) the action required to cure the default; (c) a date, not less than thirty (30) days from the date the notice is given to Borrowers, by which the default must be cured; and (d) that failure to cure the default on or before the date specified in the notice may result in acceleration of the sums secured by this Security Instrument, foreclosure by judicial proceeding and sale of the Property. The notice shall further inform Borrowers of the right to reinstate after acceleration and the right to assert in the foreclosure proceeding the nonexistence of a default of any other defense of Borrowers to acceleration and foreclosure. If the default is not cured on or before the date specified in the notice, Lender at its option may require immediate payment in full of all sums secured by this Security Instrument without further demand and may foreclose this Security Instrument by judicial proceeding. Lender shall be entitled to collect all expenses incurred in pursuing the remedies provided in this Paragraph 19, including, but not limited to, reasonable attorneys' fees and costs of title evidence.
- 20. <u>Lender in Possession</u>. Upon acceleration under Paragraph 19 or abandonment of the Property and at any time prior to the expiration of any period of redemption following judicial sale, Lender (in person, by agent or by judicially appointed receiver) shall be entitled to enter upon, take possession of and manage the Property and to collect the rents of the Property including those past due. Any rents collected by Lender or the receiver shall be applied first to payment of the costs of management of the Property and collection of rents, including, but not limited to, eceiver's fees, premiums on receiver's bonds and reasonable attorneys' fees, and then to the sum secured by this Security Instrument.
- 21. Release. Upon payment of all sums secured by this Security Instrument, Lender shall release this Security Instrument without charge to Borrowers. For every shall pay any recordation costs.
- 22. <u>Waiver of Homestead</u>. Borrowers waive all right of homestead exemption in the Property.

BY SIGNING BELOW, Borrowers accept and agree to the terms and covenants contained in this Security Instrument and in any rider(s) executed by Borrowers and recorded with it.
