CITYOF CHICAGO'S COMPLAINT FOR EQUITABLE AND OTHER RELIEF

Plaintiff, THE CITY OF CHICAGO ("the City"), by and through its attorney, Stephen R. Patton, Corporation Counsel, and the undersigned attorney, complains of the defendants as follows:

GENERAL ALLEGATIONS

Nature of the Case

The City brings this action pursuant to its police power as a home rule unit under the Illinois Constitution, article VII, § 6(a), 65 ILCS 5/11-31-1(a) et seq. (West 2012), 65 ILCS 5/11-13-15, and provisions of the Municipal Code of Chicago. By bringing this action, the City socks to abate dangerous and unsafe conditions at the property in question and obtain equitable relief, civil penalties,

The Parties and the Property at Issue

- The City is a municipal corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Illinois.
- Within the corporate limits of Chicago, there is a parcel of real estate legally described as:

LOT 17 IN BLOCK 2 IN SAMUEL EICHBREG'S SUBDIVISION OF THE NORTH 1/2 OF THE WEST 1/2 OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 29, TOWNSHIP 38 NORTH, RANGE 14, EAST OF THE THIRD PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN, IN COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS.
