JUDGMENT FOR DISSOLUTION OF MARRIAGE

THIS CAUSE having come for a hearing upon the Petition for Dissolution of Marriage of the Petitioner, Yolanda Gutierrez. The Petitioner having appeared in open court in person representing herself pro se, and the Respondent, Humberto Gutierrez, having had notice of the pendency of this suit by publication on _____, 2004; Respondent having been defaulted for failure to file an Appearance or Answer to the Petition for Dissolution of Marriage; and the Court having heard the testimony of the Petitioner offering proof and support of the allegation and charges contained in her said Petition and the Court considering all the evidences and arguments of the counsel, and now being fully advised in the premises, FINDS:

A. That the Petitioner, Yolanda Gutierrez, is forty-six (46) years of age and presently resides at 3504 S. 52nd Ct, Cicero, having resided in the State of Illinois, Cook County for at least ninety days (90) preceding the filing of this petition. B. That the Respondent Humberto Gutierrez, is fifty (50) years of age, and his current address is unknown.

C. That the parties were lawfully married on July 2, 1994, in Cicero, Illinois.

D. That no children born to the parties. That no children were adopted by the parties.

E. That the parties have lived separated and apart since August 2, 1999.
