

#### ORDER FOR RECEIVER'S SECOND CERTIFICATE

This matter coming on to be heard on Receiver's Petition for the Court's approval of second accounting and for authorization to issue a receiver's certificates, with due notice being given to all parties and the Court being fully advised in the premises;

#### THE COURT FINDS:

- 1. That on June 12, 2018, Glober otters Engineering Corporation was appointed limited receiver for the purpose of performing various ser ices at the premises.
- 2. That Receiver performed various services as detailed in the second accounting for fees and expenses from October 29, 2018 through and including February 24, 2019.
- 3. That Receiver's second accounting states that, in the course of fulfilling its duties, Receiver incurred out of pocket costs totaling \$314.00, and that \$7,342.85 in fees were billed for a combined total of \$7,656.85.
- 4. The Court has in rem jurisdiction over the subject procesty and the Defendants, such as could be located for service of process, received due notice of the receivers appointment, its accounting and its petition for approval of the second accounting 44438.85
- 5. After thorough consideration of the Motion and attached exhibits, this Court finds that \$314.00 in out of pocket costs and \$7,342.85 in fees, for a total of \$7,656.85 is fair, just and reasonable compensation for the work completed by Receiver.

### WHEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:
