The Remedial Action Completion Report (received November 26, 2018/Log No. 18-68283) and the Remedial Action Completion Report Addendum (received August 8, 2019/Log No. 19-69828), as prepared by Carlson Environmental, Inc. for the above referenced Remediation Site, have been reviewed and approved by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency ("Illinois EPA"). Conditions and Terms of Approval

Level of Remediation and Land Use Limitations

- 1) The recognized environmental conditions characterized by the focused site investigation and successfully addressed, consist of the contaminants of concern identified in the attached Table A.
- 2) The Remediation Site is approved for Residential and/or Industrial/Commercial land use.
- 3) The land use specified in this Letter may be revised if:
 - a) Further investigation or remedial action has been conducted that documents the attainment of objectives appropriate for the new land use; and
 - b) A new Letter is obtained and recorded in accordance with Title XVII of the Act and regulations adopted thereunder.

Preventive, Engineering, and Institutional Controls

The implementation and maintenance of the following controls are required as part of the approval of the remediation objectives for this Remediation Site.

Preventive Controls:

4) At a minimum, a safety plan should be developed to address possible worker exposure in the event that any future excavation and construction activities may occur within the contaminated soil. Any excavation within the contaminated soil will require implementation of a safety plan consistent with NIOSH Occupational Safety and Health Guidance Manual for Hazardous Waste Site Activities, OSHA regulations (particularly in 29 CFR 1910 and 1926), state and local regulations, and other USEPA guidance. Soil excavated below the surface grade must be returned to the same depth from which it was excavated or properly managed or disposed in accordance with applicable state and federal regulations.

Engineering Controls:

There are no engineering controls required.

Institutional Controls:

5) Any existing buildings or any future buildings constructed within the designated area depicted on the Site Base Map must contain a full concrete slab-on-grade floor or full concrete basement floor and walls with no unsealed sumps.

- 6) Any sump located within the designated area as depicted on the Site Base Map must remain sealed with the approved cap and vent system. A caution label must be affixed to the vent pipe indicating that the system cannot be dismantled without proper consultation. A vacuum pressure gauge must be installed on the system to provide a clear indication of when the system is operating properly and when maintenance is required. In addition, the sump cover must be resealed if it is ever removed for sump pump inspection, replacement, maintenance or for any other reason. The vent system must also be correctly maintained under such circumstances.
- 7) No person shall construct, install, maintain, or operate a potable well at the Remediation Site. All water supplies and water services for the Remediation Site must be obtained from a public water supply system. The provisions of this institutional control shall be applicable to all water usage (e.g., domestic, industrial/commercial uses and outdoor watering).

- 8) The Remediation Applicant has remediated the release associated with Leaking UST Incident Number 20160118 and 20160257.
- 9) Where the Remediation Applicant is <u>not</u> the sole owner of the Remediation Site, the Remediation Applicant shall complete the attached *Property Owner Certification of the No Further Remediation Letter under the Site Remediation Program* Form. This certification, by original signature of each property owner, or the authorized agent of the owner(s), of the Remediation Site or any portion thereof who is not a Remediation Applicant shall be recorded along with this Letter.


