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RECEIVERS' DEED

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That whereas on September 7, 1968 in Case #64 C 1285, United States District Court, Northern District of Illinois, Eastern Division, we Leonard B. Ettelson and William J. Friedman were appointed Receivers of City Savings Association, an Illinois Corporation, with the usual powers and duties of such office; and

WHEREAS, we as Receivers, did on the 10th day of September, 1968 give bond and duly qualify as said Receivers and take possession of all the real and personal property of the defendant; and

WHEREAS, on December 22, 1970, we, as said Receivers, filed in said cause a Petition asking said Court for an order giving permission to sell the real estate described herein and said order having been granted; and

WHEREAS, on December 22, 1970, we as Receivers filed in said cause a Motion asking said Court for an order appointing Jerome Whiston, John Pittroff and Robert Walker as appraisers of the real estate described herein, accepting the appraisers' opinion of value of such real estate, and approving the terms of the sale of said real estate; and

WHEREAS, we, as Receivers, having advertised the terms of the sale in the Chicago Daily Law Bulletin, a newspaper of general circulation in Cook County for ten days prior hereto; and

WHEREAS said Court on January 12, 1971, having examined our report of said sale and having found that said sale had been conducted in all ways according to law, the same was by said Court approved and confirmed.

Now, therefore, we Leonard B. Ettelson and William J. Friedman, not individually, but as Receivers of City Savings Association, by virtue of the powers vested in us by law, and in consideration of the premises and of the sum of Twenty Thousand Nine Hundred (\$20,900.00) Dollars, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, and under and by virtue of the orders of said Court, do hereby give, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto Martin Minogue and Ann Minogue, his wife, as joint tenants and not as tenants in common, their heirs and assigns forever, all of the estate, title and interest of City Savings Association, an Illinois Corporation, in and to the following described real estate situate in Cook County, and described as follows:-

Lot 3 in Second Addition to Line-Crest Manor, being a Resubdivision of Block 'B' in First Addition to Line-Crest Manor, being a Subdivision of part of the South East quarter of Section 22, Township 37 North, Range 13 East of the Third Principal Meridian, according to the plat thereof recorded February 19, 1959 as document 17461147 in Cook County, Illinois.
