KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That whereas on September 7, 1968 in Case #64 C 1285, United States District Court, Northern District of Illinois, Eastern Division, we Leonard B. Ettelson and William J. Friedman were appointed Receivers of City Savings Association, an Illinois Corporation, with the usual powers and duties of such office; and

WHEREAS, we as Receivers, did on the 10th day of September, 1968 give bond and duly qualify as said Receivers and take possession of all the real and personal property of the defendant; and

WHEREAS, on May 7, 1971, we, as said Receivers, filed in said cause a Petition asking said Court for an order giving permission to sell the real estate described herein and said order having been granted; and

WHEREAS, on May 7, 1971, we as Receivers filed in said cause a Motion asking said Court for an order appointing Jerome Whiston, John Pittroff and Robert Walker as appraisers of the real estate described herein, accepting the appraisers' opinion of value of such real estate, and approving the terms of the sale of said real estate; and

WHEREAS, we, as Receivers, having advertised the terms of the sale in the Chicago Daily Law Bulletin, a newspaper of general circulation in Cook County for ten days prior hereto; and

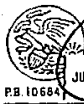
