TRUSTEE'S DEED

THIS INDENTURE, made this 5th day of June 1971 between BEVERLY BANK, a banking corporation of Illinois, as successor Trustee, party of the first part, and ALBERT C. DIBENEDETTO and MICHAEL G. DIBENEDETTO, his wife, parties of the second part, WITNESSETH: WHEREAS, 14516 S. 85th Avenue, Orland Park, Illinois, was named Trustee under the provisions of a deed or deeds in trust duly recorded or registered and delivered to said Bank in pursuance of a trust agreement dated the 6th day of March, 1969, and known as Trust No. 8-1742; and WHEREAS, the aforesaid trust agreement was amended to provide that any corporate successor to the trust business of any corporate trustee named therein or acting thereunder shall become trustee in place of its predecessor without the necessity of any conveyance or transfer; and WHEREAS, said party of the first part succeeded to the trust business of said Old Beverly Bank on November 21, 1969 and is the duly authorized successor Trustee pursuant to said trust agreement as amended; NOW, THEREFORE, said party of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Ten Dollars, and other good and valuable considerations in hand paid, does hereby grant, sell and convey unto said parties of the second part, not as tenants in common, but as joint tenants the following described real estate, situated in Cook County, Illinois, to-wit:

Lot 118 in C. J. Mehling's Maycliff Silver Lake Estates, Unit #5, a Subdivision of part of the west 60 acres of the North 120 acres of the Northwest quarter of Section 11, Township 36 North, Range 12, East of the Third Principal Meridian.

Together with the tenements and appurtenances thereunto belonging TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto said parties of the second part, not in tenancy in common, but in joint tenancy, and to the proper use, benefit and behoof of each of said party of the second part.

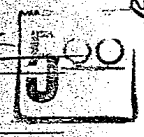
Subject to: Covenants, conditions and restrictions of record; General taxes for the year 1971 and subsequent years.
