TRUSTEE'S DEED

THIS INDENTURE, made this 10th day of October, 1971, between BEVERLY BANK, a banking corporation of Illinois, as successor Trustee, party of the first part, and ROBERT E. MILLER and DELORIS R. MILLER, his wife parties of the second part, WITNESSETH: WHEREAS, Old Beverly Bank (formerly Beverly Bank), a banking corporation of Illinois, was named Trustee under the provisions of a deed or deeds in trust duly recorded or registered and delivered to said Bank in pursuance of a trust agreement dated the 4th day of January, 1968 and known as Trust No 8-1300; and WHEREAS, the aforesaid trust agreement was amended to provide that any corporate successor to the trust business of any corporate trustee named therein or acting thereunder shall become trustee in place of its predecessor without the necessity of any conveyance or transfer; and WHEREAS, said party of the first part succeeded to the trust business of said Old Beverly Bank on November 21, 1969 and is the duly authorized successor Trustee pursuant to said trust agreement as amended; NOW, THEREFORE, said party of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Ten Dollars, and other good and valuable considerations in hand paid, does hereby grant, sell and convey unto said parties of the second part, not as tenants in common, but as joint tenants the following described real estate, situated in Cook County, Illinois, to-wit:

Lot 1 in Second Addition to Lamplighter being a subdivision of part of the East ½ of the West ½ of the Northwest ¼ of the Northwest ¼ of Section 22, Township 36 North, Range 14, East of the Third Principal Meridian, in Cook County, Illinois

Property of Beverly Bank

Together with the tenements and appurtenances thereunto belonging, TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto said parties of the second part, not in tenancy in common, but in and to the present use, benefit and behoof forever of said party of the second part.

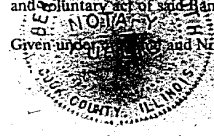

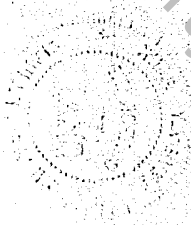
