RECEIVERS' DEED

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That whereas on September 7, 1968 in Case #64 C 1285, United States District Court, Northern District of Illinois, Eastern Division, we Leonard B. Ettelson and William J. Friedman were appointed Receivers of City Savings Association, an Illinois Corporation, with the usual powers and duties of such office; and

WHEREAS, we as Receivers, did on the 10th day of September, 1968 give bond and duly qualify as said Receivers and take possession of all the real and personal property of the defendant; and

WHEREAS, on April 3, 1972, we, as said Receivers, filed in said cause a Petition asking said Court for an order giving permission to sell the real estate described herein and said order having been granted; and

WHEREAS, on March 6, 1972, we as Receivers, filed in said cause a Motion asking said Court for an order appointing Jerome Whiston, John Pittroff and Robert Walker as appraisers of the real estate described herein, accepting the appraisers' opinion of value of such real estate, and approving the terms of the sale of said real estate; and

WHEREAS, we, as Receivers having advertised the terms of the sale in the Chicago Daily Law Bulletin, a newspaper of general circulation in Cook County for ten days prior hereto; and

WHEREAS, said Court on April 26, 1972, having examined our report of said sale and having found that said sale had been conducted in all ways according to law, the same was by said Court approved and confirmed.

NOW, THEREFORE, City Savings Association and we, Leonard B. Ettelson and William J. Friedman, not individually, but as Receivers of City Savings Association, by virtue of the powers vested in us by law, and in consideration of the premises and of the sum of \$16,500.00 Dollars, the receipt

whereof is hereby acknowledged, and under and by virtue of the orders of said Court, do hereby give, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto Garey L. Marshall and Romanie Marshall as Joint Tenants Nottas Tenants in common and their heirs and assigns forever, all of the estate, title and interest of City Savings Association, an Illinois Corporation, and of Leonard B. Ettelson and William J. Friedman, not individually but as Receivers of City Savings Association, in and to the following described real estate situated in Cook County, and described as follows:

Lot 92 and the North 15 feet of Lot 93 in Valentine Woods Subdivision of the West 10 acres of Lot 6 in Circuit Court Partition of 63.22 acres in the East 1/2 of the North East 1/4 of Section 36, Township 40 North, Range 13, East of the Third Principal Meridian, lying North of Milwaukee Avenue in Cook County, Illinois.
