This Indenture Witnesseth,

That the grantor, JULIUS C. THORNTON
AND ELIZABETH THORNTON his wife and
WINFRED C. THORNTON a bachelor
of Cook County, Illinois,
in consideration of NINETY-FIVE HUNDRED AND NO/100 Dollars
(\$9500.00), in hand paid, CONVEY and WARRANT to DONALD DE HAAN,
Trustee, of Cook County, Illinois, and to his
successors in trust, the following described real estate, with the improvements thereon, including all heating, gas and plumbing apparatus, and all fixtures, together with the rents, profits and income thereof, and everything appurtenant thereto, situated in the County of Cook in the State of Illinois, to-wit:

Lot Thirty-two (32) in Block Four (4) in Pierce's Park, a Subdivision of the South West Quarter of the North East Quarter of Section 35, Township 38 North, Range 14 East of the Third Principal Meridian, in Cook County, Illinois.

Hereby releasing and waiving all rights under and by virtue of the homestead exemption laws of the State of Illinois:

In Trust, nevertheless, for the purpose of securing performance of the covenants and agreements herein set forth,
Whereas, the grantor Julius C. Thornton and Elizabeth Thornton, his wife, and Winfred C. Thornton, a bachelor, are

jointly indebted upon their one principal promissory note, bearing even date herewith, payable to BEARER for the principal sum of NINETY-FIVE HUNDRED AND NO/100 (\$9500.00) DOLLARS payable in monthly installments of One Hundred Twelve and 77/100 (\$112.77) Dollars, or more, on the 18th day of each and every month hereafter until the whole sum shall have been fully paid. Above payments include interest at the rate of 7-1/2% per annum, payable monthly, on the whole sum remaining from time to time unpaid at the office of DE HAAN AGENCY 1080 South Western Avenue, Chicago, Illinois.

Both principal and interest notes bear interest at the rate of seven per cent per annum after maturity, and are payable in lawful money of the United States of America at the office of DE HAAN AGENCY in Chicago, Illinois, or at such other place as the legal holder thereof may from time to time in writing appoint.

The Grantor agrees as follows: (1) to pay said indebtedness, and the interest thereon as herein and in said notes provided, or according to any agreement extending time of payment; (2) to pay, prior to the first day of July in each year, all taxes and assessments against said premises, and, on demand, to exhibit receipts therefor; (3) within sixty days after destruction or damage to rebuild or restore all buildings or improvements on said premises that may have been destroyed or damaged; (4) to keep said premises in good condition and repair without waste and free from any mechanics' or other liens or claims of lien; (5) to complete within a reasonable time any and all buildings now or at any time in process of erection on said premises; and (6) to keep all buildings at any time on said premises insured against loss by fire, lightning and tornado to their full insurable value, in companies to be approved by the legal holder of the indebtedness secured hereby, with loss clause payable to the grantee herein as his interest may appear, and all such policies shall be issued and remain with the legal holder of the indebtedness secured hereby. The grantee is empowered to adjust, compromise, submit to arbitration or a settlement, and collect, and apply to the reduction of said indebtedness any claim for loss arising under any insurance policy covering said premises. That and the grantee is irrevocably appointed the attorney in fact of the grantor for them and in their name and seal to execute and deliver such receipts, releases and other writings as shall be requisite to completely accomplish such adjustment, compromise, arbitration, approval and collection. In case of foreclosure hereof each such insurance policy may be endorsed or rewritten so as to make loss thereunder payable to the grantee or creditors or after sale pursuant to such decree to the holder of the Master's certificate of sale, and such decree may so provide.

In case of default therein the grantee, or the holder of said indebtedness, or any part thereof, may, but is not obliged to, make any payment or perform any act heretofore required of the grantor, as may, but is not obliged to, purchase, discharge, compromise or settle any tax lien or other lien or title or claim thereof, or redeem from any tax sale or lien or title or claim thereof, or do any act or thing affecting said premises and when so doing, is not obliged to inquire into the validity of any tax, assessment, tax sale, forfeiture, or lien or title or claim thereof. If any building or other improvement upon said premises, at any time, shall not be completed within a reasonable time, the Trustee of any such holder may cause the completion thereof in any form and manner deemed expedient. All moneys paid for any of the aforesaid purposes and all moneys paid or incurred in connection therewith, including attorney's fees, and any other moneys advanced by the grantee or such holder to prosecute the same hereunder, and reasonable compensation for each matter concerning which action herein authorized may be taken, shall be so much additional indebtedness secured hereby, immediately due and payable without notice, with interest at seven per cent per annum.

In the event of a breach of any of the aforesaid agreements, the whole of said indebtedness, including principal and all earned interest shall, at the option of the legal holder thereof, without notice, become immediately due and payable, with interest thereon from the time of such breach at seven per cent per annum, shall be recoverable by foreclosure hereof, or by suit at law, with, in either case, the same as if all said indebtedness had been matured by express terms. All expenses and disbursements, paid or incurred in behalf of any party in connection with proceedings for the foreclosure hereof, including reasonable solicitor's fees, outlays for documentary evidence, stenographer's charges, cost of procuring or of completing abstract showing the whole title to said premises, shall be paid by the grantor, and, and the like expenses and disbursements occasioned by any suit or proceeding wherein the grantee, or any holder of any part of said indebtedness, as such, may be a party by reason hereof shall also be paid by the grantor, and; all of which expenses and disbursements shall be an additional lien upon said premises, and included in any decree that may be rendered in such foreclosure proceeding. The grantor, and waives all right to the possession of, and income from, said premises pending such foreclosure proceedings, and consents that upon the filing of a bill to foreclose this Trust Deed, the grantee or some other suitable person or corporation may be appointed Receiver of said premises, without notice, and without complaint being required to give any bond, whether the premises be then occupied as a homestead or not, and irrespective of the solvency of any person or the adequacy of the security, with the usual powers and duties of Receivers, and that said Receiver may continue in office during the pendency of said foreclosure and thereafter until redemption is made or the issuance of Deed in case of sale, and may collect rents, alter or repair said premises and put and maintain them in first class condition and order, and may pay expenses of Receivership, insurance premiums, all taxes and assessments which are a lien or charge at any time during the Receivership of said alterations and repairs, and may also pay and do whatever the grantee is hereby authorized to pay and do. The net income, or any portion thereof, may be applied from time to time on any foreclosure decree entered in such proceedings, and in case of a sale and deficiency, the deficiency, if any, or there be a decree therefor in personam or not, and whether any subsequent owner of the equity of redemption be liable therefor or not, shall be paid out of the net income remaining at the termination of the Receivership.

As additional security the grantor, and hereby assigns all the rents, issues and profits arising or to arise out of said premises to the grantee herein and authorizes him, in his own name as assignee, or otherwise, to receive, sue for, or otherwise collect the same, issues and profits, to serve all notices which may be or become necessary to institute forcible detainer proceedings, to receive, possess, lease and re-lease said premises, or any portion thereof, for such term or terms, and upon such conditions as he may deem proper, and apply the proceeds thereof, first, to the payment of the expense of operating and charges against said premises; and, second, to the payment of the indebtedness hereby secured, covering the overplus, if any, to the grantor, and if and when the indebtedness hereby secured shall have been fully paid.

In The Event of the death or permanent removal from said Cook County of the grantor, or his wife, or failure to act thereon C. C. DE HAAN of said Cook County, is hereby made first successor in this trust, and invested with all the title and the powers granted to said grantee, and if for any reason said first successor also shall fail or refuse to act, the person who shall then be the acting Recorder of Deeds of said Cook County is hereby made second successor in this trust with like title and powers.

When all of the aforesaid agreements are performed, the grantee or his successor in trust, shall release said premises to the party entitled, on receiving his reasonable charges.
This Trust Deed and all provisions hereof, shall extend to and be binding upon the grantor, and and all persons claiming under or through the grantor, and.
