WHEREAS, in pursuance of a decree entered on the 2d day of June, 1972, by the U. S. District Court for the Northern District of Illinois, in a certain cause then pending therein, wherein United States of America was plaintiff and Elijah Thurston Foundation, Inc., an Illinois not-for-profit corporation, was the defendant, which case bore Civil Number 72 C 564 on the docket of said Court, said first party, as United States Marshal, duly advertised according to law and to the highest and best bidder on the 12th day of July, 1972, at the hour of 2:00 o'clock in the afternoon, DST, in Room 704 in the Chicago Civic Center, in the City of Chicago, Cook County, Illinois; and

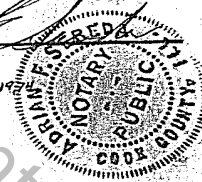

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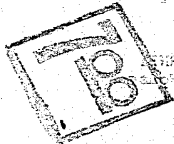
