ORDER FOR RECEIVER'S FOURTH/FINAL CERTIFICATE

THE COURT FINDS:

- 1. That on April 16, 2019, Globe rotters International, Inc. was appointed limited receiver for the purpose of performing various services at the premises.
- 2. That Receiver performed various ser icts as detailed in the fourth/final accounting for fees and expenses from March 22, 2021 through and including July 13, 2021.
- 3. That Receiver's fourth/final accounting states that, in the course of fulfilling its duties, Receiver incurred out of pocket costs totaling \$0.00, and that \$5,546.25 in fees were billed for a combined total of \$5,546.25.
- 4. The Court has in rem jurisdiction over the subject property and the Defendants, such as could be located for service of process, received due notice of the receive.'s appointment, its accounting and its petition for approval of the fourth/final accounting.
