TOGETHER with all improvements, tenements, easements, fixtures, and appurtenances thereto belonging, and all rents, issues and profits thereof for so long and during all such times as Mortgagors may be entitled thereto (which are pledged primarily and on a parity with said real estate and not secondarily), and all apparatus, equipment or articles now or hereafter therein or thereon used to supply heat, gas, air conditioning, water, light, power, refrigeration (whether single units or centrally controlled), and ventilation, including (without restricting the forecastics) assessments, including, and apparatus, and apparatuses, and apparatuses as Mortgagors may be entitled thereto (which are pledged primarily and on a parity with said real estate and not secondarily), and all apparatus, equipment or articles now or hereafter therein or thereto controlled, and ventilation, which is the proposed of the proposed propose including (without restricting the foregoing), screens, window shades, storm doors and windows, floor cover-

ings, inador beds, awnings, stoves and water heaters. All of the foregoing are declared to be a part of said real estate whether physically attached thereto or not, and it is agreed that all similar apparatus, equipment or articles hereafter placed in the premises by the mortgagors or their successors or assigns shall be considered as constituting part of the real estate.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the premises unto the said Trustee, its successors and assigns, forever, for the purposes, and upon the uses and trusts herein set forth, free from all rights and benefits under and by virtue of the Homestead Exemption Laws of the State of Illinois, which said rights and benefits the Mortgagors do hereby expressly release and waive.

IT IS FURTHER UNDERSTOOD AND AGREED THAT:

- 1. Mortgagors shall (1) promptly repair, restore or rebuild any buildings or improvements now or hereafter on the premises which may become damaged or be destroyed; (2) keep said premises in good condition and repair, without waste, and free from mechanic's or other liens or claims for lien not expressly subordinated to the lien hereof; (3) pay when due any indebtedness which may be secured by a lien or charge on the premises superior to the lien hereof, and upon request exhibit satisfactory evidence of the discharge of such prior lien to Trustee or to holders of the note; (4) complete within a reasonable time any buildings or buildings now or at any time in process of erection upon said premises; (5) comply with all requirements of law or municipal ordinances with respect to the premises and the use thereof; (6) make no material alterations in said premises except as required by law or municipal ordinance.
- 2. Mortgagors shall pay before any penalty attaches all general taxes, and shall pay special taxes, special assessments, water charges, sewer service charges, and other charges against the premises when due, and shall, upon written request, furnish to Trustee or to holders of the note duplicate receipts therefor. To revent default hereunder Mortgagors shall pay in full under protest, in the manner provided by statute, any ax or assessment which Mortgagors may desire to contest.
- 3. Mortgagors shall keep all buildings and improvements now or hereafter situated on said premises inside against loss or damage by fire, lightning or windstorm under policies providing for payment by the insurance companies of moneys sufficient either to pay the cost of replacing or repairing the same or to pay in for the indebtedness secured hereby, all in companies satisfactory to the holders of the note, under insurance policies rayable, in case of loss or damage, to Trustee for the benefit of the holders of the note, such rights to be at decade by the standard mortgage clause to be attached to each policy, and shall deliver all policies, including a faithful and renewal policies, to holders of the note, and in case of insurance about to expire, shall deliver renewal policies not less than ten days prior to the respective dates of expiration.

 4. In case 't def ult therein, Trustee or the holders of the note may, but need not, make any payment or perform any act hereinbefore required of Mortgagors in any form and manner deemed expedient, and may, but need and the remaining of principal or interest on prior encumbrances, if any, and purchase, discharge cor promise or settle any tax lien or other prior lien or title or claim thereof, or redeem from any tax sand feiture affecting said premises or contest any tax or assessment. All moneys paid for any of the purpose, he eir authorized and all expenses paid or incurred in connection therewith, including attorney's fees, and my fear moneys advanced by Trustee or the holders of the note to protect the mortgaged premises and the liet rereof, plus reasonable compensation to Trustee for each matter concerning which action herein authorized may be when, shall be so much additional indebtedness secured hereby and shall become immediately due and pay able vithout notice and with interest thereon at the rate of seven per cent per annum. Inaction of Trustee or holders of the note shall never be considered as a waiver of any right accruing to them on account of any death thereunder on the part of Mortgagors.

 5. The Trustee or the holders of the note shall never he converged relative.

The Trustee or the holders of tle note hereby secured making any payment hereby authorized relating to taxes or assessments, may do so account to any bill, statement or estimate procured from the appropriate public office without inquiry into the accuracy of such bill, statement or estimate or into the validity of any tax, assessment, sale, forfeiture, tax lien of the control or claim thereof.
- 6. Mortgagors shall pay each item of indebte ne herein mentioned, both principal and interest, when due according to the terms hereof. At the option of t'e hilders of the note, and without notice to Mortgagors, all unpaid indebtedness secured by this Trust Deed shall, not ithstanding anything in the note or in this Trust Deed to the contrary, become due and payable (a) imprimately in the case of default in making payment of any instalment of principal or interest on the note, or (b) who de ault shall occur and continue for three days in the performance of any other agreement of the Mortg gors I erein contained.
- 7. When the indebtedness hereby secured shall become a. whether by acceleration or otherwise, holders of the note or Trustee shall have the right to foreclose the lier hereof, there shall be allowed and included as additional indebtedness in the decree for sale all expenditures and expenses which may be paid or incurred by or on behalf of Truste. or all'ers' of the note for attorneys' fees, Trustee's fees, appraiser's fees, outlays for documentary and expenses, ethographers' charges, publication costs and costs (which may be estimated as to items to be expended a feer entry of the decree) of procuring all such abstracts of title, title searches and examinations; guarant e policies, Torrens certificates, and similar data and assurances with respect to title as Trustee or holders of the note may deem to be reasonably necessary either to prosecute such suit or to evidence to bidders at any sale which may be had pursuant to such decree the true condition of the title to or the value of the premises. All expended to the hade the same of the nature in this paragraph mentioned shall become so much additional indebtedness see red hereby and immediately due and payable, with interest thereon at the rate of seven per cent per annua, when paid or incurred by Trustee or holders of the note in connection with (a) any proceedings, including, proceedings, to which either of them shall be a party, either as plaintiff, claimant or feedant, by reason of this trust deed or any indebtedness hereby secured; or (b) preparations for the commenced; or (c) preparations for the defense of any threatened suit or proceeding which might affect the premises or the security hereof, whether or not actually commenced.

 8. The proceedings of any foreclosure hereof after accrual of the premises shall be distributed and applied in the follow-
- 8. The proceeds of any foreclosure sale of the premises shall be distributed and applied in the following order of priority: First, on account of all costs and expenses incident to the foreclosure proceedings, including all such items as are mentioned in the preceding paragraph hereof; second, all other items which under the terms hereof constitute secured indebtedness additional to that evidenced by the note, with interest thereon as herein provided; third, all principal and interest remaining unpaid on the note; fourth, any overplus to Mortgagors, their heirs, legal representatives or assigns, as their rights may appear.
- 9. Upon, or at any time after the filling of a bill to foreclose this trust deed, the court in which such bill is filed may appoint a receiver of said premises. Such appointment may be made either before or after sale, without notice, without regard to the solvency or insolvency of Mortgagors at the time of application for such receiver and without regard to the then value of the premises or whether the same shall be then occupied as a homestead or not and the Trustee hereunder may be appointed as such receiver. Such receiver shall have power to collect the rents, issues and profits of said premises during the pendency of such foreclosure suit and, in case of a sale and a deficiency, during the full statutory period of redemption, whether there be redemption or not, as well as during any further times when Mortgagors, except for the intervention of such

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receiver, would be entitled to collect such rents, issues and profits, and all other powers which may be necessary or are usual in such cases for the protection, possession, control, management and operation of the premises during the whole of said period. The Court from time to time may authorize the receiver to apply the net income in his hands in payment in whole or in part of: (1) The indebtedness secured hereby, or by any decree foreclosing this trust deed, or any tax, special assessment or other lien which may be or become superior to the lien hereof or of such decree, provided such application is made prior to foreclosure sale; (2) the deficiency in case of a sale and deficiency.

- 10. No action for the enforcement of the lien or of any provision hereof shall be subject to any defense which would not be good and available to the party interposing same in an action at law upon the note hereby secured.
- 11. Trustee or the holders of the note shall have the right to inspect the premises at all reasonable times and access thereto shall be permitted for that purpose.
- 12. Trustee has no duty to examine the title, location, existence, or condition of the premises, nor shall Trustee be obligated to record this trust deed or to exercise any power herein given unless expressly obligated by the terms hereof, nor be liable for any acts or omissions hereunder, except in case of its own gross negligence or misconduct or that of the agents or employees of Trustee, and it may require indemnities satisfactory to it before exercising any power herein given.

Trustee shall release this trust deed and the lien thereof by proper instrument upon presentation of satisfactory evidence that all indebtedness secured by this trust deed has been fully paid; and Trustee may execute and deliver a release hereof to and at the request of any person who shall, either before or after aturity thereof, produce and exhibit to Trustee the note, representing that all indebtedness hereby secured has been paid, which representation Trustee may accept as true without inquiry. Where a release is requested of a successor trustee, such successor trustee may accept as true without inquiry. This Trust Deed and all provisions hereof, shall extend to and be binding upon Mortgagors and all persons claiming under or through Mortgagors, and the word "Mortgagors" when used herein shall include all such persons and all persons liable for the payment of the indebtedness or any part thereof, whether or not such persons shall have executed the rearrange of the indebtedness or any part thereof, whether or not such persons shall not vi nout the written consent of the Trustee or the holder of the note sell or convey the property herein descubed so just to the interest of the Trustee or the holder of the note whether or not such purchaser shall assume or agree to pay the indebtedness hereby secured. Upon any application for the Trustee's or the holder's of the note consent to such a transaction, the Trustee or the holder of the note may require from the purchaser were a new loan applicant. Consent shall not be unreasonably withheld, but Trustee or the holder of the note may impose a service charge not exceed. It is of the original amount of the indebtedness hereby secured and may adjust the contractual interest rate upor the unpaid balance of the obligation secured by this trust deed.
- 17. The lien of this Trust Deed also secures the repropriat of the principal and interest on any other indebtedness due and owing from the mortgagors to the north deed of the principal note secured by this Trust Deed.
