- 9. No Release Upon Extension or Modification. Our granting of any extension of time for payment or our agreement to modify the terms of repayment of the obligations under the Agreement or the requirements in this Mortgage shall not operate to release you from your obligations or liability under the Agreement or this Mortgage.
- 10. Successors and Assigns Bound; Joint and Several Liability; Co-signers. The covenants and agreements of this Mortgage shall bind and benefit your successors and permitted assigns. Your covenants and agreements shall be joint and several. - 11. Loan Charges. - 12. Notices. - 13. Governing Law; Severability. The interpretation and enforcement of this Mortgage shall be governed by the law of the jurisdiction in which the Property is located, except as preempted by federal law. - 14. Transfer of the Property. Project which is satisfactory to us and which provides insurance coverage in the amounts (including deductible levels), for the periods, and against loss by fire, hazards included within the term "extended coverage," and any other hazards, including, but not limited to, earth tuakes and floods, from which we require insurance, then: (i) we waive the provision in Section 3—for the periodic payment to us of the yearly premium installments for hazard insurance on the Property; and (ii) your obligation under Section 4 to maintain hazard insurance coverage on the Property is deemed satisfied to the extent that the required coverage is provided by the Owners Association policy.
