TOGETHER with all improvements, tenements, easements, fixtures, and appurtenances thereto belonging, and all rents, issues and profits thereof for so long and during all such times as Mortgagors may be entitled thereto (which are pledged primarily and on a parity with said real estate and not secondarily), and all apparatus, equipment or articles now or hereafter therein or thereon used to supply heat, gas, air conditioning, water, light, power, refrigeration (whether single units or centrally controlled), and ventilation, including (without restricting the foregoing), screens, window shades, storm doors and windows, floor coverings, inadoor beds, awnings, stoves and water heaters. All of the foregoing are declared to be a part of said real estate whether physically attached thereto or not, and it is agreed that all similar apparatus, equipment or articles hereafter placed in the premises by the Mortgagors or their successors or assigns shall be considered as constituting part of the real estate.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the premises unto the said Trustees, its successors and assigns, forever, for the purposes, and upon the uses and trusts herein set forth, free from all rights and benefits under and by virtue of the Homestead Exemption Laws of the State of Illinois, which said rights and benefits the Mortgagors do hereby expressly release and waive.

#### IT IS FURTHER UNDERSTOOD AND AGREED THAT:

- 1. Mortgagors shall (1) promptly repair, restore or rebuild any buildings or improvements now or hereafter on the p. m' s which may become damaged or be destroyed; (2) keep said premises in good condition and repair, without waste, and free from mechanic's or other liens or claims for lien not expressly subordinated to the lien hereof; (3) pay when due any indebt one, a which may be secured by a lien or charge on the premises superior to the lien hereof, and upon request exhibit satisfactor) evilence of the discharge of such prior lien to Trustee or to the holders of the note; (4) complete within a reasonable time or outliding or buildings now or at any time in process of erection upon said premises; (5) comply with all requirements of law or munic; an ordinances with respect to the premises and the use thereof; (6) make no material alterations in said premises except as r qu' l by law or municipal ordinance.
- 3. Mortgagors shall pay before any enalty attaches all general taxes, and shall pay special taxes, special assessments, water charges, sewer service charges, and an charges against the premises when due, and shall upon written request, furnish to Trustee or to holders of the note duplic te receipts, therefor. To prevent default hereunder Mortgagors shall pay in full under protest, in the manner provided by statute, any x or assessment which Mortgagors may desire to contest.
- 4. Mortgagors shall keep all buildings and improvements now or hereafter situated on said premises insured against loss or damage by fire, lightning or windstorm under policies providing for payment by the insurance companies of moneys sufficient either to pay the cost of replacing or repair or the same or to pay in full the indebtedness secured hereby, all in companies satisfactory to the holders of the note, such rights to be evided. It is not to be a policies payable, in case of loss or damage, to Trustee for the benefit of the holders of the note, such rights to be evided. It is not a policies and shall deliver all policies, including additional and renewal pecies. To bolders of the note and in case of insurance about to expire, shall deliver renewal policies not less than ten days prior to the specified dates of expiration.
- 5. In case of default therein, Trustee or the holders of the note way, but need not, make any payment or perform any act hereinbefore required of Mortgagors in any form and manner deemed experient, and may, but need not, make full or partial payments of principal or interest on prior encumbrances, if any, and puchase, lischarge, compromise or settle any tax lien or other prior lien or other prior lien or other prior lien or itile or claim thereof, or redeem from any tax sale or forfeitu affecting said premises or contest any tax or assessment. All moneys paid for any of the purposes herein authorized and a verenses paid or incurred in connection therewith, including attorneys fees, and any other moneys advanced by Trustee or the volers of the note to protect the mortgaged premises and the lien hereof, plus reasonable compensation to Trustee for any state concerning which action herein authorized may be taken, shall be so much additional indebtedness secured hereby r d ab il become immediately due and payable without notice and with interest thereon at the rate of seven per cent per annum a school of Trustee or holders of the note shall never be considered as a waiver of any right accruing to them on account of any default hereunder on the part of Mortgagors.
- 6. The Trustee or the holders of the note hereby secured making any payments hereby authorized releging to assessments, may do so according to any bill, statement or estimate procured from the appropriate public office without inquiry into the accuracy of such bill, statement or estimate or into the validity of any tax, assessment, sale, forfeiture, tallier or the or claim, thereof.
- 7. That in the event the ownership of said property or any part thereof becomes vested in a person other than the Mort approach, the Mortgagee may, without notice to the Mortgagor, deal with such successor or successors in interest with reference to this mortgage and the debt hereby secured in the same manner as with the Mortgagor, and may forbear to sue or may extend time for payment of the debt, secured hereby, without discharging or in any way affecting the liability of the Mortgagor hereunder or upon the debt hereby secured;
- 8. Mortgagors shall pay each item of indebtedness herein mentioned, both principal and interest, when due according to the terms hereof. At the option of the holders of the note, and without notice to Mortgagors, all unpaid indebtedness secured by this Trust Deed shall, notwithstanding anything in the note or in this Trust Deed to the contrary, become due and payable (a) immediately in the case of default in making payment of any installment of principal or interest on the note, (b) when default shall occur and continue for thirty days in the performance of any other agreement of the Mortgagors herein contained, or (c) in the event the ownership of said property or any part thereof becomes vested in a person other than the mortgagor.
- 9. When the indebtedness hereby secured shall become due whether by acceleration or otherwise, holders of the note or Trustee-shall have the right to foreclose the lien hereof. In any suit to foreclose the lien hereof, there shall be allowed and included as additional indebtedness in the decree for sale all expenditures and expenses which may be paid or incurred by or on behalf of Trustees or holders of the note for attorneys' fees, Trustee's fees, appraiser's fees, outlays for documentary and expert, evidence, stenographers' charges, publication costs and costs (which may be estimated as to items to be expended after entry of the decree) of procuring all such abstracts of title, title searches and examinations, guarantee policies, Torrens certificates, and similar data and assurances with respect to title as Trustee or holders of the note may deem to be reasonably necessary

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either to prosecute such suit or to evidence to bidders at any sale which may be had pursuant to such decree the true condition of the title to or the value of the premises. All expenditures and expenses of the nature in this paragraph mentioned shall become so much additional indebtedness secured hereby and immediately due and payable, with interest thereon at the rate of seven per cent per annum, when paid or incurred by Trustee or holders of the note in connection with (a) any proceeding, including probate and bankruptcy proceedings, to which either of them shall be a party, either as plaintiff, claimant or defendant, by reason of this trust deed or any indebtedness hereby secured; or (b) preparations for the commencement of any suit for the foreclosure hereof after accrual of such right to foreclose whether or not actually commenced; or (c) preparations for the defense of any threatened suit or proceeding which might affect the premises or the security hereof, whether or not actually commenced.

10. The proceeds of any foreclosure sale of the premises shall be distributed and applied in the following order of priority; First, on account of all costs and expenses incident to the foreclosure proceedings, including all such items as are mentioned in the preceding paragraph hereof; second, all other items which under the terms hereof constitute secured indebtedness additional to that evidenced by the note, with interest hereon as herein provided; third, all principal and interest remaining unpaid on the local content of the provided of the content of the provided of the provided

Trustee has no duty except to examine the title, It ration, existence, or condition of the premises, nor shall Trustee be obligated to record this trust deed or to exercise any power, he can given unless expressly obligated by the terms hereof, nor be liable for any acts or omissions bereunder, except in case of its own gross negligence or more standard or that of the agents or employees of Trustee, and it may require indemnities satisfations of it before exercising any power herein given.
