5. Property Insurance. Unless an agreement is made in writing or Applicable Law requires interest to be paid on such insurance proceeds, Lender shall not be required to pay Borrower any interest or earnings on such, proceeds. Fees for public adjusters, or other third parties, retained by Borrower shall not be paid out of the insurance proceeds and shall be the sole obligation of Borrower. If the restoration or repair is not economically feasible or Lender's recurrity would be lessened, the insurance proceeds shall be applied to the sums secured by this Security Instrument, whicher or not then due, with the excess, if any, paid to Borrower. Lender may use the insurance proceeds either to repair or restore the Property or to pay amounts unpaid under the Note or this Security Instrument, whether or not then due.

- 6. Occupancy. Borrower shall occupy, establish, and the Property as Borrower's principal residence within 60 days after the execution of this Security Instrument and the number of occupantive to occupy the Property as Borrower's principal residence for at least one year after the date of occupancy, urless Lender otherwise agrees in writing, which consent shall not be unreasonably withheld, or unless extenuating circum stances exist which are beyond Borrower's control.
- 7. Preservation, Maintenance and Protection of the Property, Pushections. Borrower shall not destroy, damage or impair the Property, allow the Property to deteriorate or commit waste on any Property. Whether or not Borrower is residing in the Property, Borrower shall maintain the Property in order to prevent the Property from deteriorating or decreasing in value due to its condition. Unless it is determined pursuant to Section 5 that repair or rest vation is not economically feasible, Borrower shall promptly repair the Property if damaged to avoid further delectionation or damage. If insurance or condemnation proceeds are paid in connection with damage to, or the taking of, the Property ty, Borrower shall be responsible for repairing or restoring the Property only if Lender has released proceeds for such purposes. Lender may disburse proceeds for the repairs and restoration in a single payment or in a series of progress payments as the work is completed. If (a) Borrower fails to perform the covenants and agreements contained in this Security Instrument, (b) there is a legal proceeding that might significantly affect Lender's interest in the Property and/or rights under this Security Instrument (such as a proceeding in bankruptcy, probate, for condemnation or forfeiture, for enforcement of a lien which may attain priority over this Security Instrument or to enforce laws or regulations), or (c) Borrower has abandoned the Property, then Lender may do and pay for whatever is reasonable or appropriate to protect Lender's interest in the Property and rights under

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this Security Instrument, including protecting and/or assessing the value of the Property, and securing and/or repairing the Property. Lender's actions can include, but are not limited to: (a) paying any sums secured by a lien which has priority over this Security Instrument; (b) appearing in court; and (c) paying reasonable attorneys' fees to protect its interest in the Property and/or rights under this Security Instrument, including its secured position in a bankruptcy proceeding. Any amounts disbursed by Lender under this Section 9 shall become additional debt of Borrower secured by this Security Instrument. These amounts shall bear interest at the Note rate from the date of disbursement and shall be

payable, with son interest, upon notice from Lender to Borrower requesting payment.

If this Security instrument is on a leasehold, Borrower shall comply with all the provisions of the lease. If, for any reason, the Mortgage Insurance coverage required by Lender ceuses to be available from the mortgage insurer that previously provided such insurance and Borrower was required to make se parately designated payments toward the premiums for Mortgage Insurance, Borrower shall pay the premiums required to obtain coverage substantially equivalent to the Mortgage Insurance previously in effect, at a cost substantially jour alent to the cost to Borrower of the Mortgage Insurance previously in effect, from an alternate mortgage insurer selected by Lender. If substantially equivalent Mortgage Insurance coverage is not available, Borrower shall continue to pay to Lander the amount of the separately designated payments that were due when the insurance coverage ceased to be in effect. Lorder will accept, use and retain these payments as a non-refundable loss reserve in lieu of Mortgage Insurance.
