The following provisions of the Revised Statutes of said State of Illinois, being Section 752 of Chapter 120 is recited, pursuant to law:

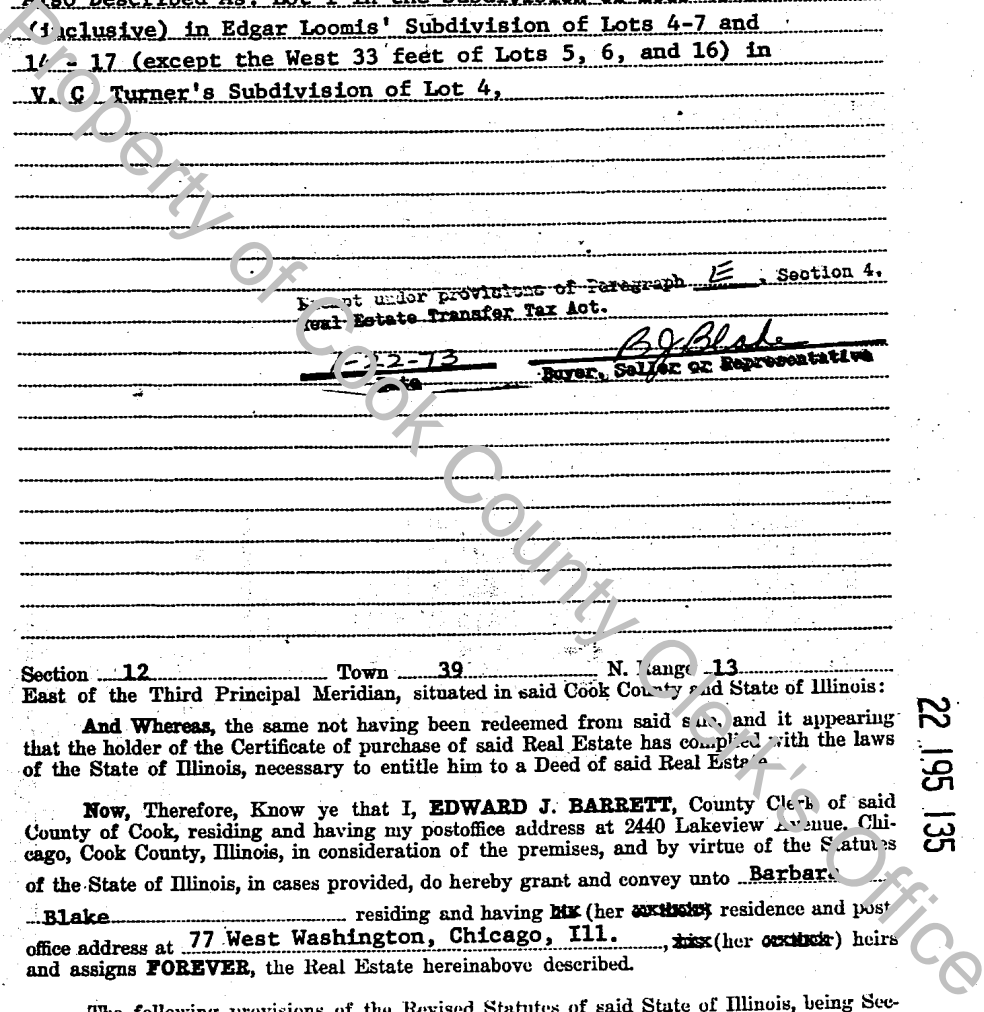
