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## EXHIBIT "A"

This conveyance is made and accepted upon each of the following stipulations, restrictions and conditions which are hereby made covenants running with the land, and which shall apply to and be binding upon the purchaser, its successors or assigns.

- I. That no building shall at any time be erected on the said premises within twenty-fire (25) feet of any street right-of-way adjoining the same, within ten (10) feet all side boundary lines, or within fifteen (15) feet from the rear boundary line of the premises.
- 2. No loading o'c' shall be erected on the said premises fronting on any street, unless the front f such loading platform shall be set back at least sixty (60) feet from the property lime abutting the street on which said loading dock fronts.
- 3. The grantee agrees to privile on the premises off-street automobile hard surface parking areas of blacktop, asphil or concrete based on a minimum rate of one 300-square-foot space for each three (.) employees employed on the premises by the original occupants thereof, and ur completion of the building, to place a sidewalk along the entire street frontage of fro tages adjacent to the building in accordance with the requirements of the Villege of Elk Grove Village.
- 4. All buildings erected on the property shall be of resont's construction or its equivalent or better. Front walls facing on streets of such buildings must be finished with face brick, stone, modern metal paneling, glas or their equivalent. Other walls shall be faced with common brick or its equivalent. Any construction other than the above shall be submitted to and approved by grant or
- 5. Grantee agrees that the area between the building lines and the street property lines shall be used for either open landscaped and green areas or for service access to the building or to a parking lot. Landscaped areas shall be done attractively with lawns, trees, shrubs and similar treatment and shall be properly maintained in a sightly and well kept condition.

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- 6. Water towers, water tanks, stand pipes, penthouses, elevators or elevator equipment, stairways, ventilating fans or similar equipment required to operate and maintain the building, fire or parapet walls, s vrights, tanks, cooling or other towers, wireless, radio or television mast, roof signs, flagpoles, chimneys, smoke stacks, gravity flow storage, and mixing towers or similar structures may exceed a height of fifty (50) feet from the established building grade only with the approval of grantor. By the above, rorestriction is intended as to building heights.
- 7. The graitor etains such rights-of-way and easements as may be necessary or convenier. It is not the purpose of erecting, constructing, maintaining and operating utility a rvices over, across, under and through the premises in the designated set back areas between the building lines and the property lines, including putilic service wires and conduits for lighting, power and telephone, gas lines, savitary sewer, storm sewer and water, and the grantor shall have the right to grait right-of-way easements to others to carry out this purpose. Any contract for the laying of such lines, wires, conduits, pipes or sewers shall also provide that the premises shall be restored to the same condition they were in the contract to the doing of such work.
- 8. Storage yards for equipment, raw materials, sent inished or finished products shall be so shielded by a fence, shrubs, hedge or other foliage as to effectively screen the view of such storage area from the street.
- 9. The premises shall not be used or maintained as a dumping ground for rubbish. Trash, garbage or other waste shall not be kept, except in sanitary containers. All incinerators or other equipment for the storage or disposal of such material shall be kept in a clean and sanitary condition.

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- 10. No fence, wall, hedge or shrub, plant or tree which obstructs site lines at elevations between two and six feet above the roadway shall be placed or permitted to remain on any corner within the triangular area formed by street property lines and a line connecting them at points twenty
  (25) feet from the intersection of the street lines.
- and a continuance thereof, may, at the option of grantor, its successors or assigns, be enjoined, abated or remedied by appropriate proceedings. It is understood, however, that the breach of any of the foregoing covenants, conditions and restrictions shall not defeat or render invalid the lien of any mortgage on the premises made in good faith and for value; provided, however, that any breach or continuance thereof may be enjoined, abated or remedied by the proper proceedings as aforesaid; and provided further, that each and all of the foregoing covenants, conditions and restrictions shall at all times remain in full force and effect against said premises or any part thereof, title to which is obtained by foreclosure of any such mortgage.
- 12. The conditions of this contract state survive the deed given pursuant hereto.
- 13. The conditions and covenants herein contained shall terminate and be of no further effect after twenty-five (25) years ir a January 1, 1967.

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
